RAIDERS' CARSON HELPS NORTH FINISH OFF SOUTH

TYRONE — Nate Carson hadn't caught a pass all night. And with his team on defense and the clock winding down, it looked like the former Bellefonte standout wide receiver was going to go receptionless in an all-star game.

Officially, Carson didn't have a reception Friday night but it was a 21-yard interception return for a touchdown with 1 minute, 19 seconds to go that sealed the North's 24-14 victory over the South in the 22nd Lezzer Lumber Football Classic.

Centre County players had a hand in all three touchdowns for the North, which evened the series at 11 wins apiece. Carson's interception, which came against South quarterback Leonard Wilson, put the exclamation point on an impressive second half that saw the North defense hold the South to 3 yards rushing and force two South fumbles.

"I saw him come up to throw and I just anticipated it and broke off the pass route and stepped in front of it," Carson said.

The game also saw Bald Eagle Area quarterback Camdin Crouse's first pass of the night go for an 81-yard touchdown to Central Mountain's Brad Shellenberger, setting a record for the longest pass completion for a touchdown in Classic history.

The win, the second straight for the North, capped the coaching career of former Moshannon Valley coach Howie Camberg, who earlier Friday was in Hershey to be inducted into the Pennsylvania Scholastic Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

"Hall of Fame in the morning, an all-star win at night. You can't beat it," said Camberg, who stepped down as the Moshannon Valley coach after 27 seasons.

"For whatever reason, I woke up at 5 o'clock this morning and I've been going all day," Camberg continued. "It doesn't matter. These kids played so well tonight and made some enormously big plays. I'm just really proud of them."

DuBois' Robbie Hanzley was voted the North's offensive most valuable player after he rushed for 54 yards, including two big third-down runs in the fourth quarter. Tim Smeal of West Branch was the North defensive MVP.

Wilson, the former Tyrone star playing his final game on the Gray Veterans Memorial Field grass, was the offensive MVP for the South, leading two second-quarter touchdown drives to give the South a 14-7 lead at halftime.

But when Wilson dropped back on a second-and-10 from the South 18, he immediately looked to his left in the direction of Huntingdon's Mike Jones, who was running a go route. Wilson, instead, threw the ball short, expecting Jones to run an out pattern. The ball came right to Carson and he jogged 24 yards to the end zone for the clinching touchdown.

"Going into that drive, I was just thinking we had to toughen up and play tough defense," said Bald Eagle Area defensive lineman Mike Cook. "I saw Carson jump up and I was like, 'He has it.' I knew when he has the ball is in his hands, you just look out."

Earlier in the fourth, Kyle Miller of Central Mountain kicked a 31-yard field goal to put the North ahead 17-14.

The North took advantage of great field position on its first drive of the second half when State College's Ben Woodward returned a punt 13 yards to the South 23-yard line. After State College's Matt Kenney gained 9 yards to the 14, Bellefonte's Chris Snare did the rest. The former Red Raider quarterback picked up 4 yards to the 10 and after a South penalty moved the ball to the 5, Snare swept to the left corner and absorbed a big hit from Tyrone's Shane Barr at the goal line to tie the game at 14.

"Snare was a factor in the second half," said South coach Jim Zauzig. "We knew that that had to be in their repertoire. They'd be crazy not to run the spread with him back there even though they had the other two kids. We were ready for it but Snare's an issue. That's why the grass is high."

The highlight of the first half came when Crouse spotted Shellenberger streaking up the left side. Crouse delivered a perfect ball into double coverage and the 6-foot-2 Shellenberger went up and snared it, then outran the South secondary to finish off the 81-yard touchdown catch a little less than three minutes into the second quarter.

The South responded with an efficient drive that saw Southern Huntingdon's Johnny Neuder cap a nine-play march with a 3-yard touchdown run that tied it at 7.

The scoring drive was keyed by Wilson, who replaced Huntingdon's Kyle Kyper and gained 11 yards on a third-and-eight and was 3-for-3 through the air for 53 yards, including a 34-yard strike to Jones that gave the South a first-and-goal at the 6. Three plays later, Neuder, part of a full-house backfield, plowed into the end zone from the 3.

