James Franklin - Penn State Head Football Coach

Featured Speaker

Pennsylvania State University has selected James Franklin, a Pennsylvania native who is one of the nation's most successful and dynamic coaches, as the 16th head football coach in its storied 127-year history.

The enthusiastic and passionate Franklin led Vanderbilt University to unprecedented success in his three years as head coach, winning nine games in each of the past two years, and finishing in the Top 25 in consecutive seasons, both for the first time in school history.

From Langhorne, Pa., a Philadelphia suburb, Franklin's enthusiasm and tireless efforts resulted in taking Vanderbilt to new heights over the past three years, posting a 24-15 record, including marks of 9-4 during each of the past two seasons, capped by bowl victories. The Commodores finished the 2013 season with five consecutive victories, with wins over Florida, Georgia, Tennessee and Kentucky in Southeastern Conference play, along with a win over Houston in the BBVA Compass Bowl. Franklin's 2012 squad finished the season with seven consecutive victories and posted VU's first nine-win season since 1915.

Penn State and Vanderbilt annually rank among the nation's top institutions in the graduation of its football student-athletes. In the NCAA Graduation Success Rate data from October 2013, the Nittany Lions and Commodores both ranked among the leaders in the Football Bowl Subdivision. Penn State's 85 percent Graduation Success Rate was tied for 12th among the nation's 124 FBS programs and Vanderbilt's 82 percent GSR was tied for the best in the Southeastern Conference. Both programs were well above the 70 percent FBS graduation rate average.

A two-time All-Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) quarterback at East Stroudsburg University, Franklin has demonstrated the ability to recruit, teach and motivate talented student-athletes throughout his coaching tenure. He was named Vanderbilt's head coach on December 17, 2010 after three years as the assistant head coach/offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Maryland, his second stint with the Terps. Franklin was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Kansas State in 2006-07 and the wide receivers coach of the NFL's Green Bay Packers (2005) prior to arriving in Nashville.

The engaging Franklin spent this past Monday in Pasadena, appearing on multiple ESPN platforms throughout the day during the network's coverage of the BCS National Championship Game.

Entering his 20th year in coaching, Franklin directed Vanderbilt to consecutive Top 25 finishes for the first time in the 124-year history of the program. The Commodores finished this past season No. 24 in the Associated Press poll and No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches survey. The 2012 Vanderbilt squad finished No. 23 and 20, respectively, marking its first AP final ranking since 1948. Franklin's 24 wins tied Dan McGugin for the most by a Vanderbilt coach in his first three seasons.

Franklin led Vanderbilt to a bowl game in each of his three seasons in Nashville, with the last two years resulting in wins over North Carolina State (Music City Bowl) and Houston (BBVA Compass Bowl). The Commodores had played in four bowl games all-time in the 121 seasons prior to his arrival, none in consecutive years.

Franklin began his coaching career as the wide receivers coach at Kutztown University (1995) and was a graduate assistant coach at East Stroudsburg in 1996, working with the secondary. He then was the wide receivers coach at James Madison (1997), a graduate assistant (tight ends) at Washington State in 1998 and the wide receivers coach at Idaho State (1999).

In 2000, Franklin was named the wide receivers coach at Maryland under head coach Ron Vanderlinden. He continued in that role under new head coach Ralph Friedgen in 2002 and '03 and helped the Terps to three consecutive 10-win seasons, including an appearance in the 2002 FedEx Orange Bowl. In 2003, Franklin added duties as recruiting coordinator and directed back-to-back recruiting classes ranked in the Top 25 nationally. Franklin and O'Brien (running backs) were Maryland assistant coaches in 2003 and '04 under Friedgen.

After five successful years at Maryland,



Franklin was named wide receivers coach on Mike Sherman's Green Bay Packers staff in 2005. During that season, Green Bay ranked third in the NFL in receptions (383) and seventh in receiving yards (3,766). Donald Driver was among the top receivers in the NFL, ranking second in receptions and eighth in receiving yards, with a then-career-high 86 catches for 1,221 yards.

