

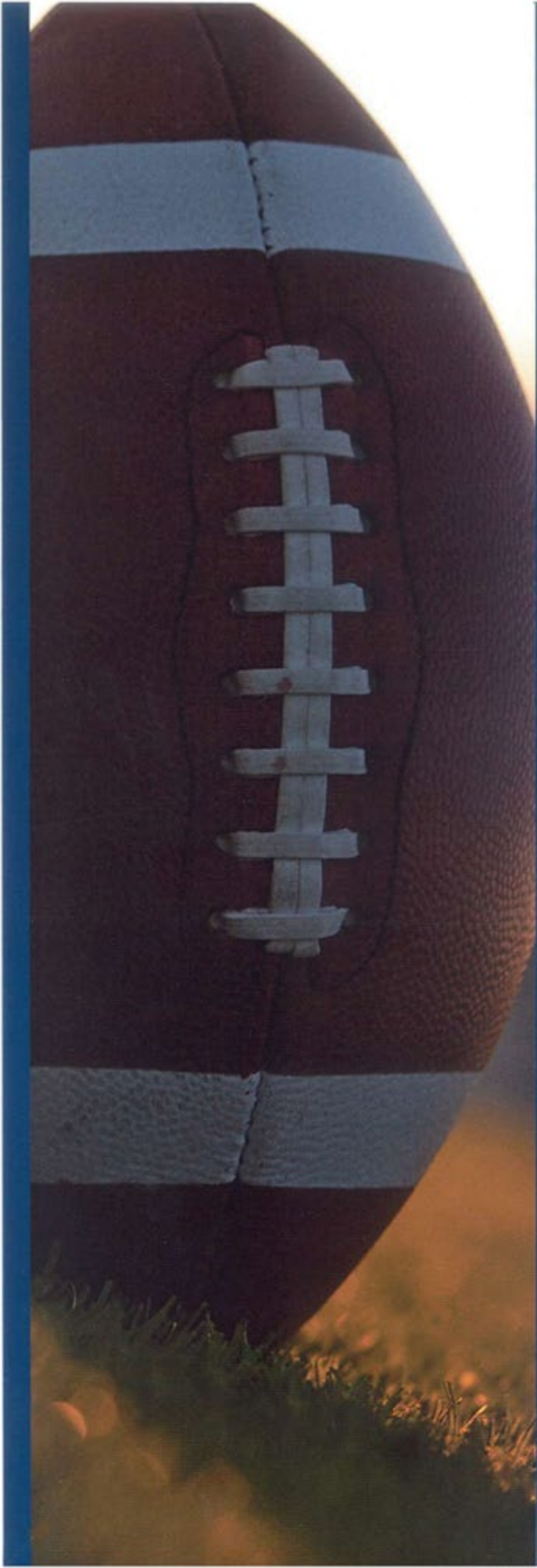

that she says was instilled in her at a young age growing up as a farm kid on her family’s third generation dairy farm.

