
Jeff Hartings is a former college and professional football player who was a guard and center in the National Football League for eleven seasons. He played college football for Penn State University, and earned All-American honors.

Hartings was a first-round pick of the Detroit Lions in the 1996 NFL Draft, and he played professionally for the Lions and Pittsburgh Steelers. He was a member of the Steelers' Super Bowl championship team in 2005, and was a two-time Pro Bowl selection.

Hartings was born in St. Henry, Ohio. He attended St. Henry High School, and was a letterwinner in football as a two-way starter and in track and field. In football, he was a two-time all-conference selection, helped lead his team to the state championship as a senior, and compiled 23 sacks and 200 tackles. After his senior season, he participated in the Ohio North-South Game.


Jeff graduated from Penn State with a bachelor of science degree in marketing in 1995 and was twice honored as an Academic All-American.

Lifetime Achievement in Football Award Winner: John Hayes



John graduated from East Huntingdon High School in 1964.

He continued his education at Susquehanna University in 1965 before transferring to Juniata College - 1966-1969 Hayes played center and line-backer.

Hayes has spent thirty-five (35) years coaching at Bellwood-Antis amassing an otustanding:

296-96-2 record (1980-present) He teaches social studies at Bellwood-Antis.

In 1981, John also assumed the duties of Athletic Director.

Prior to coming to Bellwood-Antis, he served as assistant at Tyrone from 1969-1978.

John has coached five teams to undefeated regular seasons twelve times. Three of his teams have advanced as far as the PIAA Final Four (1988, 2006, 2012). Under Hayes, Bellwood-Antis has won six D6 Championships and seventeen

Inter-County Conference titles.

Mr. Hayes has been a statewide leader serving as State VP and State President PSFCA 2002-2003.

He further was the Game Director of the East/West All-Star Game from 2001-2010.

John was also instrumental in re-establishing this game in Altoona and worked closely with the Blair County Visitor and Convention Staff as well as with the Pennsylvania Football News.

Besides receiving many local coaching awards, John was named Regional Athletic Director of the Year 2001 and State Coach of the Year 1985.

Contribution to Football Award - Athletic Training

Dr. Salvaterra currently serves as a Faculty Athletic Trainer at Bloomsburg University, having been hired in July of 2014. He provides athletic training services to all student-athletes at the university, with his main sport responsibilities being football, women's basketball, and women's lacrosse.

Prior to Bloomsburg, he was previously employed at Penn State University from 1985 to 2012 where he served as the Head Athletic Trainer for the Football program. He also served as the Supervisor for Athletic Training Services for the Penn State Athletic Department.

During his time at Penn State, George co-authored several nationally published research articles on the topics of nutrition and injuries of Division I football players.

Prior to his time at Penn State, Dr. Salvaterra also served as an athletic trainer at Lafayette College and Princeton University, as well as Parkland High School.

He received his Bachelors degree from West Chester University, a Masters degree from Michigan State University and a Doctorate degree from Penn State University.

Dr. Salvaterra and his wife Barbara are the parents of three children; Charlie and Travis (students at Penn State) and Catherine.



Fran Fisher Award "Excellence in Sports Journalism"



Ron Bracken

Ron has been a fixture in Central Pennsylvania Sports and is best known for his sportswriting career at the Centre Daily Times.

Ron is a graduate of Bald Eagle Area High School and spent two years at Penn State before entering his life passion of being a sports writer.

He spent forty-one years at the Centra Daily Times, forty (40) of those covering Penn State football. He covered all four games in which the Nittany Lions played for a national title - 1978 Sugar Bowl and 1985 Orange Bowl, 1982 Sugar Bowl and 1987 Fiesta Bowl.

Bracken has covered ten Bowl games including the Orange, Rose, Sugar, Cotton and Fiesta.

The long time writer has won fifteen Pennsylvania writing awards and two national awards.

He was the very first president of Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation and Hall of Fame. This very organization is indebted to Ron for this huge effort.

He has also been recognized in other sports and is an honoired member of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame (PA chapter), Pennsylvania Wrestling Coaches' Hall of Fame, the District 6 and BEA wrestling Halls of Fame and will be inducted into the District 6 softball hall of fame this spring.

Ron currently resides in Philipsburg, and he still manages to serve as a stringer for his former paper.

His dedication and insight into area sports coverage has not gone unnoticed. He has definitely earned this cherished award.