In 1998, Franklin began his participation in the NFL's Minority Coaching Fellowship Program, starting with a stint with the Miami Dolphins and working with Hall of Fame quarterback Dan Marino. Franklin also worked with Donovan McNabb with the Philadelphia Eagles (1999) and Minnesota Vikings (2008) in the NFL program.

Franklin was a four-year letterman at quarterback and a two-time All-PSAC selection at East Stroudsburg. He set seven school records as a senior to earn team MVP honors and was a Harlon Hill Trophy nominee for the NCAA Division II Player of the Year. Among the records he set were for total offense (3,128 yards), passing yards (2,586) and touchdown passes (19).

Franklin graduated from East Stroudsburg in 1995 with a psychology degree. He also earned a master's degree in educational leadership from Washington State University. Franklin graduated from Neshaminy High School in Langhorne.

Franklin and his wife, Fumi, have two daughters, Ava and Addison.

Lifetime Coaching Achievement Award Winner: Danny Hale



Coach **Danny Hale**, who retired in June after 20 years as head coach at Bloomsburg University.

Hale, who also had been the head coach at West Chester University for five years, is one of the winningest coaches in Division II with a record of 213-69-1 (.754). His Bloomsburg teams won or shared 11 Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference Eastern Division titles and reached

the NCAA post-season playoffs eight times.

Counting his five years at West Chester, Hale has 213 career victories, which was good for fifth among active Division II coaches at the end of 2012. Hale is 13th on the Division II all-time list topped by Ken Sparks of Carson-Newman.

Hale amassed 173-56-1 mark in 20 seasons at Bloomsburg. The previous winningest coach in Bloomsburg history had 38 wins. He turned Bloomsburg from just another program to one that won or tied for 11 PSAC East Division titles during his tenure and which qualified for the NCAA tournament eight times, including a turn as national runner-up in 2000. His teams were 121-32 since the 21st century began.

Among the players he coached are Jahri Evans of the New Orleans Saints, one of the top offensive linemen in the NFL; Irv Sigler, the 1997 Harlon Hill Award winner as the best player in Division II; Jamar Brittingham, the PSAC's career rushing leader; and Franklin Quiteh, who is being recognized here today, as well.

In April 2002, Danny Hale was accorded a special honor, having the field at Robert B. Redman Stadium named Danny Hale Field in his honor.

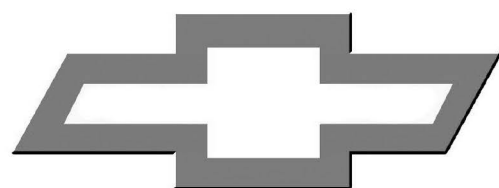

Jonathan Ganter was a 1998 National Football Foundation, Central PA Chapter scholarship winner from State College Area High School.

Jonathan received his A.B. degree, cum laude, in 2002 from Princeton University, where he also earned three varsity letters as a defensive back on the Princeton Football team. Upon the completion of his college career, the Princeton Football Association awarded him with the Ronald A. Rogerson Memorial Award for enthusiasm, hard work, and leadership, as well as the Charles W. Caldwell Postgraduate Scholarship for Academic Excellence.

Following graduation, Jonathan worked at the U.S. Department of Justice as the Special Assistant to the Attorney General of the United States, and at the White House Counsel's Office as a Staff Assistant in President George W. Bush's Administration.

Fran Fisher Award "Excellence in Sports Journalism"



John Lipez

John Lipez is a Lock Haven native, a life-long Clinton County resident and a longtime broadcaster and journalist. He is a 1965 graduate of Penn State University, with a BA from the School of Journalism with a broadcast major.

He did his first radio sportscast in 1964, a wrestling match between Lock Haven and Bloomsburg Universities. Shortly thereafter he began regular announcing of football, basketball, wrestling, baseball and softball on WBPZ in Lock Haven, continuing in that role to this day.

His broadcasts of high school football extend a remarkable family string of 67 years: his late father Harris Lipez began broadcasting Lock Haven High School football games when WBPZ went on the air in 1947. Son John began his broadcasting of the games in the mid 1960s and continues to this day; they announced the games together for a quarter of a century.

Lipez became principal owner of WBPZ and WSNU in 1987, selling the properties in November of 2010. In 1993 he became a partner in the Clinton County weekly newspaper The Record and became sole owner in 1998. With both holdings he has put an emphasis on covering local amateur sports, seeing them as an integral positive part of the culture of the greater Lock Haven area community.

FRAN FISHER AWARD--

The Fran Fisher Award for Excellence in Sports Journalism was created in 2011 by the National Football Foundation's Central Pennsylvania Chapter to honor the most popular sportscaster in the history of Penn State and the region.

Fisher's name is synonymous with Penn State sports, and especially football.

For thirty-five years he was associated with the broadcasts of Penn State football games on radio with numerous other assignments involving Penn State sports on television, radio and public events.

Even in retirement he continues to be an ambassador for Penn State and college football, not only with his attendance at games but also in the frequent interviews he does for the media.

Fisher also represents the best of scholastic football. Prior to joining Penn State he broadcasted high school games for fifteen years in Greensburg and Lewistown.

The Fran Fisher Award will be presented annually to an individual who exemplifies the character and professionalism of Fran Fisher as they promote the values and goals of amateur football while applying their craft.

Community Service Award in Honor of Joe Sarra: Coach, Friend, Advisor

Joe Sarra was a football coach for 40 years, but he has been more than just a coach to most of the players, fellow coaches and football fans he met in his career. Joe was a friend and advisor to many of his players, an honest, hard worker to his coaching colleagues, and a caring and compassionate man to the thousands of other people met over the decades. Football and family has been his passion but helping others was his avocation.

Joe is typical of the western Pennsylvania young men of his generation. They were the children of hard working blue collar families, sons of the tough and intense men who labored in the hot steel mills or underground in the dusty coal mines. Don't follow us, the fathers told them. Make something of your self, they said. Go to college and get an education, they urged. And sports—particularly football--was the way to do it.

So, Sarra left his home in Belle Vernon, 20 miles southeast of Pittsburgh, in 1956 and entered a small college down the road, then known as California State Teachers College. He went there to play football, and to be a teacher, studying social studies education and guidance. After graduation in 1960, he stayed in the area and was hired by East Washington High School to teach social science with additional duties as the head coach of the football team. That would be the start of his lifetime dream—to coach football and teach young men.

A year later, Joe was back in his hometown as an assistant coach at Belle Vernon High School, and guidance counselor. But that wasn't enough for Sarra. He was also continuing his education, working part-time on a Master's Degree in secondary administration and counseling from the University of West Virginia, just across the state line from the football hotbeds of southwestern Pennsylvania. He did that in 1964, the same year he became an assistant coach at nearby Hempfield High School.

However, Joe wanted to be a head coach again. So, in 1967 he left western Pennsylvania for the hard coal region, becoming the head coach and social studies teacher at Southern Columbia High School. He loved his job but he wanted

more. He had always wanted to coach in college, and in 1970 he had his chance, when Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, hired him as an assistant. Sarra never looked back.

The next season, 1971, Lafayette University came calling, and Joe spent the next 12 years there, first as the offensive coordinator until 1975 and then as the defensive coordinator. Now, Joe really fell in love—in love with defensive coaching. Joe knew he could coach defense at a higher level.

In 1984, Penn State hired Sarra as the inside linebackers coach. Nine years later, Sarra was promoted to defensive line coach, and he stayed there through the 1999 season, when he moved into the front office as an administrator, retiring in 2005.

Throughout his professional career, Joe was always involved in volunteer work for the communities he lived in. One of his favorite organizations was the Second Mile charity for children. But perhaps his greatest service to the community and to Penn State was his dedication to the rehabilitation of Adam Taliaferro, the Penn State cornerback who was paralyzed in a game against Ohio State in 2000. Joe was the liaison with the Taliaferro family and spent many of his days with Adam and the family in the year that Adam recovered and was able to walk again.

No one, in all of college football, more adequately and more appropriately exemplifies the values and the mission of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame.

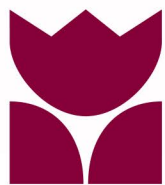