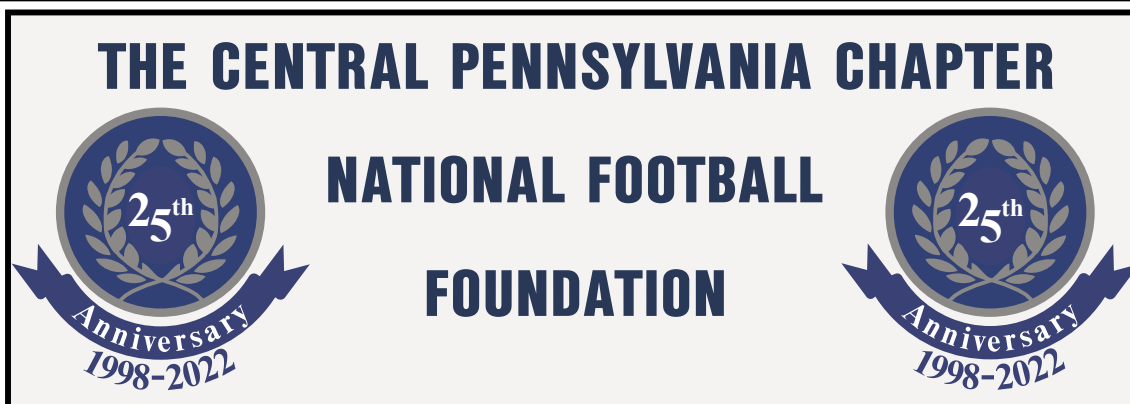

Andrew Janocko

Featured Speaker

The National Football Foundation, College Hall of Fame and the Central Pennsylvania Chapter, has selected Chicago Bears QB Coach, and Clearfield Alumni, Andrew Janocko, as the guest speaker to its 25th Annual Scholar-Athlete Awards banquet.

Janocko has been named the quarterback coach for the Chicago Bears for the 2022 NFL season. He will be working under Head Coach, Matt Eberflus. Janocko will be in charge of developing 2nd year quarterback, Justin Fields.

To highlight Janocko's most recent positions, he was the Minnesota's Vikings quarterback coach in his 7th season with the Vikings, and 9th overall in the NFL in 2021. He was also Minnesota's wide receivers coach during the 2020 season. Transitioning to coaching the quarterbacks and working alongside offensive coordinator Klint Kubiak in 2021, Janocko benefitted from his broad understanding of offensive coaching from the line to skill positions.

Janocko has an impressive coaching career coaching Vikings, Kirk Cousins. Cousins became the only QB in franchise history to have 3 seasons as a 3,000-yard passer, with a 1,000-yard rusher (Cook), and a 1,000-yard receiver (Jefferson). Cousins finished the season with a 103.1 passer rating, which is 4th best in the league.

On top of guiding Cousins to another record-setting season, Janocko helped to further develop Sean Mannion, who played in his first game since 2019 and made his third career start. Mannion threw for a career-high 189 yards and tallied his first career touchdown pass to WR K.J. Osborn.

Justin Jefferson had one of the best seasons in the history of the NFL for a rookie WR under Janocko in 2020. Jefferson finished his first season with an NFL rookie record 1,400 receiving yards (in the Super Bowl era) and a Vikings rookie record 88 catches, along with 7 TD's receiving. Jefferson became the first NFL rookie WR to earn Associated Press All-Pro honors (1st and 2nd team) since Randy Moss in 1998, earned a Pro Bowl berth and was named to the All-Rookie team. Veteran WR Adam Thielen finished with a career high 14 receiving TD's, the 5th most in team history and 3rd best mark in the NFL.

Janocko arrived in Minnesota after coaching QB's at Division II Mercyhurst during the 2014 season. At Mercyhurst, Janocko guided Brendan Boylan to 3 Pennsylvania State Athletics Conference West Division Offensive Player of the Week honors and a Division II National Player of the Week honor. Boylan finished the season 192-of-319 (60.2 percent) for 2,952 yards, 29 TD's and 8 INT's.

From 2012-13, Janocko received his first experience coaching at the NFL level when he served as an offensive assistant with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. While in Tampa Bay, Janocko was responsible for working with then-Head Coach Greg Schiano and Offensive Coordinator Mike Sullivan in coordinating practice schedules and breaking down film. In 2012, Janocko had a hands-on role with the quarterbacks and kick returners before working with WR's and KR's in 2013.

In 2011, Janocko served as a graduate assistant under Schiano at Rutgers with the QB unit.

A 3-year letter winner at Pitt, Janocko served as a backup QB and holder on special teams. Janocko spent his 1st 2 seasons as a walk-on before earning a scholarship his final 2 seasons. A 3-time member of the Big East All-Academic Team, he graduated from Pitt in 2010 with a degree in history and minor in political science.

A native of Clearfield, PA., Janocko was the starting QB at Clearfield Area High School, where his father, Tim, served as the head coach. He led the school to a pair of district championships and was a 2-time Pennsylvania Football News All-State honoree. Janocko is married to wife Natalie and they have a son, Noah. They currently reside in Chicago.

