



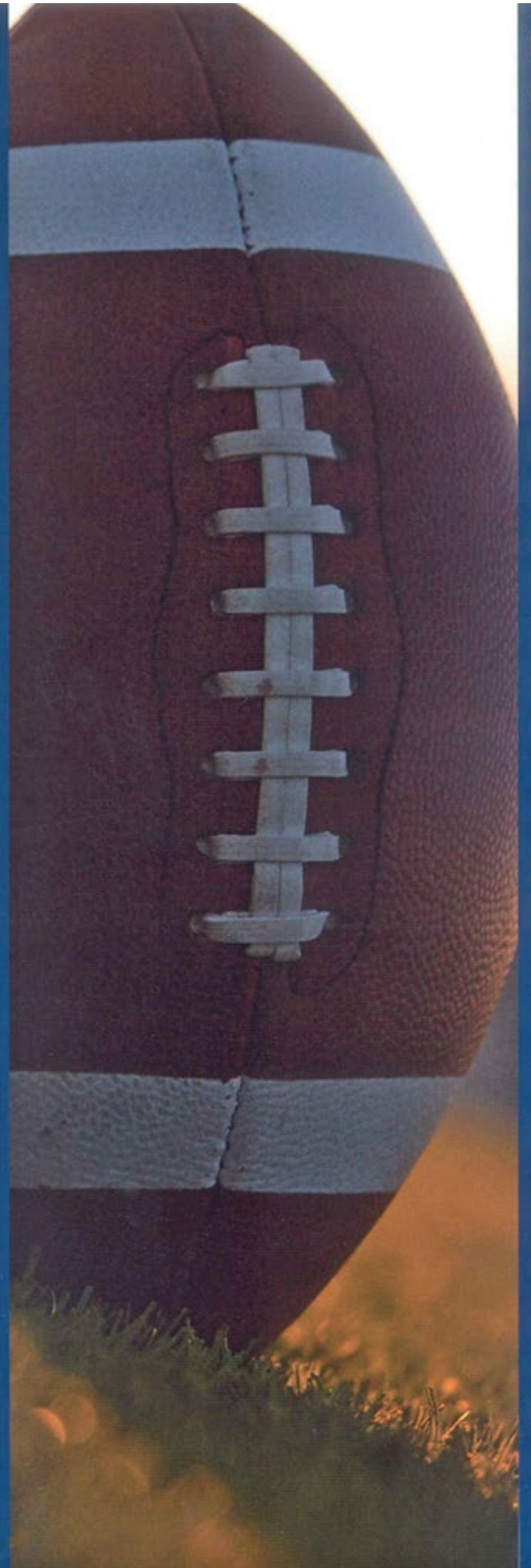

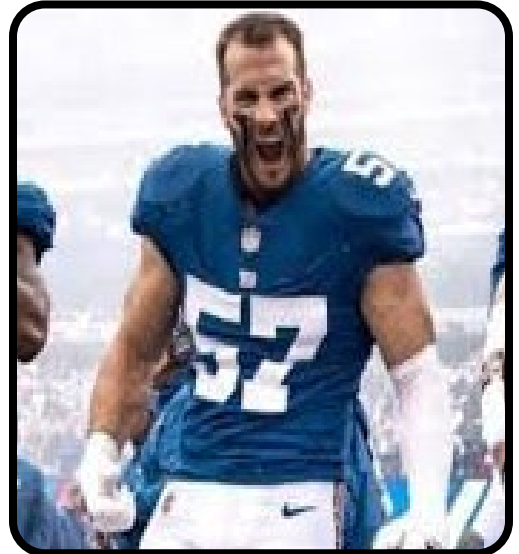
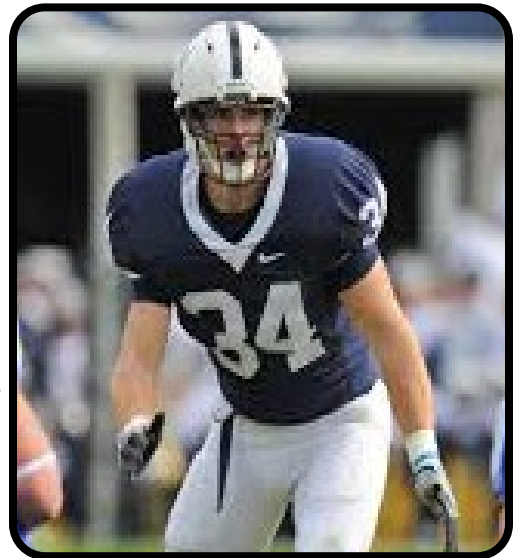
The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame, Central Pennsylvania Chapter, has selected former Penn State Linebacker and seven-year National Football League veteran Nate Stupar as guest speaker for its 23rd annual scholar-athlete awards dinner.

Stupar's time at Penn State exemplifies why he is a fitting choice to be this year's feature speaker, achieving athletic and academic success. Appearing in 52 games for the Blue & White, Stupar made 16 career starts amassing 205 career tackles with five sacks and four interceptions. He was also a member of Penn State's 2008 Big Ten Championship team. In the classroom, he was selected Academic All-Big Ten from 2008-10 and was a Dean's List student.

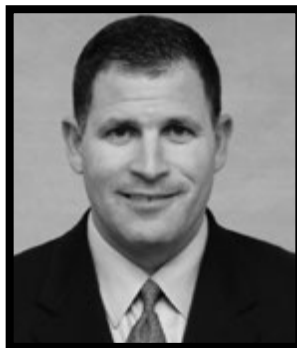
Stupar has been in the NFL for seven seasons, spending 2018 and part of 2019 as a member of the New York Giants. The seventh-round selection of the Oakland Raiders in 2012 NFL Draft, Stupar has been a contributor to several franchises while compiling 134 career tackles. He and his wife, Marissa, began the State of Hope Foundation in 2016 to provide children of low-income families, single parents, and others with less fortunate situations with positive life experiences that they may not be able to obtain otherwise.

At State College Area High School, Stupar enjoyed a decorated career on and off the field. As a senior, he was Pennsylvania & Mid-Penn Conference Defensive Player of the Year. He was selected first-team Associated Press all-state as a junior and senior. Stupar rated among the nation's top 10 defensive end/outside linebacker prospects in 2006 and was a 2007 Big 33 selection. Academically, he was a member of the State College Honor Roll.

"The Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation College Hall of Fame is privileged to have Nate Stupar as the featured speaker for our 23rd Annual Awards Dinner" said Chapter President John Kulka. "Nate graduated from State College Area High School and from Penn State where he excelled as a linebacker, then was drafted by the Oakland Raiders and is a seven-year NFL veteran. The Chapter is extremely pleased to have Nate back to share some of his career-shaping experiences with the outstanding student athletes from the high schools and colleges within the Central Pennsylvania Chapter."

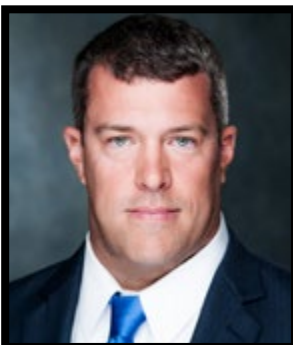

Community Service Award in Honor of Joe Sarra: Coach, Friend, Advisor

Joe Sarra was a football coach for 40 years, but he has been more than just a coach to most of the players, fellow coaches and football fans he met in his career. Joe was a friend and advisor to many of his players, an honest, hard worker to his coaching colleagues, and a caring and compassionate man to the thousands of other people met over the decades. Football and family has been his passion but helping others was his avocation.

Joe is typical of the Western Pennsylvania young men of his generation. They were the children of hard working blue collar families, sons of the tough and intense men who labored in the hot steel mills or underground in the dusty coal mines. Don't follow us, the fathers told them. Make something of yourself, they said. Go to college and get an education, they urged. And sports—particularly football -- was the way to do it.

Sarra left his home in Belle Vernon, 20 miles southeast of Pittsburgh, in 1956 and entered a small college down the road, then known as California State Teachers College. He went there to play football, and to be a teacher, studying social studies education and guidance. After graduation in 1960, he stayed in the area and was hired by East Washington High School to teach social science with additional duties as the head coach of the football team. That would be the start of his lifetime dream—to coach football and teach young men.

A year later, Joe was back in his hometown as an assistant coach at Belle Vernon High School, and guidance counselor. But that wasn't enough for Sarra. He was also continuing his education, working part-time on a Master's Degree in secondary administration and counseling from the University of West Virginia, just across the state line from the football hotbeds of southwestern Pennsylvania. He did that in 1964, the same year he became an assistant coach at nearby Hempfield High School.

However, Joe wanted to be a head coach again. So, in 1967 he left western Pennsylvania for the hard coal region, becoming the head coach and social studies teacher at Southern Columbia High School. He loved his job but he wanted more. He had always wanted to coach in college, and in 1970 he had his chance, when Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, hired him as an assistant. Sarra never looked back.

The next season, 1971, Lafayette University came calling, and Joe spent the next 12 years there, first as the offensive coordinator until 1975 and then as the defensive coordinator. Now, Joe really felt the passion of coaching defense. Joe knew he could coach defense at a higher level.

In 1984, Penn State hired Sarra as the inside linebackers coach. Nine years later, Sarra was promoted to defensive line coach, and he stayed there through the 1999 season, when he moved into the front office as an administrator, retiring in 2005.

Throughout his professional career, Joe was always involved in volunteer work for the communities he lived in. Perhaps his greatest service to the community and to Penn State was his dedication to the rehabilitation of Adam Taliaferro, the Penn State cornerback who was paralyzed in a game against Ohio State in 2000. Joe was the liaison with the Taliaferro family and spent many of his days with Adam and the family in the year that Adam recovered and was able to walk again.

