# Big Plays Lead to North Victory

BEN'S Weaver makes the huge pass plays, while South's offense never gets untracked.

STATE COLLEGE — As North quarterback Shawn Weaver rolled right — bodies flying at him and arms swarming at the ball — the Bald Eagle Nittany graduate calmly bounced off a pair of would-be tacklers and continued scoping out his receivers.

Then Weaver, with just over a minute remaining in the half and his North team leading 7-0, showed off the right arm that earned him a baseball scholarship to Old Dominion. He fired downfield to Lock Haven's Joe Hanna, who waiting patiently for the spiral after sneaking behind the secondary, hauled in a 41-yard reception at the South 14.

The North was on its way to a 20-7 win, and just as it had all game, the North made the big play and the South didn't.

"That's the game right there," said South coach John Franco. "We had the opportunity to make the big plays. We didn't. They did."

On a muggy night in crowded Memorial Field, that's just what happened. Weaver made several big plays on offense, including a 46-yard completion to Hanna on a third-and-12 late in the fourth quarter that set up the North's final touchdown.

"That was just a super effort by a super athlete," said North coach Howie Camberg.

Weaver, who finished 5-of-7 for 112 yards, helped a North offense outplay the South's highly-touted counterpart that boasted a stable of speedy tailbacks. And while the North's offense may have been overlooked leading up to the game, Camberg and the rest of his team knew there was talent along the offensive line, in the backfield and in the receiving corps.

"We didn't get as much credit as we should have," said North tailback Justin Ingram, a Clearfield graduate.

After the game, however, there was no shortage of praise for the unit that helped the North control the game.

"Our big linemen up front were huge," Weaver said. "They just controlled the whole ballgame."

And Camberg couldn't have been happier.

"Our offensive line worked so hard all week," he said. "We worked very hard to put an offensive team out there that could control the ground game and mix in the pass."

That's exactly what the North did on its second possession. Starting at its own 19, the North methodically drove 76 yards on 13 plays in — ending with Ingram's 2-yard touchdown run after taking nearly six minutes off the clock — to score first. Clearfield's Eric Kaufman, on his way to winning the offensive most valuable player award for the North, added his first of two extra points and the North led, 7-0, with 14:25 left in the half.

Meanwhile, the South, which boasted fleet-footed J.J. Easter of Mount Union and Marcus Owens of Tyrone at tailback, wasn't able to get much going all game.

"They had a real good defensive scheme," said Owens, who was limited to 24 yards on eight carries. "We thought we could run up the middle, but we couldn't."

The North, though, seemed to enjoy success running up the middle whenever it needed. Sparked by the between-the-tackles running of Curwensville's Josh McBride and Bucktail's Dennis Getz, the North added the first of Kaufman's two 23-yard field goals with 18 seconds left in the half to take a 10-0 lead into intermission.

In the second half, the North picked up right where it left off. This time led by the passing of Moshannon Valley quarterback J.R. Baughman — who was 3 of 5 for 51 yards on the drive — the North received its second Kaufman field goal to increase its lead to 13-0 with 8:54 left in the third quarter.

After each team was unable to sustain a long drive, the South came up with its first big play of the night when Mount Union's Lanny Ramey intercepted a Baughman attempt and returned it 25 yards to the North 40 just over one minute into the fourth quarter.

However, the South offense stalled again. After trading punts though, the South came to life. Tyrone's Jarrod Anderson found Altoona's George Bailey open in the end zone from six yards out, and after the successful extra point, the South was withing 13-7 with 8:04 left.

The rest of the way the South was unable to make the elusive big play Franco talked about. And when the North was stuck in a third-and-12 with less than three minutes in the game, Weaver again came up big, this time with a 43-yard hook up with Hanna.

Two plays later, McBride bull-dozed his way into the end zone from two-yards out and the North had its win.

"They came out and played hard," Owens said. "And they made the plays."

Along with Kaufman who won the Offensive MVP for the North Bucktail defensive lineman Justin Ditty received the Defensive MVP award.

For the South, Easter was the Offensive MVP while Tyrone defensive lineman Jonathan Seiner was the defensive recipient.

As for the scholarship award winners, they were the following: The Sponsor Award given by Uni-Mart went to the Juniata Valley's Trevore Broadbent and West Branch's Kyle Hubler; The Co-Sponsor Award given by the Centre Daily Times, WRSC/WBLF radio station; and Snappy's went to Moshannon Valley's Bill Raab and Central's Matt Lehman; The Business and Patrons Sponsor Award went to State College's Mark Hagen and Southern Huntingdon's Ray Rosenberry. The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association Award went to Glendale's Paul McClellan and Williamsburg's Mike Hoover.

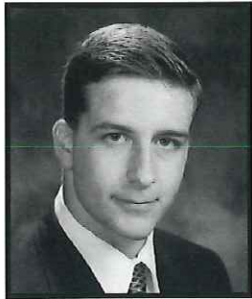

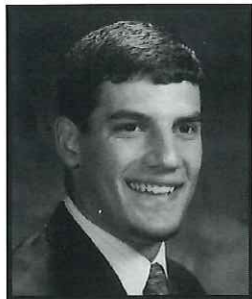

# PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

## Player Selection:

1. Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
  - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)

## Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division -- North and South.
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five Associate Coaches.

