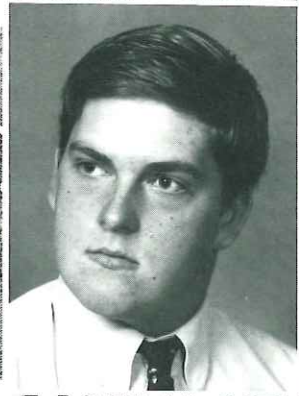

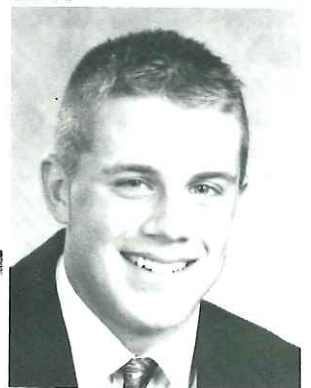

# KROELL ROLLS IT UP

## Penn State recruit Chad Kroell throws for three touchdowns to lead North to 39-26 victory in Uni-Mart Classic

State College -- Clearfield's Chad Kroell will be spending the next five years or so at Penn State.

On Saturday, the record-breaking quarterback wanted to give the 3,800 people in attendance at State College Memorial Field their money's worth.

He did that and more.

Kroell completed 12 of 22 passes for 206 yards and three touchdowns to lead the North to a 39-26 victory over the South in the 11th annual Uni-Mart Classic.

I really wanted to make a good showing, said Kroell, who earned the offensive MVP honors. I am going to be here for a while and I wanted to show people what I could do.

Kroell's first two touchdowns passes showed plenty.

On the North's first play from scrimmage, Kroell hit Clearfield teammate Adam Gibson for a 68-yard scoring play that erased an early 6-0 South advantage.

That's a play we frequently use during the season, Kroell said. He was wide open and I got him the ball.

That play works all the time, Gibson added. I think we have used that five time during the season and it has worked every time.

The South answered with 13-yard run by Huntingdon's Wes Green, but the extra point missed with 8:31 left in the first quarter.

Trailing 12-7, the North got the ball back and Kroell found Penns Valley tight end Kenny Grubb over the middle for a 43-yard scoring play. The touchdown and extra point by DuBois's Kevin Bowser gave the North a 14-12 lead with 4:54 left in the first quarter.

It was a tight end delay, Grubb said. I got into the seam and Chad got me the ball. I just had to get around one guy and I was able to do that.

With Lewistown's Justin Henry at the controls, the South took a 20-14 lead into halftime. Mount Union's Tink Stennett scored on a seven-yard run with 2:14 left in the half. Henry found Huntingdon's Jeff Closz on the two-point conversion.

Stennett and Green ran for 92 and 76 yards respectively for the South. Green, however, earned offensive MVP honors for the South. Playing just the first half, Henry completed 6 of 14 passes for 163 yards.

The North's defense did a better job in the second half controlling Green and Stennett. It also had an easier time containing Central's Andy Krider, who completed 3 of 6 passes for 49 yards.

Lock Haven's Scott Eberle took over for Kroell in the second half and had a rough time of it. Eberle missed all three passing attempts and was sacked four times.

Kroell was back in control in the fourth quarter. In their second drive of the stanza, the North went 56 yards in nine plays and Bald Eagle Nittany's Steve Hill got the touchdown on a five-yard run with 5:48 left. Bowser's extra point gave the North the lead for good at 21-20.

Jersey Shore's Steve Sechrist set up the North's next scoring opportunity when he sacked Krider at the 16 and recovered the ensuing fumble.

Kroell immediately took advantage finding his favorite target Wes Dahlem in the back of the end zone for a 28-20 lead.

We run that play all the time, Kroell said. I just throw it up there and Wes comes down with it.

On the ensuing kickoff, Dahlem, however, was carried off the field when he took a helmet in the calf. For the game, Dahlem, also Penn State bound, caught five passes for 49 yards.

The North capped its scoring with a 31-yard field goal from Bowser in the fourth quarter and a 57-yard interception return by Lock Haven's Justin Stoner with just over eight minutes left. Green scored his third touchdown of the night for the South with just under two minutes left.

State College's Mike Gahagan capped the game for the North when he intercepted a halfback-option pass by Stennett.

Gahagan summed up the feeling of his North teammates.

This is the most fun I have ever had playing high school football he said.

