# Bill O'Brien - Penn State Head Football Coach

## Featured Speaker

To call Bill O'Brien's first year as a head coach "great" would be a vast understatement.

A thesaurus is unable contain all the superlatives that could be used to describe the overall efforts by O'Brien, his staff and the Nittany Lion squad members during his thrilling, challenging and memorable first season as head coach at Penn State.

Named the Nittany Lions' 15th head football coach on January 6, 2012, O'Brien quickly and effectively established the foundation and shared his passionate vision for the new era of Penn State Football during his initial eight months on the job.

After two narrow losses to open the season, the resilient Nittany Lions responded the following Monday with one of their best practices of the season to set the tone for the final 10 games. A 34-7 victory over Navy in Week 3 not only was O'Brien's first career victory but served as a launching pad for the remainder of the season. Penn State won eight of its final 10 contests and earned a 6-2 mark in the Big Ten Conference, finishing second in the Leaders Division.

Penn State capped its remarkable season with a 24-21 overtime victory over eventual Big Ten Champion Wisconsin on an emotional Senior Day, with 31 committed and dedicated seniors introduced before the game. O'Brien's eight wins were the most by a first-year Penn State coach in the 126 years of the program and led to a plethora of accolades for his leadership, coaching acumen and commitment under unprecedented conditions.

In his 20th year of coaching, but his first as a head coach, O'Brien was selected the 2012 Bear Bryant Coach of the Year, ESPN Coach of the Year and the Maxwell Football Club Collegiate Coach of the Year. He also was a finalist for the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year and the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year by the Football Writers Association of America (FWAA). O'Brien also was among the finalists for the 2012 Dapper Dan Sportsman of the Year, a prestigious honor presented to a metropolitan Pittsburgh sports figure.

O'Brien also was named the Big Ten's Dave McClain Coach of the Year (media) and Hayes-Schembechler Coach of the Year (coaches). The Brown University graduate

was just the seventh first-year head coach to earn the Big Ten-Dave McClain Coach of the Year in the 41 years it has been awarded.

Penn State reeled off five consecutive victories after the 0-2 start, as O'Brien tied George Hoskins (1892) and Dick Harlow (1915) for the most consecutive wins by a first-year Nittany Lion coach. Among the wins was a 22-point fourth quarter explosion to hand No. 24 Northwestern its first loss. Penn State also won its initial three Big Ten road games, making O'Brien just the fifth Big Ten coach since 1950 to win his first three conference away contests.

The Nittany Lions' offensive coordinator, O'Brien engineered a dynamic, fast-paced offense that featured the Big Ten's passing leader (Matt McGloin), top receiver (Allen Robinson) and a running back (Zach Zwinak) who gained 100 yards six times in eight Big Ten games and 1,000 yards for the season. McGloin broke nine school passing records and won the Burlsworth Trophy and Robinson shattered the Penn State season record with 77 receptions.

Penn State led the Big Ten in total offense (437.0 ypg) in conference games and was second in scoring offense (32.6 ppg) and second in pass offense (283.1 ypg) against Big Ten foes during the 2012 the season. The Nittany Lions gained more than 500 yards of total offense three times in conference play, topped by 546 yards vs. Indiana, its highest total against a Big Ten foe in four years.

O'Brien's teaching and tenacity helped Penn State earn two All-America honorees (Jordan Hill and Michael Mauti), two freshmen All-Americans (Deion Barnes and Kyle Carter), six first-team All-Big Ten selections and three individual conference award winners:

- LB Michael Mauti - Big Ten Butkus-Fitzgerald Linebacker of the Year;
- WR Allen Robinson - Big Ten Richter-Howard Receiver of the Year;
- DE Deion Barnes - Thompson-Randle El Big Ten Freshman of the Year.

"Bill O'Brien has been an outstanding addition to Penn State athletics and to our University community," said President Rodney Erickson. "His leadership has been exceptional as he has rallied fans and players in their support of our team and delivered a



winning season. Coach O'Brien's commitment to both athletics and academics continues Penn State's long-standing tradition of achievement both on the field and off, and his first year as head coach of the Nittany Lions has been one of tremendous success and positive impact on the entire University."

