# The all-star's all-star

## South 35 North 7

### Huntingdon's Kozak shines bright as South dominates annual classic

Bellefonte – Either someone had an itchy trigger finger or the football gods were saying enough was enough. Because with 4 minutes, 20 seconds left in the fourth quarter of the Lezzer Lumber Football Classic on Friday, a bank of lights on the North sideline at Rogers Stadium went dark.

By then, the shades had already been drawn on the mid-summer all-star game. Behind yet another brilliant display by Huntingdon's Geoff Kozak, the South team registered a thorough 35-7 win, its fourth straight in the series. It was the most lopsided win in the 20-year history of the contest.

"They got a few plays on us and that's what made the difference," said North lineman Josh Belcher of Penns Valley. "I think we stayed toe-to-toe with them the whole game. You just always have one or two of those plays." With Kozak, deceptively quick at 6 feet and 177 pounds, it was a lot more than one or two plays. Kozak, who took a good majority of the snaps for the South after Central's Paul Frederick went down with appendicitis, did it all in earning the South's offensive Most Valuable Player award. He completed 11-of-19 passes for 148 yards and a touchdown and rushed nine times for 66 yards and another score. He also caught a 31-yard pass on a flea-flicker. Oh, and he kicked three extra points, ran for a two-point conversion and punted once for 36 yards.

"Kozak was a lot more than what we could handle," said North coach Dave Lintal. "He's just such a good athlete. What are you going to do – they had us out-gunned. They were good but he was the difference in the game without a doubt." "He impressed me a lot," said North's Scott Koch of State College. "His quickness was up there with anyone I've played in my career."

The South scored two touchdowns on fourth down plays, punted only once and had the North on its heels for the better part of three quarters. The South had 416 yards of total offense to 94 for the North. The South held the North to eight yards in the second half and outrushed the North 237-71. "We got what we were hoping for," said South coach Jack Krider, the former coach at Central. "We wanted to get the ball to the guys we felt could make the plays." Gifford Piper of Hollidaysburg led the South with 72 yards rushing on 14 carries. He rushed for two touchdowns and had another on a 59-yard reception just before halftime. Lucas Stewart of Indian Valley added 54 yards, all coming in the second half. Eight different players caught a pass for the South.

Koch, the offensive MVP for the North, gained 35 yards on 11 carries. Kevin Suhey, a Penn State recruit, finished 3-of-6 for 22 yards. He added an interception on defense. "I'm officially a spectator," Lintal said. "I'm ready for a break." The way things started, it appeared the game would be a back-and-forth slugfest. The South opened the game with an impressive 14-play march during which three different players ran the ball and four different players caught the ball. Josh DeStefano took an option pitch from Kozak and scampered 14 yards on a fourth-and-4 for the game's first touchdown. Koch blocked the extra point.

The North answered in kind with a 14-play drive of its own, which wound up being its bright spot. Koch's five-yard run on the second play of the second quarter. Chris Gould, the North defensive MVP, added the extra point for a 7-6 lead. Gould, of Central Mountain and bound for Virginia, finished with a 42.8 average on six punts. After the North squandered an interception by Suhey, Kozak guided the South on a 10-play, 66-yard drive capped off by Piper's seven-yard score on a fourth-and-2. The march began with a flea-flicker pass from wideout Jarvis Reeves to Kozak, who began the play at quarterback then snuck down the right side. Following another North three-and-out, the South seized control when Kozak connected with Piper near the left sideline before Piper slipped the tackle of Nathan Shadeck and raced 59 yards for the score, which put the South ahead 21-7.

"Our offense just stalled," Koch said. "We didn't really play that bad defensively. They got some big plays on third-and-longs and that turned it around for them." The South scored on its first two possessions of the second half – a mystifying 26-yard keeper by Kozak and a two-yard plunge by Piper – to go ahead 35-7.

# PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

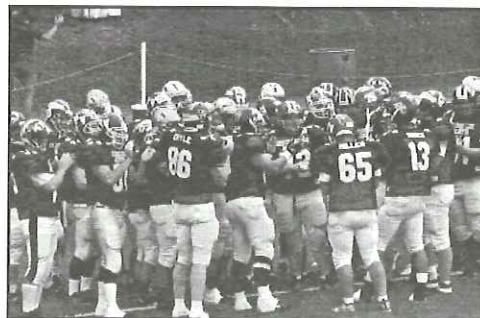
## Player Selection:

1. Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
  - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)

## Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division -- North and South.
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five Associate Coaches.

# A Classic History

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewistown Lion Club were "great football games," but were short lived.

In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools. Uni-Mart replaced Mid-State Bank as the game sponsor in 1993. Since 1996, Jack Bailey and Rob Irwin have served as Co-Game Directors for the Classic.

