Team Chemistry pushes North to victory

Huntingdon—Jeff Vroman noticed it Tuesday, the second day of practice. Seth Nyman sensed it the following day during an intra-squad scrimmage. On Saturday, when it mattered most, the chemistry was still there.

Riding an offense that looked as if it had been together for months and a swarming defense that rarely gave ground, the North beat the South 35-20 Saturday night to win the 21st Lezzer Lumber Football Classic at War Veterans Field.

While the final score may indicate a closely-played contest, it was a rather lopsided affair that saw the North break the South's four-game win streak that included a 35-7 rout in last year's contest.

What's more impressive is that the North abandoned its strategy of alternating quarterbacks and instead stuck with Clearfield's Tanner Kelly, who threw two touchdowns—both to State College's Brady Hart—and ran for another to earn offensive Most Valuable Player honors for the North.

Kelly, who will attend Shippensburg University in the fall completed 10 of 14 passes for 140 yards and also rushed 11 times for 27 yards. The plan coming into the game was for Kelly and Hart to share the quarterback duties. But things were going so well with Hart lining up as a slot receiver that Kelly wound up taking every snap under center.

"All week we had been alternating at quarterback and slot receiver," said Hart, who will attend Yale. "He knew where I was going to be and I knew where he was going to be looking and I knew where some of the holes in the defense were. We were on the same page because we were running the same positions. We were going to rotate on and off but it was just working so well."

Vroman, the North head coach, said that Hart turned down playing quarterback at halftime.

I asked Brady at halftime if he wanted to go in and he told me, I'm fine doing what I'm doing," Vroman said. "That was fine with me. He really contributed on offense. When you have an athlete like that, it's nice to utilize him in different places."

Hart finished with five catches for 62 yards. He also rushed two times for 2 yards and booted two touchbacks on kickoffs.

Nyman, a Bald Eagle Area product who played linebacker for the North, said it was apparent during a mid-week scrimmage that things were going to run smoothly once game time arrived.

"You could just tell by how we played in practice," he said. "During the scrimmage we had Wednesday, they were connecting on offense and our defense was clicking. It was running on all cylinders. It was awesome to get the win tonight. It was great to be a part of this team."

The North thoroughly dominated the first half, logging three methodical scoring drives and outgained the South 203-78 to build a 21-0 lead at halftime.

After the South got on the board in the third quarter, the North answered with two more touchdowns to take a commanding 35-6 lead. The South closed the game with a pair of fourth-quarter scores.

"I thought we were alright," said South head coach Mike Smith of Juniata Valley. "Offensively, it just took us a little time to get rolling. We moved the ball. I was pretty happy with how we were making plays offensively."

Kelly efficiently guided the North offense through the first two quarters, completing 8-12 passes for 110 yards and a touchdown to Hart. After forcing a three-and-out on the South's first possession of the game, the North went 65 yards on 14 plays as Kelly dove in from 1 yard out for a 7-0 lead.

On the next drive, the South turned it over on downs, giving the North the ball at its own 33-yard line.

The North converted a pair of third downs and got two nice completions from Kelly to set up the second score. Kelly hit Hart for 13 yards after scrambling out of the pocket on a third-and-11. Then, faced with a third-and-2 at the South's 33, Kelly lofted a perfect fade pass toward the left sideline and wide receiver Lou LaFuria of Philipsburg-Osceola fought off South cornerback Derrick Hoffer to come down with the ball at the South 1. On the next play, Josh Harbold, Kelly's teammate at Clearfield, sprinted to the right corner of the end zone to give the North a 14-0 lead.

Following another South three-and-out, Hart hauled in a 9-yard touchdown pass from Kelly with 36 seconds left in the half to cap a 12-play, 75-yard march that was highlighted by Harbold's 43-yard halfback option pass to Colby Welshans of Central Mountain. That play got the North down to the South 17 and after a 4-yard loss on a fumble by Curwensville's Nate Sipes, Kelly found Hart open in the slot for the score and the North had all the momentum heading into the locker room.

"We knew there were some things we could do to try to exploit them. We tried to do that," Vroman said.

South quarterback Tyson Maugle's 35-yard sprint up the left sideline got the South on the board with 5:01 remaining in the third quarter. During the drive, the South executed the hook-and-ladder play for a 26-yard pickup after Maugle connected with Huntingdon's Matt Young for 13 yards before Young pitched to Dustin Hoffmaster, who rumbled 13 more yards up the sideline to the North 43.

