#### History -

The National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame was founded in 1947 and is dedicated to mobilizing the constructive forces of amateur football, at all levels, for the benefit of society.

As stated most clearly by former President and Foundation "Gold Medal" recipient Dewight D. Eisenhower. "In football, in business, in the trades and professions, the normal urge to excel provides one of the most hopeful assurances that our kind of society will continue to advance and prosper. Morale... the will, this heart...we need not only in athletic teams as individual, but collectively."

To preserve and encourage these values in our nation's youth, the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame helps to bring together all of the organized groups that play, coach, administer, support and report amateur football. It seeks to establish the true concept of the game as an amateur sport, and to gain recognition of the important role it plays in the preservation and advancement of our way of life.

The Central Pennsylvania Chapter is one of 110 chapters who combine with the national office to honor over 3,000 high school and college scholar athletes each year with nearly \$1,000,000 in scholarships for undergraduate and graduate education. Now in its sixth year, the Central Pennsylvania Chapter is proud to honor 32 high school and 3 college scholar athletes for the 2002-2003 year. Our congratulations to each award recipient who was nominated by their schools.

#### Procedure for Selecting Award and Scholarship Winners -

At the beginning of the scholastic football season, the president of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter sent a letter and nomination form to each of the 32 high school principals, head coaches, and athletic directors in the central region. Each school was asked to nominate one senior member from their football team to receive an award from the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame. Each nomination form included a high school transcript, and official test scores (SAT/ACT).

The nomination forms, transcripts and test scores were forwarded to the scholarship selection committee. This committee is composed of knowledgeable representatives from our local chapter who were responsible for evaluating each of the nominees using the following three criteria established by the National office:

40% Academic Achievement

40% Athletic Achievement

20% Extracurricular/Community Service Participation

The scholarship committee carefully evaluated each nominee and rank ordered them accordingly. The rank order was given to the Advisory Board and the top 10 individuals will also receive \$1000 post graduate scholarships.



# Dr. Dave Joyner An All-American, Academic Scholar, Doctor and Olympian

Dr. Dave Joyner was one of Penn State's outstanding scholar athletes and long after his graduation he continues to show why.

Today, Dr. Joyner is an orthopedic surgeon, a physician for the United States Olympic team and a member of the Penn State Board of Trustees. He also is active in various public service endeavors on a local, state, national and international level.

That's quite an accomplishment for a player who was a near unanimous selection as an All-American offensive tackle and a runner-up in the NCAA heavyweight wrestling tournament.



"Joyner may be the best tackle we've had at Penn State," Coach Joe Paterno once said about the man who was his co-captain of the 1971 team. Dr. Joyner played three years for Paterno and was a devastating blocker and exceptional pass protector. The 1971 team lost only one game and wiped out favored Texas, 30-6, in the 1972 Cotton Bowl.

Dr. Joyner was equally successful in wrestling. He is one of just seven Nittany Lion wrestlers to win three individual championships in the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association. Dr. Joyner also was co-captain of the undefeated 1971 wrestling team (10-0-1) that won the team EIWA title and finished fourth in the NCAA tournament. He narrowly missed winning the NCAA heavyweight championship that year.

Dr. Joyner also excelled in the classroom. The State College native was an academic All-American in his senior year and also won a prestigious fellowship from the National Football Foundation and College Football Hall of Fame. In 1991, Dr. Joyner was inducted in the GTE/CoSIDA Academic Hall of Fame. Perhaps his greatest academic honor came in 1997 when he was the recipient of the NCAA Silver Anniversary Award honoring former student-athletes who have distinguished themselves in their profession.

After graduating from Penn State with a Bachelors of Science degree, Dr. Joyner went on to medical school at Penn State's College of Medicine and received his medical degree in 1976. He has spent the majority of his medical career in sports medicine. In 1992 he founded the Joyner Sports Medicine Institute and he is now associated with the Orthopedic Institute of Pennsylvania and hospitals in the Harrisburg area. He also is chairman of the board and chief executive officer for Elan Cosmetic Centers, Inc., which is developing national centers devoted to skin care.

Dr. Joyner has been involved in the Olympic movement for many years and was the head physician for the U. S. Team at the 1992 Winter Games in Albertville, France. He has been chairman of the U.S. Olympic Committee's Sports Medicine Committee since 1993.

Dr. Joyner was honored by Penn State as a Distinguished Alumnus in 1992 and was elected to the board of trustees in 2000. He continues to give back to the University in several capacities, including serving as cochairman of the Paterno Libraries Endowment and chairman of the Schreyer Institute for Innovation Learning.