Procedure for Selecting Award and Scholarship Winners

At the close of the scholastic football season, the president of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter sent a letter and nomination form to each of the 96 high school head football coaches in the centre region. Each school was asked to nominate one senior member from their football team qualify to receive an award from the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame. Each nomination form included a high school transcript and official test scores (SAT/ACT). The nomination forms, transcripts and test scores were forwarded to the scholarship selection committee. This committee is composed of knowledgeable representatives from our local chapter who were responsible for evaluating each of the nominees using the following three criteria established by the National office:

- Academic Achievement - 40%
- Athletic Achievement - 40%
- Extracurricular/Community Service Participation - 20%

The scholarship committee carefully evaluated each nominee and rank ordered them accordingly. The rank order was used to award \$1,000 postgraduate scholarships.

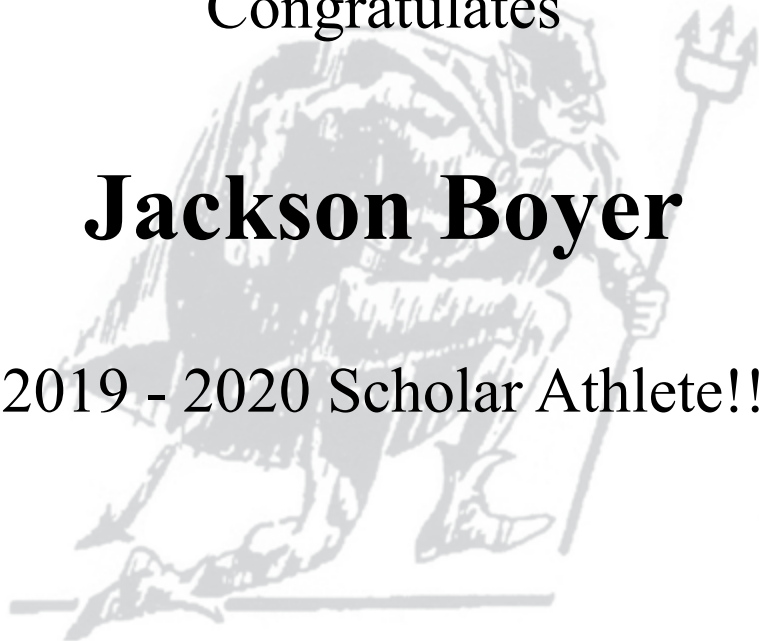

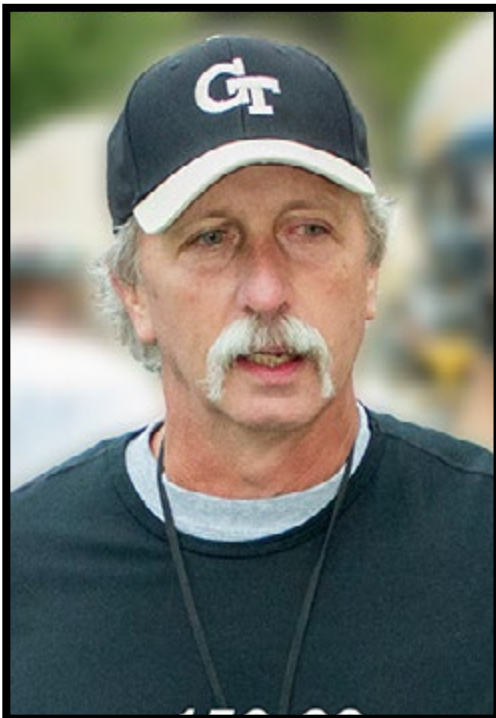

Tribute to Ron Pavlechko

On January 24, 2020 the State College community and the National Football Foundation, Central Pennsylvania Chapter were very saddened to hear of the passing of Ron Pavlechko. Affectionately known as “Pav,” he was the head coach and athletic director at State College High School for many years. He was also a long-time member of our chapter, serving two terms as president.

Pav came to State College in 1967, a member of one Joe Paterno’s first recruiting classes, and learned the lessons that would impact the lives of so many. As a coach and teacher he excelled at getting the most out of his students and athletes. Whether it was with his smile or a kind word, he made them each feel important. Simply put, when you interacted with Ron Pavlechko you left feeling better than you did before.

It’s well known that Pav would make a point to talk to each of his players every day about something other than football. It is a tradition that is still carried on to this day by the Little Lions staff.

Pav displayed many of those same traits during NFF board meetings. He was a tremendous listener who valued everyone’s input. In a room full of ex-coaches and players, his calming demeanor could diffuse any situation. The Centre Daily Times referred to Pav as a State College icon, and while that title would have embarrassed him, it is one that he most certainly deserved. It is with great reverence and gratitude that we honor our friend, leader and icon Ron Pavlechko for his contributions to the National Football foundation, Central Pennsylvania Chapter and to the game of football.