According to the game rules, the South could elect to receive the ensuing kickoff since it still trailed by nine or more points. The North kicked off but Maugle fumbled on the fourth play of the next drive and Philipsburg-Osceola's Ron Pollock recovered at the South 46 to set up the next score.

LaFuria made a difficult one-handed catch on first down for a 26-yard gain to the South 20. It took six straight running plays before Bellefonte's Josh Jones bulled in for a 3-yard score on the first play of the fourth quarter to make it 28-6.

LaFuria had three catches for 61 yards.

"They were very sharp. They sustained drives and didn't make mistakes," Smith said. "They gelled real well."

P-O's Jeff Winters intercepted a Dan Beatty pass on the ensuing drive and returned it to the South 30 before a personal foul penalty on the South put the North in scoring position again.

On first-and-goal from the 4, Kelly rolled to his left and found Hart wide open in the front portion of the end zone to push the margin to 35-6.

"I like catching passes," Hart said. "It's fun whenever the play ends up in your hands rather than throwing it. That way I can get the ball in the open field."

Young caught a 9-yard touchdown from Maugle with 5:16 remaining before Ben Gummo of Tyrone swept in for a 4-yard score with 52 seconds remaining to account for the South's final points.

"We probably could have exploited their pass defense a little more," Smith said. "I thought we could throw on them pretty easily."

Brice Mertiff, a Class AA first team all-state running back at Tyrone, rushed for a game-high 95 yards on 21 carries but had just one run longer than 7 yards.

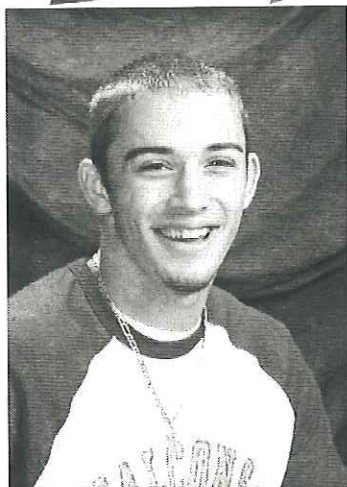
"We took care of the cut back and we stayed home," said Vroman. "I thought we were really aggressive. They got outside on us a couple of times but when it came down to it I thought we played good position defense."

Maugle, who starred at Hollidaysburg and is headed to Penn, was selected as the South's offensive MVP after completing 8 of 12 passes for 197 yards and rushing for 35 yards on seven carries.

Pollock, who will attend East Stroudsburg along with Winters, earned the defensive MVP award for the North while Mount Union's Trey McClain was the South defensive MVP.

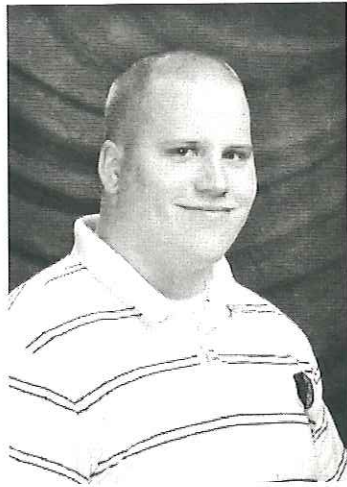

A Classic History

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewistown Lion Club were "great football games," but were short lived.

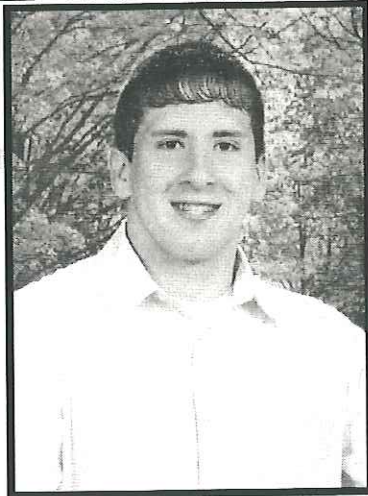
In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools. Uni-Mart replaced Mid-State Bank as the game sponsor in 1993. Since 1996, Jack Bailey and Rob Irwin have served as Co-Game Directors for the Classic.