North coach Tim Janocko added: All the kids had great nights. There are a lot of great memories out there.

NOTES: The defensive MVP honors went to the South's Jason Showalter of Juniata Valley and Scott Latosky of Moshannon Valley. . . . Uni-Mart's scholarship were presented to Bellefonte's Jeff Wetzler, West Branch's Hays Bickel, Bald Eagle Nittany's Steve Hill, Central's Andy Krider, Hollidaysburg's Shawn Hoyer, an Indian Valley's Chris Fultz. . . . Former Miami Dolphin kicker Gary Yprimian was on hand to give a kicking exhibition at halftime. . . . North inside linebackers Bellefonte's Josh Leitzell and State College's Jon Sandusky also had big nights with seven and five tackles, respectively. Bald Eagle Area's Chad Packer added a fumble recovery. . . . The 65 points were the most ever scored in this all-star game.

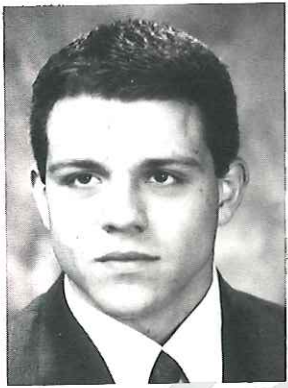

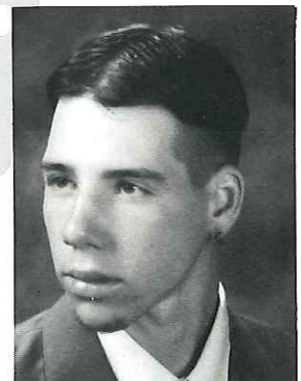

# PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

## Player Selection:

1. Their head coach nominates Graduating Senior players in writing in December.
  - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)

## Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division – North and South
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five Associate Coaches.

# A Classic History

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewistown Lion Club were great football games, but were short lived.

In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools.

In 1993, Uni-Mart, Inc. became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. Currently, there are thirty schools from District VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$33,000 in the form of sixty-six scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the Classic is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

The Uni-Mart Classic is considered as one of the premiere all-star football games in Pennsylvania. It is a tribute to our sponsors and co-sponsors, to the individual players sponsors, the business card and patron sponsors, and to families and friends of scholastic football in the Central Pennsylvania region.

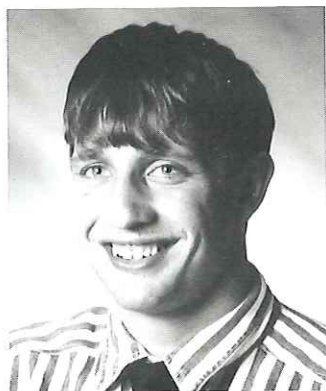

## CLASSICAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT

How are the funds raised?  
Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past twelve years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic - 1) individual player sponsors provide for the one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

Basically, the game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty school comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Uni-Mart Classic.

# UNI-MART FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

## OFFENSIVE RESTRICTIONS:

Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may not align in trips, but motion is permitted. Each team must attempt passes on 30% of the offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If under the 30% passes have been thrown, each non-pass play will be penalized as unsportsmanlike conduct until the percentage is met and maintained. Forced scrambles and sacks shall be counted as pass percentage.

## DEFENSIVE RESTRICTIONS:

Must align in basic 5-2 with a man on the center, a man on each tackle, a man on each end (or outside the defensive tackle on a split end side.) Linebackers must be over the guards and deeper than the heels of the defensive tackles. Secondary may be man or zone in any desired scheme. Defensive ends (one or both may drop for pass coverage) but must start in alignment outside defensive tackle on or off the line. There shall be no blitzing or shooting linebackers or secondary. Slanting & Looping by front five is permitted.

## SPECIAL FOR KICKING GAME:

In kicking game situations the linebackers may move up onto line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end); however, no more than 7 may rush on any one play.

## SPECIAL FOR GOAL-LINE:

Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or a touchdown, the linebackers may move as close to the line as desired, and the secondary may place two men on the line (secondary men must be outside the defensive end). After a score by either team, a team that is behind by 9 or more points will have the choice to kick-off or receive.

## PLAYING TIME:

Each player must participate for at least 15 plays.

## TIME SPECIFICATIONS:

Quarters 1 and 3 will be 12 minutes  
Quarters 2 and 4 will be 15 minutes

## TIE BREAKER:

If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie.