"He's an educator and he's a very humble guy," said Dave Joyner, Acting Director of Athletics. "He is a coach who is really a teacher and an educator. He really serves that purpose very well, and he's able to greatly enhance the experience for his student-athletes. What motivates him is working at a great university and being able to coach these great young men, and working with all the coaches together as a great One Team. That's what motivates Bill O'Brien."

During the 2012 Fall semester, O'Brien saw 47 squad members earn at least a 3.0 grade-point average, with a program record 20 Nittany Lions earning Dean's List recognition by posting a 3.5 GPA or higher during the semester. A program record 28 football student-athletes earned Academic All-Big Ten honors in 2012 for owning at least a 3.0 grade point average and being a letterwinner. In addition, senior defensive end Pete Massaro and John Urschel earned first-team CoSIDA Academic All-America honors, as Penn State and Notre Dame were the only FBS schools with multiple first-team honorees.

O'Brien is a tireless worker, with an emphasis not only on hard work in the classroom, practice field and weight room, but on the importance of character, respect, integrity, honesty and competition for all members of the football squad and staff.

# Matt Rhule - Temple Head Football Coach

## Featured Speaker

Matt Rhule may be the perfect person to take Temple to the next level of collegiate football. He has spent most of his 14 years as an assistant collegiate coach with Temple, where he was a key part of Al Golden's resurrection of Owl football.

In announcing the hiring of Rhule on December 17, Temple's Director of Athletics Bill Bradshaw said, "We had a diverse and talented pool of candidates and an overwhelming amount of interest in the Temple football head coaching position, but one person distinguished himself from the rest – Matt Rhule. Matt is the perfect person to take the Temple football program to the next level. He is an outstanding recruiter and in his six years at Temple was responsible for bringing many of the players that helped the program win its first bowl in 32 years. He is one of the top young minds in the profession, and has a total understanding of the game. And clearly he is someone who loves Temple, and is already ingrained into the Temple community."

Rhule returns to Temple as the Owls 26th head coach after spending a year as the assistant offensive line coach with the New York Giants. During his previous tenure at Temple, the role of the 37-year-old State College native changed several times since his original hiring by Golden in 2006 to coach the defensive line. He also served as the quarterbacks coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2006 and 2007 seasons

when Temple's recruiting class was ranked No. 1 in the MAC. In the spring of 2008 he was promoted to offensive coordinator while continuing to coach quarterbacks and remained in that position until 2011, Coach Steve Addazio reassigned him as assistant offensive coordinator, tight ends coach and recruiting coordinator

Rhule was a four-year walk-on at Penn State and became a three-time Penn State scholar-athlete, earning Academic All-Big Ten honors in 1997. Prior to Temple, Rhule had coached at Albright, Buffalo, UCLA and Western Carolina

"It is with tremendous pride and anticipation for the future that my family and I are coming home to Temple University," said when he accepted the position. "I am honored and thankful that Bill Bradshaw (and Temple's presidents) have entrusted me with the privilege to serve Temple as its head football coach, and I am impressed with their vision for the future. I had the privilege of spending six wonderful seasons at Temple University in a myriad of roles, and it was during that time that I realized Temple was home. When the opportunity came to return and serve the Temple student-athletes and the greater University community as a whole; I knew it was right. I am extremely grateful for the opportunity and look forward to continuing the program's upward momentum as a member of the BIG EAST Conference."

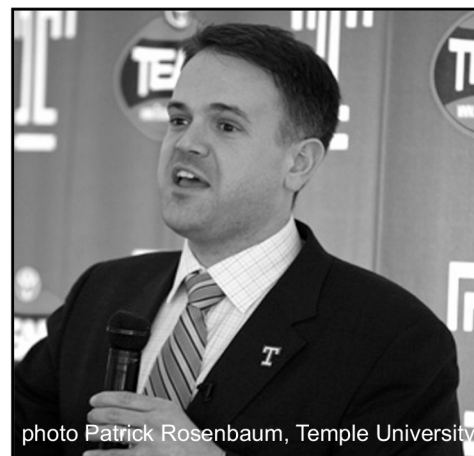

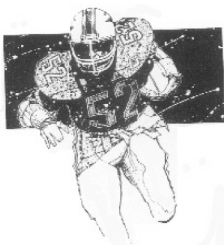

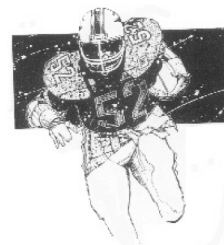

# Fran Fisher Award Winner: Doug McDonald

When Doug McDonald started covering high school football late in the fall of 1958 he was the Sports Editor of the Centre Daily Times---and the only person in the entire department! He retired as Senior Sports Writer in 1995 after 37 1/2 years.