FRAN FISHER AWARD--

The Fran Fisher Award for Excellence in Sports Journalism was created in 2011 by the National Football Foundation's Central Pennsylvania Chapter to honor the most popular sportscaster in the history of Penn State and the region.

Fisher's name is synonymous with Penn State sports, and especially football.

For thirty-five years he was associated with the broadcasts of Penn State football games on radio with numerous other assignments involving Penn State sports on television, radio and public events.

Even in retirement he continues to be an ambassador for Penn State and college football, not only with his attendance at games but also in the frequent interviews he does for the media.

Fisher also represents the best of scholastic football. Prior to joining Penn State he broadcasted high school games for fifteen years in Greensburg and Lewistown.

The Fran Fisher Award will be presented annually to an individual who exemplifies the character and professionalism of Fran Fisher as they promote the values and goals of amateur football while applying their craft.

Community Service Award in Honor of Joe Sarra: Coach, Friend, Advisor

Joe Sarra was a football coach for 40 years, but he has been more than just a coach to most of the players, fellow coaches and football fans he met in his career. Joe was a friend and advisor to many of his players, an honest, hard worker to his coaching colleagues, and a caring and compassionate man to the thousands of other people met over the decades. Football and family has been his passion but helping others was his avocation.

Joe is typical of the western Pennsylvania young men of his generation. They were the children of hard working blue collar families, sons of the tough and intense men who labored in the hot steel mills or underground in the dusty coal mines. Don't follow us, the fathers told them. Make something of yourself, they said. Go to college and get an education, they urged. And sports—particularly football—was the way to do it.

So, Sarra left his home in Belle Vernon, 20 miles southeast of Pittsburgh, in 1956 and entered a small college down the road, then known as California State Teachers College. He went there to play football, and to be a teacher, studying social studies education and guidance. After graduation in 1960, he stayed in the area and was hired by East Washington High School to teach social science with additional duties as the head coach of the football team. That would be the start of his lifetime dream—to coach football and teach young men.

A year later, Joe was back in his hometown as an assistant coach at Belle Vernon High School, and guidance counselor. But that wasn't enough for Sarra. He was also continuing his education, working part-time on a Master's Degree in secondary administration and counseling from the University of West Virginia, just across the state line from the football hotbeds of southwestern Pennsylvania. He did that in 1964, the same year he became an assistant coach at nearby Hempfield High School.


However, Joe wanted to be a head coach again. So, in 1967 he left western Pennsylvania for the hard coal region, becoming the head coach and social studies teacher at Southern Columbia High School. He loved his job but he wanted

more. He had always wanted to coach in college, and in 1970 he had his chance, when Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, hired him as an assistant. Sarra never looked back.

The next season, 1971, Lafayette University came calling, and Joe spent the next 12 years there, first as the offensive coordinator until 1975 and then as the defensive coordinator. Now, Joe really fell in love—in love with defensive coaching. Joe knew he could coach defense at a higher level.

In 1984, Penn State hired Sarra as the inside linebackers coach. Nine years later, Sarra was promoted to defensive line coach, and he stayed there through the 1999 season, when he moved into the front office as an administrator, retiring in 2005.


Throughout his professional career, Joe was always involved in volunteer work for the communities he lived in. Perhaps his greatest service to the community and to Penn State was his dedication to the rehabilitation of Adam Taliaferro, the Penn State cornerback who was paralyzed in a game against Ohio State in 2000. Joe was the liaison with the Taliaferro family and spent many of his days with Adam and the family in the year that Adam recovered and was able to walk again.

Contribution to Football Award - Officiating



Ed Conklin started officiating with the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association in 1978.

He has worked all levels of football from peewees to adult flag (adult flag football was the toughest as many close fights broke out without enough 'adult' supervision).

Ed has also worked all over central and north central Pa. traveling for games from the New York

stateline, Sayre HS in district 4, to Harrisburg, Northern Dauphin HS in district 3, to the Johnstown area, Westmont HS in district 6, to Bradford HS in district 10.

He started working PIAA playoff games in the 80s, and in 2014, worked a state semi-final game.


Most years Ed has worked forty (40) or so junior high, jv, and varsity games.

Ed has also been an effective recruiter, enticing numerous others into officiating, including two sons.





 Service Participation 20%


The scholarship committee carefully evaluated each nominee and rank ordered them accordingly. The rank order was used to award \$1,000 postgraduate scholarships.