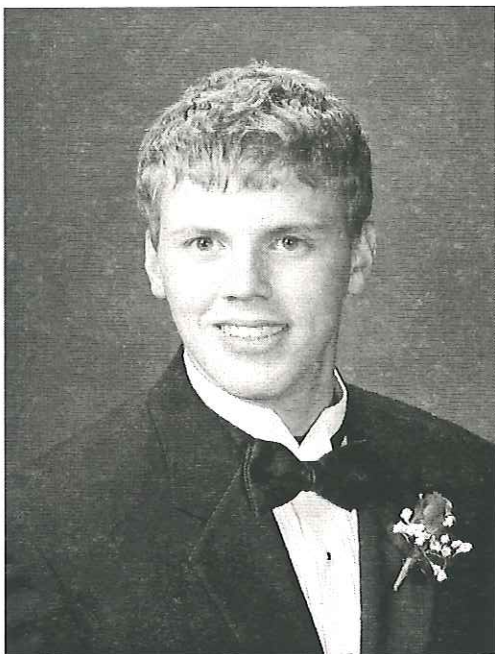
The North's next possession was an abbreviated one as Central's Chad Saylor, the South's defensive MVP, intercepted an errant Crouse pass and returned it to the North 33.

Four plays later, Tyrone's Brinton Mingle scored from 4 yards out to give the South a 14-7 edge with 45 seconds left in the second.

A Classic History

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewistown Lion Club were "great football games," but were short lived.

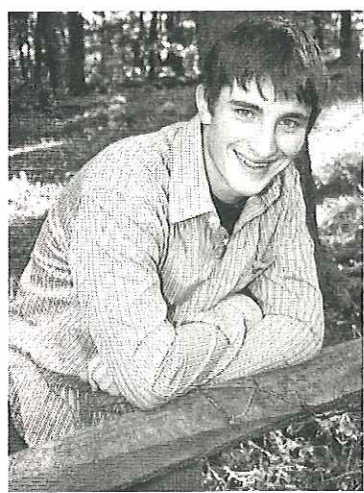
In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools. Uni-Mart replaced Mid-State Bank as the game sponsor in 1993. Since 1996, Jack Bailey and Rob Irwin have served as Co-Game Directors for the Classic.

In 1998, the Lezzer Lumber Company became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. We are proud to continue our association with Lezzer Lumber as the corporate sponsor. Currently, there are thirty schools from District III, VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$78,000 in the form of 156 scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the "Classic" is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

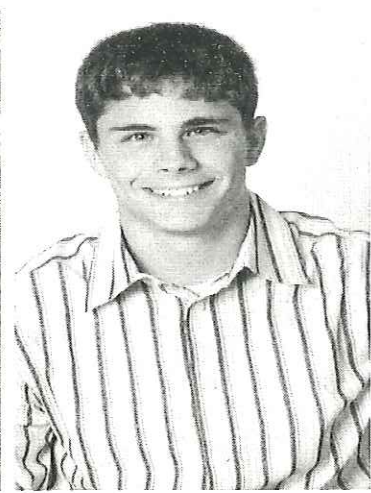

CLASSICAL FINANCIAL STATEMENT

How are the funds raised? Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past seventeen years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

The game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty-one schools comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Lezzer Lumber Classic.

PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

Player Selection:

1. Graduating senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
 - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)

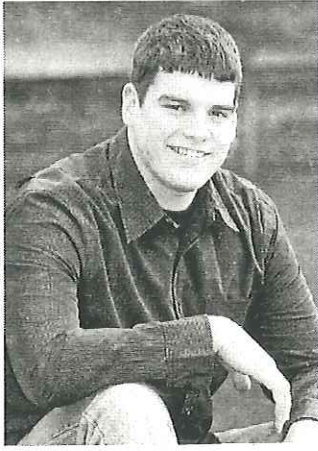
Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division -- North and South.
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five Associate Coaches.

LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

Offense

Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30 % of their offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If a team is under the 30 % pass attempt, each non-pass play will be penalized for un-sportsmanship conduct until the percentages are met and maintained. Forced scrambles and sacks will be counted as pass attempts.

Defense

Must align in basic 4-3, with a man on each guard and a man on the widest player of the tight part of the offensive formation(i.e. TE or Slot or split side tackle). Linebackers must be deeper than the heels of the defensive line. The . Middle LB must be over the Center. Outside LB's must be over the offensive Tackles to a tight end or tight slot; but outside the defensive end when he is reduced to the split side. There will be no blitzing or shooting Linebackers and no twists by the front four, but slanting and looping by the front four is permitted. Pass Coverage on first, second, and fourth down may be man or zone, but must be man -to-man on third down.

Short Yardage / Goaline Point Differential


Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or touchdown, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end). **If Team A scores and is behind by 9 + points, Team A will be given the Option to Kick or Receive. If Team A receives and scores on that possession and still trails by 9 + points, No option - Team A will Kickoff to Team B. Rule does not change designated second half Kickoff.**

Kickoff Kicking Game

Kickoff will be from the 35 yardline.
In Kicking Game situations, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end), however, no more than seven may rush on any kicking play.

Quarters / Time Playing Time Tie Breaker

Quarters 1 and 3 will be 15 minutes Quarters 2 and 4 will be 12 minutes
Each player must participate for a least 15 plays.
If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie
