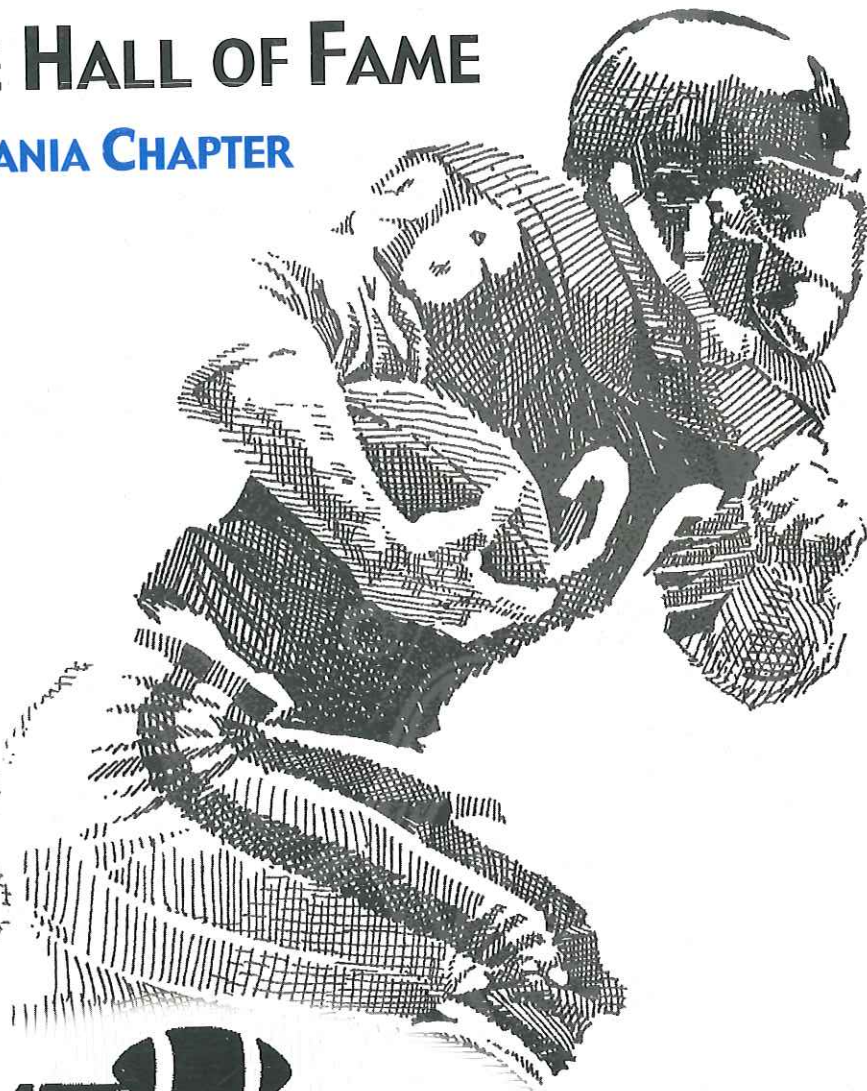

Coaching Accomplishments:

The success of his disciples in the NFL has earned Penn State the name "Linebacker U." Coached nine first-team All-America linebackers, most recently LaVar Arrington in 1998. Two of his linebackers, Brandon Short and LaVar Arrington, were first-team All-Big Ten and Butkus Award semifinalists in 1998. Was named the 1986 Assistant Coach-of-the-Year by Athlon as his defense led Penn State to the National Championship, intercepting Heisman Trophy winner Vinny Testaverde a season-high five times and holding him without a touchdown pass for the only time on the season in the 1987 Fiesta Bowl. Devised defensive schemes that put the clamps on such Heisman Trophy winners as Tony Dorsett, Marcus Allen, Herschel Walker, Doug Flutie, Vinny Testaverde, Gino Torretta, and Ty Detmer. Named the 1996 Pennsylvania recipient of the SGMA Heroes Award for his contributions through sports in the local community. Awarded the University's Barash Human Service Award and YMCA Service-to-Youth Award in 1995. Awarded the Contribution to Amateur Football Award by the Philadelphia Chapter of the National Football Foundation and College Football Hall of Fame in 1994. Received Human Rights Award, with his father, Art, from the Washington, Pa., branch of the NAACP in 1993.

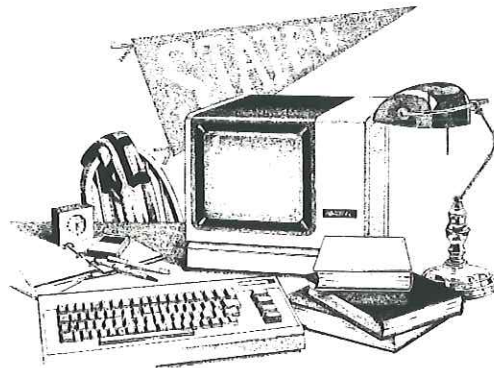

Rick's position with The National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame entails a wide range of responsibilities as both the Director of Public Relations and as the Eastern Region Coordinator. In addition to handling all public and media relations' responsibilities, he coordinates The NFF's 32 Eastern Region chapters, the College Hall of Fame elections, the Foundation's major awards, and highly prestigious national scholar-athlete program, which has now awarded over \$3 million in postgraduate scholarships. Additionally, he manages the weekly tabulation and dissemination of the Bowl Championship Series Standings during the college football season.

