





## Stefen Wisniewski Featured Speaker

The National Football Foundation, College Hall of Fame and the Central Pennsylvania Chapter, has selected Two-Time Super Bowl Champion and former Penn State All-American offensive lineman Stefen Wisniewski as our Special Guest Speaker.

"The Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation College Hall of Fame is honored to have Stefen Wisniewski as the featured speaker for our 26th Annual Awards Banquet, said Chapter President Sam Phillips. The Chapter is extremely pleased to have Stefen back to share some of his career shaping experiences with the outstanding student athletes from the high schools and colleges within the Central Pennsylvania Chapter."

Stefen is a Penn State graduate of the Schreyer Honors College with a Secondary Education degree. Stefen achieved and maintained superlative academics while being a valued member of the Penn State Football team. Wisniewski became the first Penn State Football student-athlete to be named an ESPN Academic All-American three times, having been a first team selection in 2008, 2009 and 2010. He graduated with a 3.9 cumulative GPA. Wisniewski achieved at a high level on the playing field as well. He made 39 starts during his college career (2007-2010) at the guard/center positions on the offensive line. In 2010 he was a First Team All-American selection in 2009 as a guard and was named to the second team in 2008 at the same position. At the conclusion of his college career, Stefen was a 2nd round draft pick of the Oakland Raiders in the 2011 NFL draft. Stefen is a 10 year veteran of the NFL having played for five teams. He is also a two-time Super Bowl champion with the 2017 Philadelphia Eagles and



the 2019 Kansas City Chiefs. This is quite the accomplishment to win the Super Bowl twice let alone with two different franchises.







# Community Service Award in Honor of Joe Sarra: Coach, Friend, Advisor

Joe Sarra was a football coach for 40 years, but he has been more than just a coach to most of the players, fellow coaches and football fans he met in his career. Joe was a friend and advisor to many of his players, an honest, hard worker to his coaching colleagues, and a caring and compassionate man to the thousands of other people met over the decades. Football and family has been his passion but helping others was his avocation.

Joe is typical of the Western Pennsylvania young men of his generation. They were the children of hard working blue collar families, sons of the tough and intense men who labored in the hot steel mills or underground in the dusty coal mines. Don't follow us, the fathers told them. Make something of yourself, they said. Go to college and get an education, they urged. And sports particularly football -- was the way to do it.

Sarra left his home in Belle Vernon, 20 miles southeast of Pittsburgh, in 1956 and entered a small college down the road, then known as California State Teachers College. He went there to play football, and to be a teacher, studying social studies education and guidance. After graduation in 1960, he stayed in the area and was hired by East Washington High School to teach social science with additional duties as the head coach of the football team. That would be the start of his lifetime dream—to coach football and teach young men.

A year later, Joe was back in his hometown as an assistant coach at Belle Vernon High School, and guidance counselor. But that wasn't enough for Sarra. He was also continuing his education, working parttime on a Master's Degree in secondary administration and counseling from the University of West Virginia,

Nolan Weaver Bellefonte Area just across the state line from the football hotbeds of southwestern Pennsylvania. He did that in 1964, the same year he became an assistant coach at nearby Hempfield High School.

However, Joe wanted to be a head coach again. So, in 1967 he left western Pennsylvania for the hard coal region, becoming the head coach and social studies teacher at Southern Columbia High School. He loved his job but he wanted more. He had always wanted to coach in college, and in 1970 he had his chance, when Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, hired him as an assistant. Sarra never looked back.

The next season, 1971, Lafayette University came calling, and Joe spent the next 12 years there, first as the offensive coordinator until 1975 and then as the defensive coordinator. Now, Joe really felt the passion of coaching defense. Joe knew he could coach defense at a higher level.

In 1984, Penn State hired Sarra as the inside linebackers coach. Nine years later, Sarra was promoted to defensive line coach, and he stayed there through the 1999 season, when he moved into the front office as an administrator, retiring in 2005.

Throughout his professional career, Joe was always involved in volunteer work for the communities he lived in. Perhaps his greatest service to the community and to Penn State was his dedication to the rehabilitation of Adam Taliaferro, the Penn State cornerback who was paralyzed in a game against Ohio State in 2000. Joe was the liaison with the Taliaferro family and spent many of his days with Adam and the family in the year that Adam recovered and was able to walk again.

IRVING, Texas (June 23, 2022) – From a pool of 3,500 scholar-athletes from a nationwide Chapter Network, the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) announced today the 82 members of the 2022 NFF Team of Distinction. As part of its mission to promote the scholar-athlete ideal, the initiative allows the NFF to honor the top high school scholar-athletes from around the country as the best and the brightest at the local level while highlighting the work of the NFF Chapter Network.

The members of the team all played their final high school football season during the 2021-22 school year. As part of the award, all of the honorees will be part of a permanent digital display at the Chick-fil-A College Football Hall of Fame in Atlanta.


Criteria to make the team include but are not limited to academic achievement, athletic accolades and community involvement. Each chapter is limited to one honoree, distinguishing them as the top scholar-athlete from all the high schools covered by the chapter. ## Lifetime Achievement Award Winners: Coaches



John Franco Tyrone Area John Franco is a 1974 graduate of Bishop Guilfoyle High School in Altoona, PA. and a1978 graduate of IUP where he received both his BS and Master's Degrees in education. He began his coaching career as a Grad Assistant after playing from 1974-77 for IUP under Coach Bill Neal. Returning to Bishop Guilfoyle, John served as an assistant and associate head coach with Tom Irwin compiling a record of 55-25-1 with 2 Conference titles in 1982 and 1985 and one district championship in 1985. In 1986 John took over as head coach at Altoona Area HS compiling a record of 40-45-1 with Altoona's first district championship in 1988. Taking over as head coach at Tyrone in1994 and again in 2019 after a brief return to Altoona, John has compiled a record of 203 wins, 53 losses, 8 District titles, 5 trips to the Western Finals and 3 trips to the State Championship where his Tyrone team won the title in 1999. John resides in Altoona with his wife of 37 years, Sue. They have 4 children–Kristin, Kim, Johnny and Steve and are the proud grandparents of 3–Jack, Ava and Gia.





Larry Wiser Clarion Area Coach Wiser has been involved with football for most of his entire life. His total time as an assistant and head coach spanned forty-seven years. He has coached the Clarion Area Bobcats for 31 seasons, and 1 season with the Central Clarion Wildcats, compiling an overall record of 238-105-1. 



## Procedure for Selecting Award and Scholarship Winners

At the close of the scholastic football season, the president of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter sent a letter and nomination form to each of the 96 high school head football coaches in the centre region. Each school was asked to nominate one senior member from their football team qualify to receive an award from the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame. Each nomination form included a high school transcript and official test scores (SAT/ACT). The nomination forms, transcripts and test scores were forwarded to the scholarship selection committee. This committee is composed of knowledgeable representatives from our local chapter who were responsible for evaluating each of the nominees using the following three criteria established by the National office:

- Academic Achievement 40%
- Athletic Achievement 40%
- Extracurricular/Community Service Participation - 20%

The scholarship committee carefully evaluated each nominee and rank ordered them accordingly. The rank order was used to award \$1,000 postgraduate scholarships.
