North Stars: Defense Blankets South in All-Star Win

HUNTINGDON — Some future North players sat in the stands and watched former teammates dominate last year's Lezzer Lumber Classic.

The attentive players in the Class of 2011 who watched Friday's game at War Vets Field witnessed a similar template of how to win a high school football all-star game.

The North held the South to 124 offensive yards and played more than 44 minutes of shutout football to earn a 23-7 victory and tie the all-time series 13-13.

The 13 Centre County players involved in the game already had a good idea of what to expect when Matt Gaston sent the opening kickoff into the clear sky. The majority of the county participants attended last year's 26-7 North victory at Bald Eagle Area's Alumni Stadium.

"That made me want to go out, make sure I made this team and play my hardest to win the game for the North," Philipsburg-Osceola's Steve Rusnak said.

Rusnak, a linebacker at P-O, epitomized the sacrifices the North made to retain the trophy. The game's rules require base 5-2 defense and Rusnak was one of multiple lifelong linebackers moved to defensive end.

"That shows you have a good team when guys are willing to move," North coach Jason Shilala of DuBois said. "These are all MVPs of their team and they were willing to do what's best for the team. That's sometimes a difficult task in a game like this. We were fortunate that happened."

The South scored its only points when Nate Plummer threw a 19-yard touchdown pass to Levi Reihart with 3:38 remaining. The touchdown came on a short field as a fumble return by Jesse Davis allowed the South to begin a drive on the North's 23.

Plummer's pass to Reihart marked one of the few times the South could solve the North's defense.

The North intercepted four passes and allowed just 39 rushing yards on 22 carries.

The interceptions took a variety of forms, ranging from State College's Brad Holzwarth stepping in front of Corey Miller in a zone coverage to Curwensville defensive back Sam Gardner juggling the ball twice while making a leaping snag on a fourth-quarter pass.

"Oh my goodness," BEA's Dillon Shreffler said. "They were amazing plays."

The first of Gardner's two interceptions — he picked another pass with 2:48 remaining — led to the decisive touchdown.

With 7:03 remaining, Clearfield's Trey Campman caught a 24-yard pass from DuBois' Josh Means in the corner of the end zone to give the North a 23-0 lead. The touchdown was the second athletic catch by a Clearfield receiver. The North took a 16-0 lead when Chad Zurat jumped over Michael Sellers and Zach Rentz to grab Means' 19-yard pass with 25 seconds left in the first half.

"We knew if we could get the ball to where those guys would get it, they would make some plays," Shilala said.

The South had similar targets in Tyrone's Eric Desch and Reihart and Mount Union tight end Jamel Fortson. But the North's front seven ensured the South never generated an offensive rhythm.

The South completed 9 of 24 passes for 85 yards. Coach A.J. Hoenstine and his staff resorted to trickery multiple times, but the South had a 55-yard play called back because it used two forward passes. Despite the creativity, the South's longest offensive play went for just 19 yards.

"On defense it was pretty simple," Holzwarth said. "The front seven was playing the football and the back seven was worrying about the pass."

The North received an encouraging sign after Holzwarth's interception. The linebacker returned the ball 48 yards to the South 11. Holzwarth received ribbing from teammates because he didn't reach the end zone. The ribbing represented a sign of the bond developed this past week.

"I guess I'm not fast enough to get to the end zone," Holzwarth joked. "That's at least what everybody was telling me."

The North parlayed the interception into three points as Zack Czap kicked a 27-yard field goal four plays later.

Every Centre County participant played a significant part in the victory. Bald Eagle Area's Brock Bathurst, Jon Gingrich, Chris Gribble and Shreffler, State College's Vinh Vuong, Jeff Moyer and Holzwarth, P-O's Rusnak and Czap, and Penns Valley's Bryan Lee played on defense. Vuong also played on an offensive line that included Penns Valley's Eddie Flick and P-O's Cody Pepperday.