# A Classic History

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewistown Lion Club were "great football games," but were short lived.

In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence on our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools.

In 1993, Uni-Mart, Inc. became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. Currently, there are thirty schools from District VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$41,000 in the form of eighty-one scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the "Classic" is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

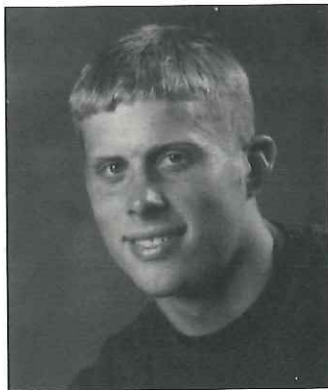

## CLASSICAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT

How are the funds raised?  
Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past thirteen years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for the one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

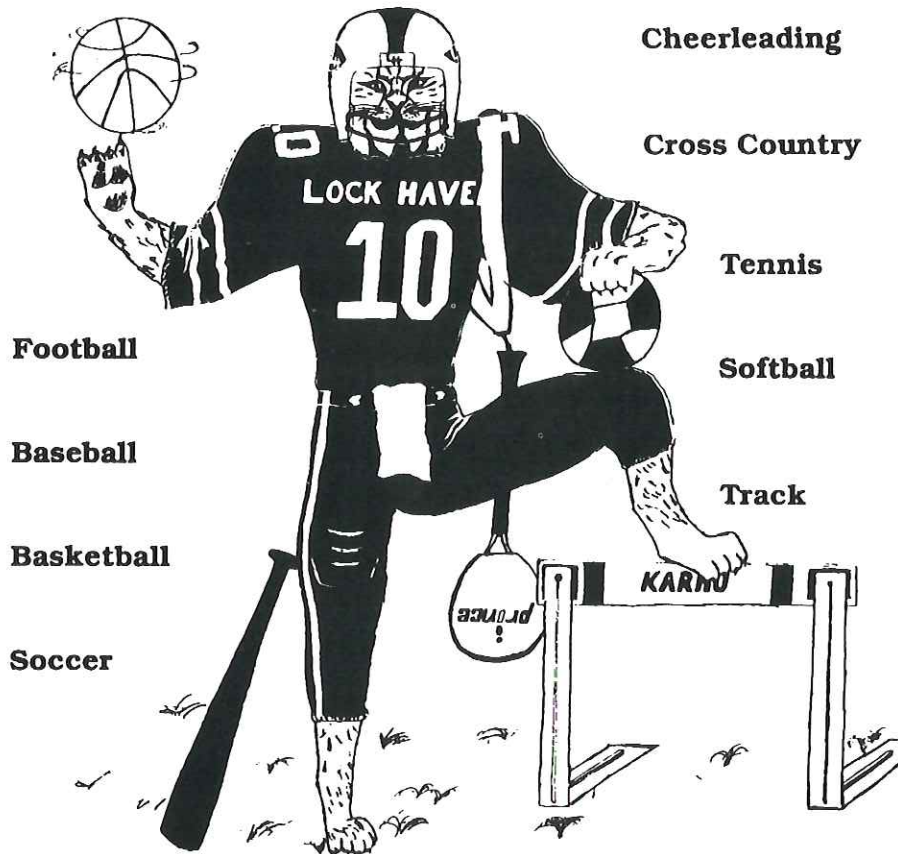
On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

Basically, the game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty school comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Lezzer Lumber Classic.

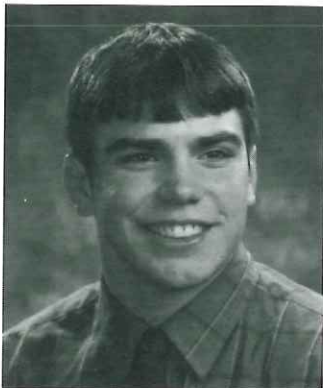

# UNI-MART FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

## OFFENSIVE RESTRICTIONS:

Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30% of the offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If under the 30% passes have been thrown, each non-pass play will be penalized as unsportsmanlike conduct until the percentage is met and maintained.

Forced scrambles and sacks shall be counted as pass percentage.

## DEFENSIVE RESTRICTIONS:

Must align in basic 5-2 with a man on the center, a man on each tackle, a man on each end (or outside the defensive tackle on a split end side.) Linebackers must be over the guards and deeper than the heels of the defensive tackles. Secondary may be man or zone in any desired scheme. Defensive ends (one or both may drop for pass coverage) but must start in alignment outside defensive tackle on or off the line. There shall be no blitzing or shooting linebackers or secondary. Slanting & Looping by front five is permitted.

## SPECIAL FOR KICKING GAME:

In kicking game situations the linebackers may move up onto line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end); however, no more than 7 may rush on any one play.

## SPECIAL FOR GOAL-LINE:

Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or a touchdown, the linebackers may move as close to the line as desired, and the secondary may place two men on the line (secondary men must be outside the defensive end). After a score by either team, a team that is behind by 9 or more points will have the choice to kick-off or receive.

## PLAYING TIME:

Each player must participate for at least 15 plays.

## TIME SPECIFICATIONS:

Quarters 1 and 3 will be 12 minutes

Quarters 2 and 4 will be 15 minutes

## TIE BREAKER:

If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie.