For his long-time contributions to scholastic football, Doug McDonald is the third recipient of the Fran Fisher Award for lifetime achievement in the media.

McDonald, 79, never expected to be a sports writer. After graduating from Penn State with a degree in advertising, he went to work at the Centre Daily Times as an advertising salesman. When Sports Editor Ron Field left for another job nine months later, McDonald asked Editor Jerry Weinstein if he could have Field's job. Mr. Weinstein replied: "Yes, if you stay for at least two years." He assured him he would. McDonald said he kept his promise and stayed 37 1/2 years.

"My main beats at the outset included Penn State football, wrestling, basketball, track and field, cross country and some gymnastics," McDonald recalled, "while my county-wide high school coverage included football, wrestling, basketball, track and field, cross country and a sprinkling of other sports. Later as we acquired more help I concentrated, to a lesser degree, on some, but I continued to cover scholastic football until I retired."

"But in 1958 I was the sports department with some local high school and Penn State student help. I wasn't superman but did put in many hours. I would cover high school football on a Friday night, working into the wee hours, and then leave early Saturday morning for, say, Syracuse, for a Penn State freshman football game at 10 a.m. and then the varsity's game at Archbold Stadium in the afternoon. The paper was evening delivery then so I had Sunday and part of Monday to complete everything.

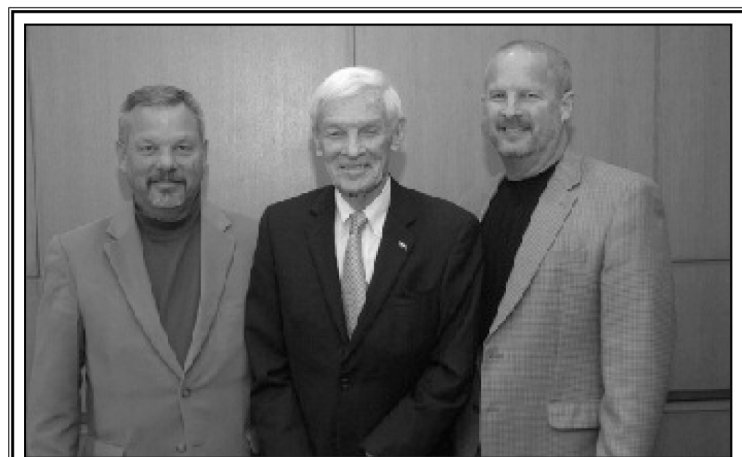
"We gave high school football excellent coverage in Centre County because we had a group of writers and sports editors from the area who met every Tuesday during the fall. The writers from the Altoona Mirror, Huntingdon Daily News, Tyrone Daily Herald, Lewistown Sentinel, Clearfield Progress and I would exchange stories for the upcoming Friday night games, providing the readers with stats, starting lineups and quotes from the head coaches.

"Toward the end of the season, we would meet again to determine the top players in the Central Counties League and forward those names to either AP or UPI, hoping the central PA kids would gain some kind of recognition at the all-state level, and at times our efforts paid off. We also selected a Central Counties League All-Star team, and later the league seniors played in a summer All-Star (North-South) game. Eventually, the writers would do their best to pool their thoughts in hoping to land a player or two on the Big 33 squad, and we landed our share of players on the squad.

In addition to football, McDonald also was devoted to wrestling, and he is now a member of four halls of fame, in-

cluding the Pennsylvania Chapter of the prestigious National Wrestling Hall of Fame. He is a graduate of West Reading High School and he and his wife, Jane, still make their home in State College.

## FRAN FISHER AWARD--

The Fran Fisher Award for Excellence in Sports Journalism was created in 2011 by the National Football Foundation's Central Pennsylvania Chapter to honor the most popular sportscaster in the history of Penn State and the region.

Fisher's name is synonymous with Penn State sports, and especially football.

For thirty-five years he was associated with the broadcasts of Penn State football games on radio with numerous other assignments involving Penn State sports on television, radio and public events.