In 1998, the Lezzer Lumber Company became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. We are proud to continue our association with the Lezzer Lumber as the corporate sponsor. Currently, there are thirty schools from District III, VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$74,000 in the form of 148 scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the "Classic" is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

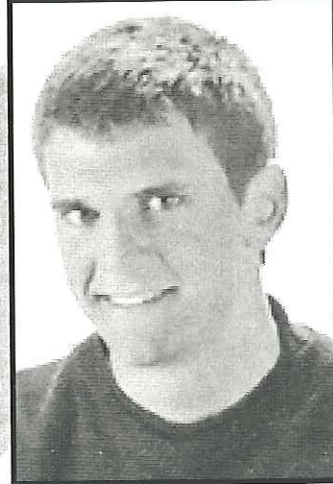

Where are they now . . .

Player Profiles from the '96 Uni-Mart Classic

North – **Nate Glunt (Curwensville)** – graduated from Penn State with a Health & Physical Education degree and was a member of the Nittany Lion Football team and letterman. Nate teaches in the Clearfield Area Schools and is an assistant Football and junior high basketball coach.

North - **Andrew Jodon (Bald Eagle Area)** – Andrew served in the U S Army from 1997 -2000 including a tour in Bosnia. Re-enlisted after September 11, 2001 and was assigned to Operation Iraq Freedom in January 2005. Killed in Action May 12, 2005. He was awarded the Purple Heart, Bronze Star, and Operation Iraq Freedom medal.

South – **Matt Stultz (Hollidaysburg)** – graduated from Edinboro University with a degree in Speech Communications while being a three year starter and letterwinner in Football. Matt had a brief professional wrestling career. He is currently a realtor with Stultz Real Estate in Hollidaysburg.

South – **Randy Zook (Indian Valley)** – four year starter and letterwinner at Susquehanna University earning “Little All-American” honors his senior year. Graduated with a degree in Criminal Justice. Serve two years as a Junior High Coach at Indian Valley. Randy died in March 2002.

CLASSICAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT

How are the funds raised? Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past seventeen years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

Basically, the game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty-one schools comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Lezzer Lumber Classic.

PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

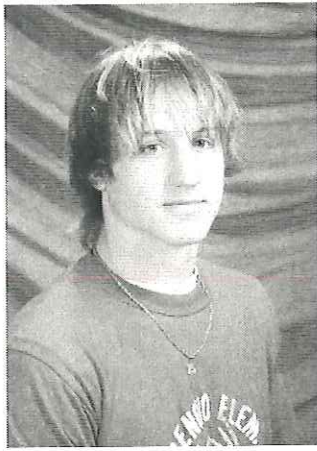
Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

Player Selection:

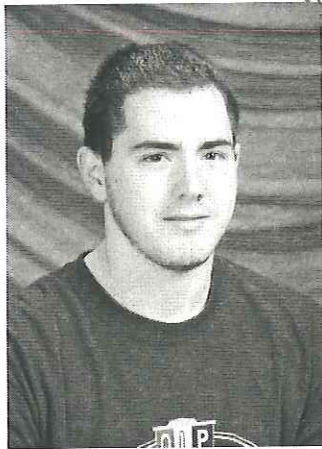
1. Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
 - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.

LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

- Offense** Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the back field between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30 % of their offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If a team is under the 30 % pass attempt, each non-pass play will be penalized for un-sportsmanship conduct until the percentages are met and maintained. Forced scrambles and sacks will be counted as pass attempts.
- Defense** Must align in basic 5-2, with a man on the center, a man on each Tackle, and a man on each End (or outside the defensive tackle to the split end side). Line backers must be over guards and deeper than the heels of the defensive tackle. Secondary may be in man or zone in any desired scheme. Defensive ends (one or both may drop into pass coverage) but must start in alignment outside the defensive tackles on or off the ball. There shall be no blitzing or shooting linebackers or secondary. Slanting or looping by front five is permissible.
- Short Yardage / Goaline** Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or touchdown, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end).
- Point Differential** If Team A scores and is behind by **9 + points**, Team A will be given the Option to Kick or Receive. If Team A receives and scores on that possession and still trails by 9 + points, No option - Team A will Kickoff to Team B. Rule does not change designated second half Kickoff.
- Kickoff Kicking Game** Kickoff will be from the 35 yardline. In Kicking Game situations, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end), however, no more than seven may rush on any kicking play.
- Quarters / Time Playing Time Tie Breaker** Quarters 1 and 3 will be 15 minutes Quarters 2 and 4 will be 12 minutes
Each player must participate for a least 15 plays.
If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie
