Todd Rucci Featured Speaker

Todd Rucci lettered in four sports his senior year that included football, basketball, winter track and spring track. While playing football at Upper Darby, he was an All-State selection and chosen to play in the Big 33 Game in 1988. Todd entertained scholarship offers to throw discus in college, but chose to follow his passion to State College.

He was originally recruited to play defensive end for the Penn State Nittany Lions, but made the successful transition to the offensive side of the field his junior year. He was the recipient of the Red Worrel Award in the spring of that same year. Todd played in four bowl games for the Nittany Lion squads from 1989-1992.

Todd was selected by the New England Patriots in the second round of the 1993 NFL draft and played 8 years at offensive guard for the Patriots 1993-2000. His career spanned 3 different head coaches including Bill Parcells, Pete Carroll and Bill Belichick. Todd played in SUPERBOWL XXXI in 1997 against the Green Bay Packers, He was named to the New England Patriot's All Decade Team for the 1990s.

Mr. Rucci is currently a government relations officer with PAP Technologies in Lancaster. He is the former Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Lottery, Board of Trustees at Penn State and currently serves on the Warwick School Board in Lancaster County.

Lifetime Achievement in Football Award Winner: Bernard L. McQuown



Before retiring in 2014, Bernie McQuown had football in his life every year since 1948, when he was 12 years old and in the sixth grade. The next year, he began playing junior high football, and had either been a player or a coach every autumn since. After his playing career ended in college, McQuown spent one season as an assistant at his high school alma mater, Punxsutawney, before becoming the head coach at East Brady for three years (1959-61), followed by four seasons at Kane (1962-65). He then went to Indiana in 1966, and he stayed for 21 wildly successful seasons in which the Indians won 133 games, lost 56 and tied nine, a winning tradition that has yet to be matched in the years since. McQuown gave up that job in 1987 and joined the Indiana University of Pennsylvania staff as an assistant that fall. He tutored the Crimson Hawks' defensive ends and coached the punt squad on special teams, but he also served as a mentor to the rest of the coaching staff, some of whom weren't even alive when McQuown was at the age he first thought he should retire

McQuown had retired before. Well, sort of. In 1987, he gave up his job as the Indiana High coach, feeling it was the right time to hand the reins to someone else. But a few years after he joined Frank Cignetti's staff at IUP, he planned to walk away, but then things happened and the next thing he

he joined Frank Cignetti's staff at IUP, he planned to walk away, but then things happened and the next thing he knew, McQuown was still there when Cignetti retired in 2005.

McQuown decided to quit then, but new IUP coach Lou Tepper asked McQuown to stay, and the plans to retire were scrapped again. And then five years later, when Curt Cignetti took over the program, well, it seemed silly to leave with the program getting a much-needed injection of enthusiasm.

Anyone who knew McQuown back in the 1950s when he was growing up in Punxsutawney was well aware of his energy level and desire to be a football coach.

He was a standout for the Chucks and then went off the Juniata College in the fall of 1954 and became an All-American for the Eagles, all the while keeping his eye on the road ahead that led to a coaching career.

He also earned a ton of honors — probably more that can fit in his home. He was named the Pennsylvania Coach of the Year in Class AAA in 1980, the Indiana Gazette Coach of the Year four times, and he was the coach of the West team for the 1979 Big 33 game. West team for the 1979 Big 33 game.

Justin Wheeler was named Bishop Guifoyle Catholic High School's head football coach in February 2011. Finishing his 14th vear in a successful and varied coaching career (his fifth at BG), Wheeler has spent the past year emphasizing not only hard work in the classroom, practice field and weight room, but on the importance character, respect, integrity and competition for all members of the football squad and

Bishop Guilfoyle White eller's experience as a former collegiate player at Penn State University and his previous high school coaching positions have gained him the knowledge needed to be a successful head coach at Bishop Guilfoyle. Wheeler has led the Bishop Guilfoyle Marauders to 2 consecutive PIAA Class A State Championships with a 32-0 record (Longest current streak in PA) in those games and an amazing 52-14 streak in PA) in those games and an amazing 52-14 overall record. Wheeler's Marauders have also won 4

LHAC Section 1 titles, 2 LHAC Championships and 2 District 6 Championships.