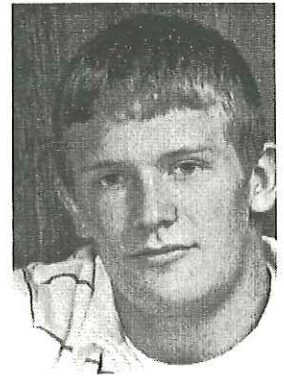
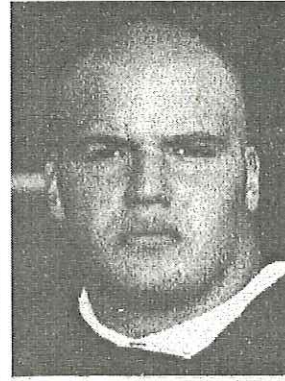
In 1998, the Lezzer Lumber Company became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. We are proud to continue our association with the Lezzer Lumber as the corporate sponsor. Currently, there are thirty schools from District III, VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$69,000 in the form of 138 scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the "Classic" is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

The Lezzer Lumber Classic is considered as one of the premiere all-star football games in Pennsylvania. It is a tribute to our sponsors and co-sponsors, to the individual players sponsors, the business card and patron sponsors, and to families and friends of scholastic football in the Central Pennsylvania region. ## CLASSICAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT

How are the funds raised?  
Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past seventeen years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

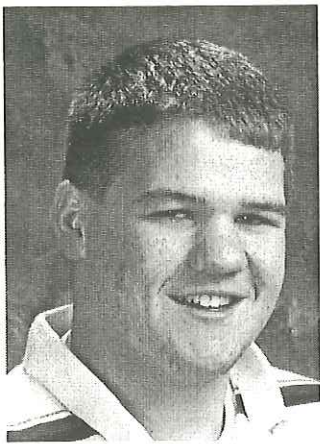
There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for the one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

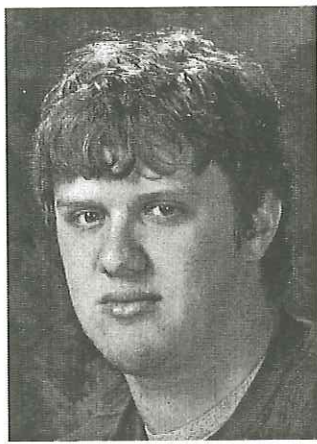
Basically, the game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty school comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Lezzer Lumber Classic.

## LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

**OFFENSIVE RESTRICTIONS:** Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30% of the offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If under the 30% passes have been thrown, each non-pass play will be penalized as unsportsmanlike conduct until the percentage is met and maintained. Forced scrambles and sacks shall be counted as pass percentage.

**DEFENSIVE RESTRICTIONS:** Must align in basic 5-2 with a man on the center, a man on each tackle, a man on each end (or outside the defensive tackle on a split end side.) Linebackers must be over the guards and deeper than the heels of the defensive tackles. Secondary may be man or zone in any desired scheme. Defensive ends (one or both may drop for pass coverage) but must start in alignment outside defensive tackle on or off the line. There shall be no blitzing or shooting linebackers or secondary. Slanting & Looping by front five is permitted.

**SPECIAL FOR KICKING GAME:** In kicking game situations the linebackers may move up onto line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end): however, no more than 7 may rush on any one play.

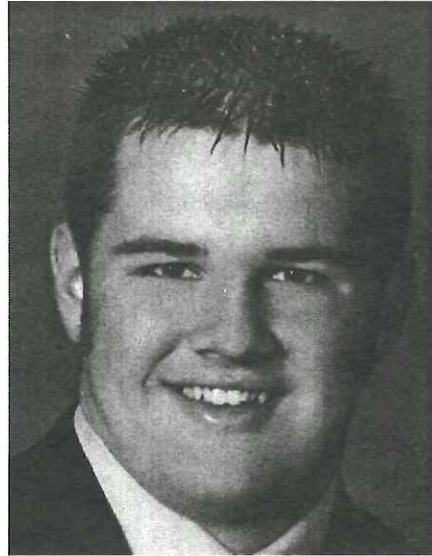
**SPECIAL FOR GOAL-LINE:** Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or a touchdown, the linebackers may move as close to the line as desired, and the secondary may place two men on the line (secondary men must be outside the defensive end). After a score by either team, a team that is behind by 9 or more points will have the choice to kick-off or receive.

**PLAYING TIME:** Each player must participate for at least 15 plays.

**TIME SPECIFICATIONS:** Quarters 1 and 3 will be 12 minutes  
Quarters 2 and 4 will be 15 minutes

**TIE BREAKER:** If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie.