"The Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation College Hall of Fame is honored to have Andrew Janocko as the featured speaker for our 25th Annual Awards Banquet," said Chapter President John Kulka. "Andrew graduated from Clearfield Area High School and from the University of Pittsburgh. He was a former 2007 Central PA Chapter of the National Football Scholar-Athlete. The Chapter is extremely pleased to have Andrew back to share some of his career shaping experiences with the outstanding student athletes from the high schools and colleges within the Central Pennsylvania Chapter."

Community Service Award in Honor of Joe Sarra: Coach, Friend, Advisor

Joe Sarra was a football coach for 40 years, but he has been more than just a coach to most of the players, fellow coaches and football fans he met in his career. Joe was a friend and advisor to many of his players, an honest, hard worker to his coaching colleagues, and a caring and compassionate man to the thousands of other people met over the decades. Football and family has been his passion but helping others was his avocation.

Joe is typical of the Western Pennsylvania young men of his generation. They were the children of hard working blue collar families, sons of the tough and intense men who labored in the hot steel mills or underground in the dusty coal mines. Don't follow us, the fathers told them. Make something of yourself, they said. Go to college and get an education, they urged. And sports—particularly football -- was the way to do it.

Sarra left his home in Belle Vernon, 20 miles southeast of Pittsburgh, in 1956 and entered a small college down the road, then known as California State Teachers College. He went there to play football, and to be a teacher, studying social studies education and guidance. After graduation in 1960, he stayed in the area and was hired by East Washington High School to teach social science with additional duties as the head coach of the football team. That would be the start of his lifetime dream—to coach football and teach young men.

A year later, Joe was back in his hometown as an assistant coach at Belle Vernon High School, and guidance counselor. But that wasn't enough for Sarra. He was also continuing his education, working part-time on a Master's Degree in secondary administration and counseling from the University of West Virginia,

just across the state line from the football hotbeds of southwestern Pennsylvania. He did that in 1964, the same year he became an assistant coach at nearby Hempfield High School.

However, Joe wanted to be a head coach again. So, in 1967 he left western Pennsylvania for the hard coal region, becoming the head coach and social studies teacher at Southern Columbia High School. He loved his job but he wanted more. He had always wanted to coach in college, and in 1970 he had his chance, when Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, hired him as an assistant. Sarra never looked back.

The next season, 1971, Lafayette University came calling, and Joe spent the next 12 years there, first as the offensive coordinator until 1975 and then as the defensive coordinator. Now, Joe really felt the passion of coaching defense. Joe knew he could coach defense at a higher level.

In 1984, Penn State hired Sarra as the inside linebackers coach. Nine years later, Sarra was promoted to defensive line coach, and he stayed there through the 1999 season, when he moved into the front office as an administrator, retiring in 2005.

Throughout his professional career, Joe was always involved in volunteer work for the communities he lived in. Perhaps his greatest service to the community and to Penn State was his dedication to the rehabilitation of Adam Taliaferro, the Penn State cornerback who was paralyzed in a game against Ohio State in 2000. Joe was the liaison with the Taliaferro family and spent many of his days with Adam and the family in the year that Adam recovered and was able to walk again.

Fran Fisher Award “Excellence in Sports Journalism”: Jim Doyle & Andy Ulicny

Jim Doyle has been a constant voice of high school and college football for over 54 years on the radio. Within those years, he has spent the past 33 years teamed with analyst Andy Ulicny as the radio voices of Bloomsburg University and Berwick High School Football.

Jim has also been involved with the play-by-play calls of over 1,000 college and high school sporting events; including 26 high school state championship games.

Jim has been awarded: PSAC/s George Heslip Media Award, Induction into the Bloomsburg University Athletic Hall of Fame, Induction into the Berwick Area School District Sports Hall of Fame, Pennsylvania Association of Broadcasters (PAB) award for outstanding coverage of local sporting event (Bloomsburg University vs West Chester football), PA Football News Media Person of the Year Award, ECAC-SIDA Monahan/Wallace Media Award, has been recognized by both Berwick High School and Bloomsburg University for 50 years in radio, and honored by the PSAC as one of the top 10 contributors to the history of Bloomsburg University Football.