Even in retirement he continues to be an ambassador for Penn State and college football, not only with his attendance at games but also in the frequent interviews he does for the media.

Fisher also represents the best of scholastic football. Prior to joining Penn State he broadcasted high school games for fifteen years in Greensburg and Lewistown.

The Fran Fisher Award will be presented annually to an individual who exemplifies the character and professionalism of Fran Fisher as they promote the values and goals of amateur football while applying their craft.

# Lifetime Achievement Award Winner: Stanley Bem



Stanley Bem is a graduate of Bishop Carroll High School in Ebensburg Pa where he earned a football scholarship to West Virginia University. At WVU he was an offensive lineman and played in the 1964 Liberty Bowl.

Stan spent his 36-year professional career at the Purchase Line High School in Commodore Pa where he started as a Social Studies teacher and head football coach. As a coach he was

named the Indiana Gazette Coach of the Year in 1968 and led his team to the 1969 Appalachian Conference Championship. He was an assistant principal at Purchase Line for two years and the high school principal for 28 years until his retirement in 2003.

During those years he was active in the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) as the Junior High Representative on the PIAA District 6 Committee. He was eventually elected Chairman of the District 6 Committee, a position he retained for 17 years. He served as the District 6 Basketball Tournament Director during that time.

He served on the PIAA Board of Directors as the Junior

High Representative and as the Chairman of District 6. He was President of the Board of Control for five years. Prior to being President he served as Treasurer and Vice President. Stanley was an avid advocate of girl's athletics and was among the individuals that started the PIAA State Football Championship. He served as the basketball and football game manager for district and state tournaments.

In addition, he officiated basketball for 25 years and football for 42 years. He continues to officiate football and works to mentor younger officials. He was inducted into the Indiana County Sports Hall of Fame in 2003.

Since his retirement he spent two years working as a consultant for the Pennsylvania Department of Education. He loves to hunt, build furniture and garden and is an avid Fly Fisherman. He also is a volunteer at the St. Vincent De Paul Thrift Store in Indiana PA.

Stanley has been married to Louise Bem for 47 years. They enjoy travel, bicycling and hiking and spending time with their grandchildren. They have three sons, Eugene an Industrial Engineer of New York City; David, Global Research and Development Director of Dow Chemicals in Midland, Michigan; and Michael, Manager of Research Dedicated Information at Eli Lilly and Company in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Stan and Louise have six grandchildren.

# Community Service Award in Honor of Joe Sarra: Coach, Friend, Advisor

Joe Sarra was a football coach for 40 years, but he has been more than just a coach to most of the players, fellow coaches and football fans he met in his career. Joe was a friend and advisor to many of his players, an honest, hard worker to his coaching colleagues, and a caring and compassionate man to the thousands of other people met over the decades. Football and family has been his passion but helping others was his avocation.

Joe is typical of the western Pennsylvania young men of his generation. They were the children of hard working blue collar families, sons of the tough and intense men who labored in the hot steel mills or underground in the dusty coal mines. Don't follow us, the fathers told them. Make something of your self, they said. Go to college and get an education, they urged. And sports—particularly football—was the way to do it.

So, Sarra left his home in Belle Vernon, 20 miles southeast of Pittsburgh, in 1956 and entered a small college down the road, then known as California State Teachers College. He went there to play football, and to be a teacher, studying social studies education and guidance. After graduation in 1960, he stayed in the area and was hired by East Washington High School to teach social science with additional duties as the head coach of the football team. That would be the start of his lifetime dream—to coach football and teach young men.

A year later, Joe was back in his hometown as an assistant coach at Belle Vernon High School, and guidance counselor. But that wasn't enough for Sarra. He was also continuing his education, working part-time on a Master's Degree in secondary administration and counseling from the University of West Virginia, just across the state line from the football hotbeds of southwestern Pennsylvania. He did that in 1964, the same year he became an assistant coach at nearby Hempfield High School.

However, Joe wanted to be a head coach again. So, in 1967 he left western Pennsylvania for the hard coal region, becoming the head coach and social studies teacher at Southern Columbia High School. He loved his job but he wanted

more. He had always wanted to coach in college, and in 1970 he had his chance, when Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, hired him as an assistant. Sarra never looked back.

The next season, 1971, Lafayette University came calling, and Joe spent the next 12 years there, first as the offensive coordinator until 1975 and then as the defensive coordinator. Now, Joe really fell in love—in love with defensive coaching. Joe knew he could coach defense at a higher level.