Coach Wheeler was honored for this success by numerous organizations and was named 2014 & 2015 Single A Coach of the Year in the State of PA, 2014 Western PA Small School Coach of the Year, 2014 District 6 Coach of the Year, 2014 & 2015 Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association Coach of the Year, 2014 & 2015 Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association Coach of the Year, 2014 & 2015 Altoona Mirror Coach of the Year, WHVL Coach of the year and the 2014 & 2015 Laurel Highlands Conference Coach of the Year Coach of the Year.

After graduating from Penn Cambria High School in 1991, Coach Wheeler went on to Penn State University to not Coach Wheeler went on to Penn State University to not only play football, but to earn his Bachelor's Degree in Secondary Science Education. Before graduating from PSU in 1996, he was a member of Penn State's 1994 Rose Bowl Champion and undefeated football team. He was hired by the Penn Cambria School District in the fall of 1996 and taught in the high school science department for 13 years. During that time, Wheeler continued his education at Saint Francis University where he earned a Master's Degree in Education and Leadership with a K-12 Principal Certification and for the past six years Wheeler has served as a 7th grade science teacher at Penn Cambria's Middle School.

Wheeler resides in Gallitzin Township with his wife of 16 years (Kelly) and their three children (Hayley-14, Kamryn-11 and Justin-6). Coach Wheeler and his wife are the owners of Charlene's School of Dance in Cresson.

Fran Fisher Award "Excellence in Sports Journalism": Terry Bowser

In his final "Bowser Bag" sports column for the Huntingdon Daily News, Terry Bowser observed that his "passion has always been high school sports." It's an admission that readers could hardly miss as they followed Bowser's sports writing career that spanned more than 14,000 newspaper editions over 47 years, including 23 with him at the helm as sports editor.

Bowser's journalism career began in 1965, when he was offered a newly-created full-time sports writing position with The Daily News by then-sports editor Mailand H. McIlroy. In 1989, following McIlroy's retirement, Bowser was named the new Huntingdon Daily News sports editor and stayed until he retired on Aug. 24, 2012 -- one day after celebrating his 47th anniversary at the paper.

During his tenure with the newspaper, Bowser covered the Pittsburgh Pirates in two World Series, most Penn State home football games for some two decades, the 1973 Orange Bowl game that featured Nittany Lion Heisman Trophy winner John Cappelletti, Juniata College football and a wide range of other sports events. His periodic "Bowser Bag" columns frequently featured thoughtful takes on current sporting events and hard-hitting news. In addition, he never failed to highlight the progress of young local athletes who had gone on to play sports in college or professionally, or who had obtained another athletic accolade. From skeet to ultra-marathons and beyond, Bowser chronicled countless local athletes' accomplishments with care and an acute attention to detail that drew in loyal readers and kept them coming back for more each day.

Bowser's love of local sports also made him a natural to serve as one of the original founders of the Huntingdon County Sports Hall of Fame, to which he was inducted in 2013. He was the organization's first president, serving in that capacity from the chapter's first day when it received its charter from the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame Sept. 4, 1997, through the end of his term in 1998. He has remained an active member of the group since then and has authored 147 of the 148 biographies that have accompanied each

inductee through this year. The only exception was his own, which he entrusted to his daughter. Bowser now serves as an Executive Board representative for the Huntingdon County Sports Hall of Fame.

Son of the late Luther and Minnie (Cramer) Bowser of Mill Creek, Bowser is a 1965 graduate of Huntingdon Area High School. He is the brother of Diana Yingling of Hesston and the late Charles Bowser of Mill Creek.

FRAN FISHER AWARD--

The Fran Fisher Award for Excellence in Sports Journalism was created in 2011 by the National Football Foundation's Central Pennsylvania Chapter to honor the most popular sportscaster in the history of Penn State and the region.

Fisher's name is synonymous with Penn State sports, and especially football.

For thirty-five years he was associated with the broadcasts of Penn State football games on radio with numerous other assignments involving Penn State sports on television, radio and public events.

Even in retirement he continues to be an ambassador for Penn State and college football, not only with his attendance at games but also in the frequent interviews he does for the media.

Fisher also represents the best of scholastic football.

Prior to joining Penn State he broadcasted high school games for fifteen years in Greensburg and Lewistown.

The Fran Fisher Award will be presented annually to an individual who exemplifies the character and professionalism of Fran Fisher as they promote the values and goals of amateur football while applying their craft.

Community Service Award in Honor of Joe Sarra: Coach, Friend, Advisor

Joe Sarra was a football coach for 40 years, but he has been more than just a coach to most of the players, fellow coaches and football fans he met in his career. Joe was a friend and advisor to many of his players, an honest, hard worker to his coaching colleagues, and a caring and compassionate man to the thousands of other people met over the decades. Football and family has been his passion but helping others was his avocation.

Joe is typical of the western Pennsylvania young men of his generation. They were the children of hard working blue collar families, sons of the tough and intense men who labored in the hot steel mills or underground in the dusty coal mines. Don't follow us, the fathers told them. Make something of yourself, they said. Go to college and get an education, they urged. And sports—particularly football--was the way to do it.

So, Sarra left his home in Belle Vernon, 20 miles southeast of Pittsburgh, in 1956 and entered a small college down the road, then known as California State Teachers College. He went there to play football, and to be a teacher, studying social studies education and guidance. After graduation in 1960, he stayed in the area and was hired by East Washington High School to teach social science with additional duties as the head coach of the football team. That would be the start of his lifetime dream—to coach football and teach young men.

A year later, Joe was back in his hometown as an assistant coach at Belle Vernon High School, and guidance counselor. But that wasn't enough for Sarra. He was also continuing his education, working part-time on a Master's Degree in secondary administration and counseling from the University of West Virginia, just across the state line from the football hotbeds of southwestern Pennsylvania. He did that in 1964, the same year he became an assistant coach at nearby Hempfield High School.

However, Joe wanted to be a head coach again. So, in 1967 he left western Pennsylvania for the hard coal region, becoming the head coach and social studies teacher at Southern Columbia High School. He loved his job but he wanted more. He had always wanted to coach in college, and in 1970 he had his chance, when Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, hired him as an assistant. Sarra never looked back.

The next season, 1971, Lafayette University came calling, and Joe spent the next 12 years there, first as the offensive coordinator until 1975 and then as the defensive coordinator. Now, Joe really fell in love—in love with defensive coaching. Joe knew he could coach defense at a higher level.


In 1984, Penn State hired Sarra as the inside linebackers coach. Nine years later, Sarra was promoted to defensive line coach, and he stayed there through the 1999 season, when he moved into the front office as an administrator, retiring in 2005.

Throughout his professional career, Joe was always involved in volunteer work for the communities he lived in. Perhaps his greatest service to the community and to Penn State was his dedication to the rehabilitation of Adam Taliaferro, the Penn State cornerback who was paralyzed in a game against Ohio State in 2000. Joe was the liaison with the Taliaferro family and spent many of his days with Adam and the family in the year that Adam recovered and was able to walk again.

His 3 children, Donalee, Renee' (Keith), & son Todd (Kim) who is also a PIAA official have attended sporting events since they were young enough to walk. He has 7 grandchildren who call him Poppy; Tyler, Collin, Tori, Parker, Austin, Marci & Mitchell. In his free time, Gene enjoys traveling, attending their sporting events & driving Poppy's taxi. He was blessed on his 81st birthday to attend Tori and Parker's swim meet for Hollidaysburg High school & is looking forward to summer baseball and dance recitals.