Jim resides in Bloomsburg, PA. Son of the late Leona and Chet Doyle.

Andy Ulicny is the son of Ann and Frank Ulicny; Shenandoah’s famed athlete, coach and Athletic Director. Second of ten children, all seven boys starred for the Blue Devils at Shenandoah Valley High School. After graduating from University of Pennsylvania, Ulicny was hired at Southern Columbia High School and joined the newly formed coaching staff. After a winless first season, Ulicny offered to head the program. With a fresh faced crew of coaches, including a young Jim Roth, this inexperienced group went 0-10 and continued a winless streak that stretched to an embarrassing state-long 27 game losing streak. Over the next three years the team improved to 4-5-1, then 9-3 (by far the schools best record), and finally 12-1 and an Eastern Conference Championship.

Ulicny turned the program over to Roth, now the winningest head football coach in Pennsylvania history. Missing football, Ulicny returned to the press box as color man and analyst with Jim Doyle in 1988. He has had the pleasure of broadcasting Berwick High School football on Friday nights including the most celebrated career of the legendary coach, George Curry. Ulicny also followed the SCA Tigers in all their playoff games. He has broadcast more Pennsylvania state championship games than anyone for the past 33 years.

Ulicny and Doyle have aired the Bloomsburg University Huskies. Like Doyle, he is a proud recipient of the George Heaslip Award, presented annually by the PSAC’s 14 member schools to one individual for excellence in media coverage. It is believed that their 33 years together as a broadcasting team covering Bloomsburg football is the current longevity record in the nation for all of college football. He is inducted into a number of local chapters of the PA Sports Hall of Fame, and his work along with Doyle, has also been presented the Pennsylvania Association of Broadcasters (PAB) Award for outstanding coverage of local sporting events.

Ulicny resides in Shenandoah Heights with his wife Deb, they have one daughter, Nicole.

Fisher also represented the best of scholastic football.

Prior to joining Penn State he broadcasted high school games for fifteen years in Greensburg and Lewistown.

The Fran Fisher Award will be presented annually to an individual who exemplifies the character and professionalism of Fran Fisher as they promote the values and goals of amateur football while applying their craft.

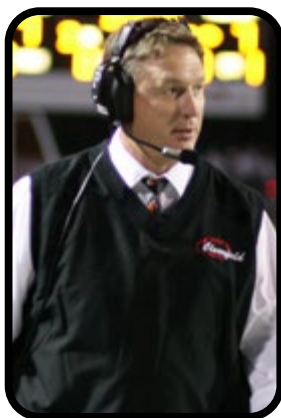

Lee Krull

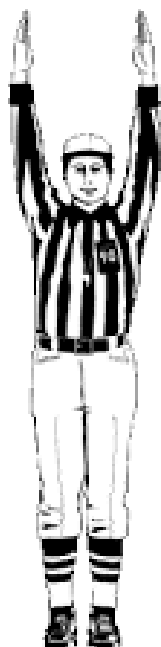

Procedure for Selecting Award and Scholarship Winners

At the close of the scholastic football season, the president of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter sent a letter and nomination form to each of the 96 high school head football coaches in the centre region. Each school was asked to nominate one senior member from their football team qualify to receive an award from the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame. Each nomination form included a high school transcript and official test scores (SAT/ACT). The nomination forms, transcripts and test scores were forwarded to the scholarship selection committee. This committee is composed of knowledgeable representatives from our local chapter who were responsible for evaluating each of the nominees using the following three criteria established by the National office:

- Academic Achievement - 40%
- Athletic Achievement - 40%
- Extracurricular/Community Service Participation - 20%

The scholarship committee carefully evaluated each nominee and rank ordered them accordingly. The rank order was used to award \$1,000 postgraduate scholarships.