A high school and American Legion baseball coach while in college, Walls received a Bachelor of Science Degree from Ohio University in 1990, majoring in Sports Industry. After an internship with WLWT-TV in Cincinnati, Ohio, he began working for The College Football Hall of Fame, which at the time was located in Kings Island, Ohio. As the assistant director of the Traveling College Football Hall of Fame, he helped plan and implement a nationwide tour, which traveled over 20,000 miles through 35 states, attending 15 college football games and numerous other events. In 1991 he became the special projects manager in charge of procuring the Hall's priceless memorabilia collection and directing special events, including the management of Galbreath Field, a 10,000 seat stadium used for high school, college, and professional events.

When the Hall of Fame was destined for relocation to South Bend, Indiana, Walls transferred to play a key role in its development, serving on the Research, Marketing and Design Committees.

In 1995 Walls returned to Ohio as a sales manager of a lumber company and later as membership director at a multi-purpose fitness center in Cincinnati. In 1997 Rick rejoined The National Football Foundation and assumed his current responsibilities, and now resides in Piscataway, NJ, with his wife, Julie.

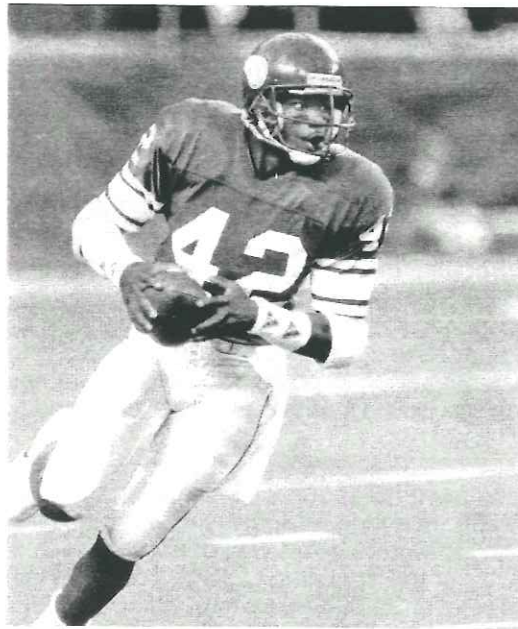

D.J. Dozier is currently a ministry assistant for a Benny Hinn Ministries and is a member at World Outreach Church in Orlando, FL. He joined BHM, WOC in September of 1995. He has traveled extensively throughout the United States and the world with the crusade team.

Dozier ministers to business people and entrepreneurs, from business start-ups to long standing establishments. He counsels on money and business strategies from a Biblical perspective. He is the President of World Changers, Inc. a non-profit organization. He is currently assisting Safe-T-Net (a national Christian based Internet service provider) in Ft. Myers, FL, Insights International (an educational program offering remedies for sleeplessness) in Va. Beach, VA; The Senior Group (sports marketing agency) in Philadelphia, PA and Publishingnet, Inc. (online business magazine) in Tampa, FL.

Dozier worked as the National Youth Coordinator for Washington for Jesus in 1994 (Rock Church, Va. Beach, VA). He gathered youth ministries for the purpose of the 1996 Youth Rally. He was also the Athletic Director for Rock Church Academy.

Dozier ministers to youth with a message of hope and encouragement. He has spoken in public schools and colleges under the supervision of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA), Athletes and Businesses for Kids and the Rock Church Power Team.

Dozier brings an inspiring message of salvation, deliverance, purpose and excellence for life to the body of Christ. He has ministered in numerous churches and church organizations throughout the United States.

Dozier is a former professional athlete. While attending Penn State University, he was All-American (1983-1987) and was a Heisman trophy candidate in the 1986-1987 season. He knelt in the end zone after scoring the winning touchdown in the 1987 National Championship game. Dozier rushed for 3,227 yards a Nittany Lion, fourth best in school history and scored 25 career touchdowns. Thereafter, he became a first round draft choice into the NFL. He played for the Minnesota Vikings and Detroit Lions football clubs in the position of running back. His NFL experience total five years. He was also healed of a football injury while at Penn State University.

Dozier, unable to play baseball while in college, signed a professional baseball contract with the New York Mets organization in 1990 after being inactive in the sport for seven years. He joined the New York Mets major league team in 1992.

Dozier has appeared as a guest speaker on the 700 Club and the Richard Roberts Program. Other appearances include: CNN, This Week in Baseball, HBO Sports and many other Christian and secular TV and Radio programs. He has been featured in many magazines and on the cover of Sports Illustrated and Sport Magazine.

He is a native of Va. Beach, VA and attended Penn State University where he studied Tourism and Business Recreation.

PROCEDURE FOR THE SELECTION OF THE SCHOLAR-ATHLETES

As the scholastic football season came to a close, a representative of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame sent a letter and nomination form to each of the 31 high school principals and football coaches represented by the Central Pennsylvania Chapter. Each principal and head coach then submitted a resume of the qualifications of the selected candidate. The resume included a high school transcript, test scores (SAT/ACT), athletic achievements, extra-curricular activities and community service participation.

The resumes were forwarded to the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee was composed of knowledgeable representatives from the athletic, educational and business communities. It was the responsibility of the Selection Committee to follow the guidelines established by the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame. The following was the basis for selection:

- 40% Academic Achievement
- 40% Athletic Achievement
- 20% Extracurricular/Community Service Activities

The resumes were carefully evaluated and rank ordered. The names were given to the Advisory Board. The Advisory Board determined the number of scholarships to be presented to the nominees.