In 1984, Penn State

hired Sarra as the inside linebackers coach. Nine years later, Sarra was promoted to defensive line coach, and he stayed there through the 1999 season, when he moved into the front office as an administrator, retiring in 2005.

Throughout his professional career, Joe was always involved in volunteer work for the communities he lived in. One of his favorite organizations was the Second Mile charity for children. But perhaps his greatest service to the community and to Penn State was his dedication to the rehabilitation of Adam Taliaferro, the Penn State cornerback who was paralyzed in a game against Ohio State in 2000. Joe was the liaison with the Taliaferro family and spent many of his days with Adam and the family in the year that Adam recovered and was able to walk again.

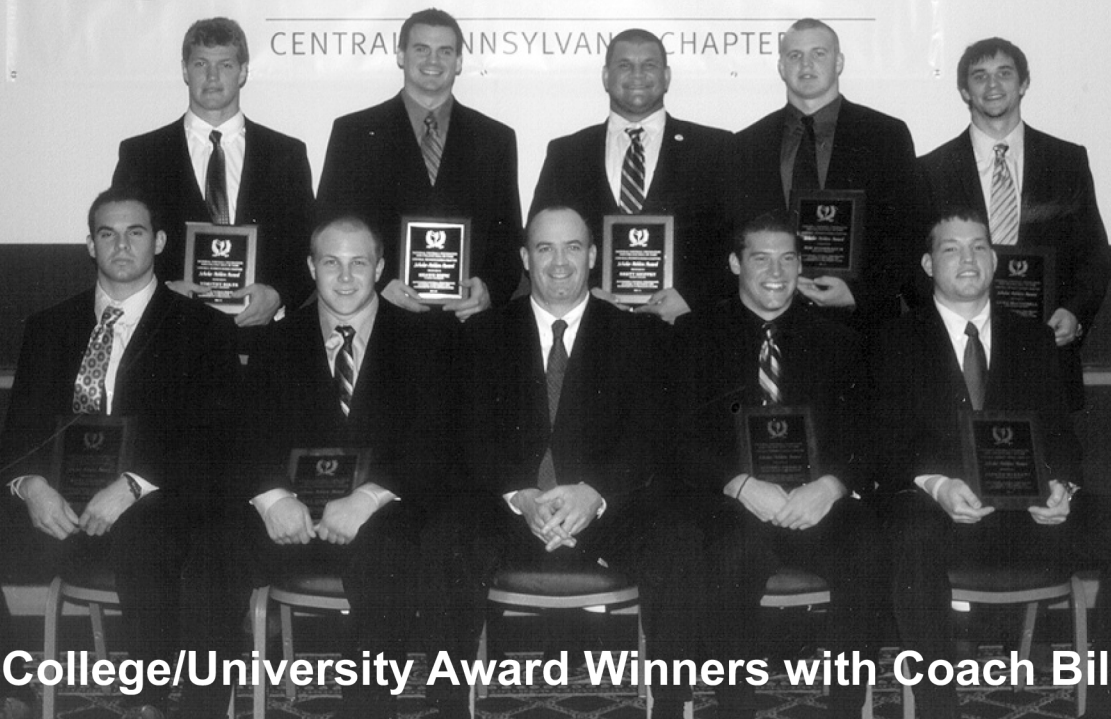

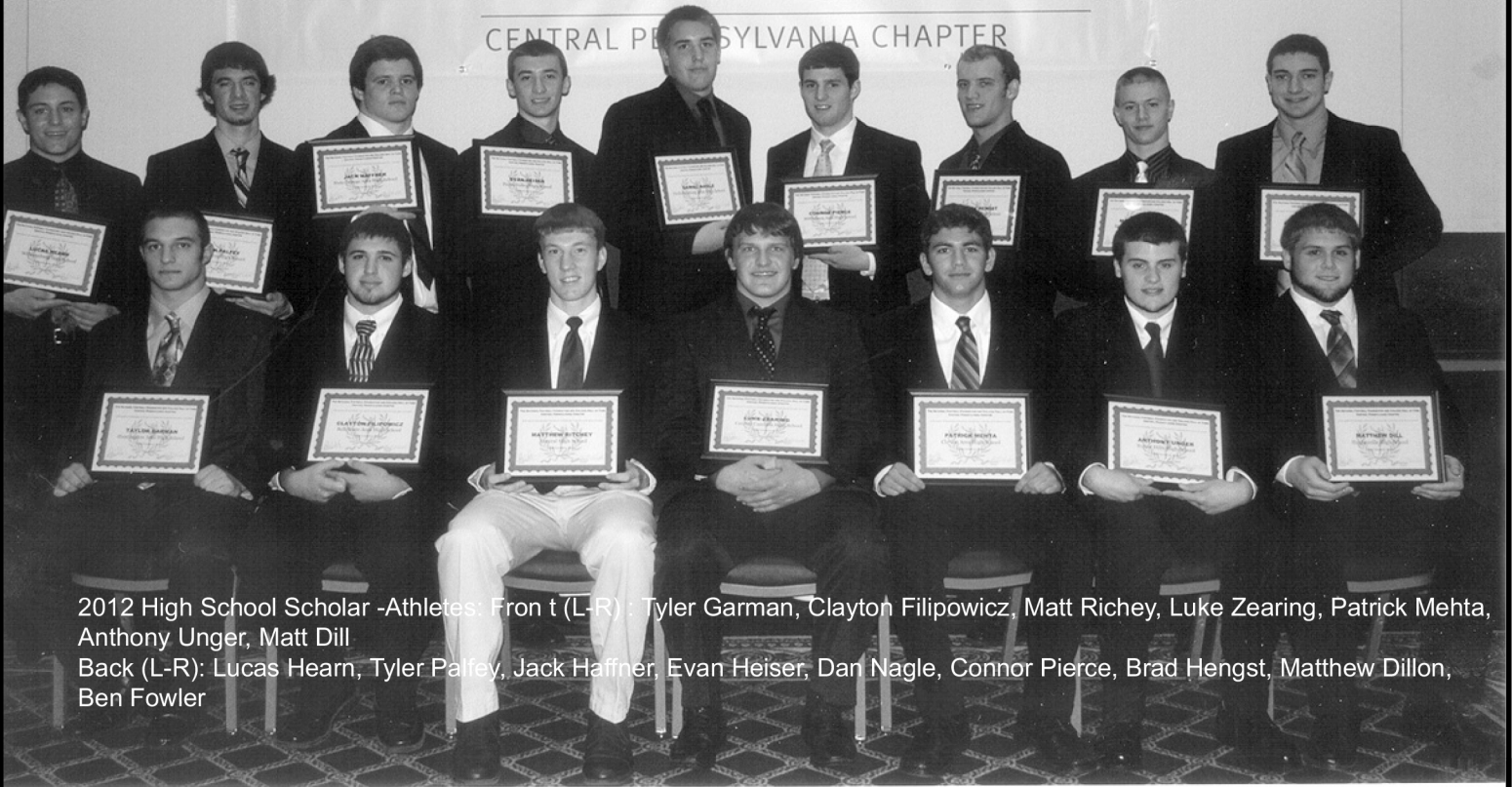

# History of our Organization

At the beginning of the scholastic football season, the president of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter sent a letter and nomination form to each of the 45 high school head football coaches in the centre region. Each school was asked to nominate one senior member from their football team to receive an award from the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame. Each nomination form included a high school transcript and official test scores (SAT/ACT).

The nomination forms, transcripts and test scores were forwarded to the scholarship selection committee. This committee is composed of knowl-

edgeable representatives from our local chapter who were responsible for evaluating each of the nominees using the following three criteria established by the National office:

- Academic Achievement**
- Athletic Achievement**
- Extracurricular/Community Service Participation**

The scholarship committee carefully evaluated each nominee and rank ordered them accordingly. The rank order was given to the Advisory Board and the top 10 individuals will also receive \$1000 post graduate scholarships.

## Mark Keppler Football Trainer of the Year

Associate Athletic Director Mark Keppler, now in his 26th year as Bucknell's head athletic trainer, oversees Bucknell's athletic training and sports medicine program. Keppler coordinates the work of seven professional staff members, a graduate assistant and a dedicated group of student assistants.

The head trainer at Carnegie Mellon University for 11 years before coming to Bucknell, Keppler is a member of the National Athletic Trainers Association and is both state- and nationally-certified.