"It was awesome being on a winning team again and having everybody come together to beat the South," Rusnak said. "We played many of the teams on the South like Tyrone. It's good to beat them. I didn't beat Tyrone three years on varsity."

Notes: Curwensville's Jed Greslick (North Offense), Clarion's Kevin Grejda (North Defense), Muir (South Offense), Huntingdon's Andrew Cerett (South Defense) and Bellwood-Antis' Nick Degol (South Defense) received MVP honors. Greslick gained a game-high 63 yards on 15 carries. ... State College's Al Wolski and Bellwood-Antis' John Hayes received North and South Coach of the Year honors during halftime. Hayes along with Tyrone's John Franco and Huntingdon's Jim Zauzig were inducted into the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame. ... A moment of silence was held before the game for former P-O coach Jack Bailey, who died of cancer last year. Bailey served as game director from 1995-2009.

CLASSIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

How are the funds raised? Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past twenty-four years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

Basically, the game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty-one schools comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Lezzer Lumber Classic.

LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

Offense	Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30 % of their offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If a team is under the 30 % pass attempt, each non-pass play will be penalized for un-sportsmanship conduct until the percentages are met and maintained. Forced scrambles and sacks will be counted as pass attempts
Defense	Must align in a Basic 5-2, with a man on the Center, a man on each Tackle, and a man on each End (or outside of the defensive tackle to the split-end side) Linebackers must be over the Guards and deeper than the heels of the defensive tackles. Defensive Ends (one or both may drop into pass coverage) but must start in alignment outside the defensive tackles, on or off the ball. Slanting and looping by the front five is permissible. There shall be no blitzing or shooting of linebackers or secondary. Pass Coverage on first, second, and fourth down may be man or zone, but must be man-to-man on third down.
Short Yardage / Goaline	Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or touchdown, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end).
Point Differential	<u>If Team A scores and is behind by 9 + points, Team A will be given the Option to Kick or Receive. If Team A receives and scores on that possession and still trails by 9 + points, No option - Team A will Kickoff to Team B. Rule does not change designated second half Kickoff.</u>
Kickoff	<u>Kickoff will be from the 35 yardline.</u>
Kicking Game	In Kicking Game situations, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end), however, no more than seven may rush on any kicking play.
Quarters / Time	Each <u>Quarter will be 12 minutes</u>
Playing Time	Each player must participate for a least 15 plays.
Tie Breaker	If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie

PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

Player Selection:

1. Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
 - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)

Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division -- North and South.
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five/six Associate Coaches.

A Classic History

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewistown Lion Club were "great football games," but were short lived.

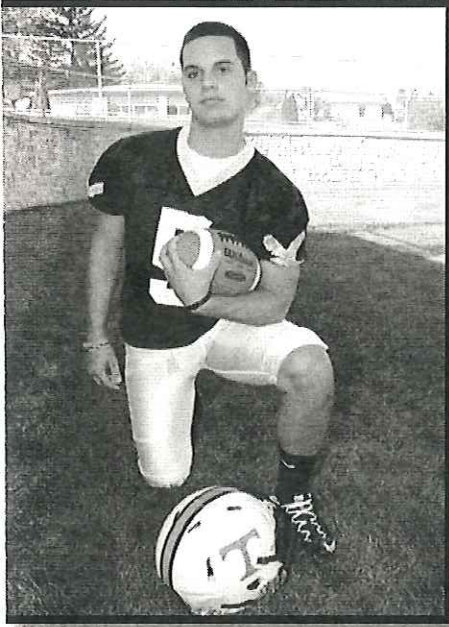
In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools. Uni-Mart replaced Mid-State Bank as the game sponsor in 1993. Since 1996, Jack Bailey and Rob Irwin have served as Co-Game Directors for the Classic. J. Gawen Stoker is our Game Director for 2010.

In 1998, the Lezzer Lumber Company became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. We are proud to continue our association with the Lezzer Lumber as the corporate sponsor. Currently, there are thirty-one schools from District VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$97,000 in the form of 189 scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the "Classic" is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

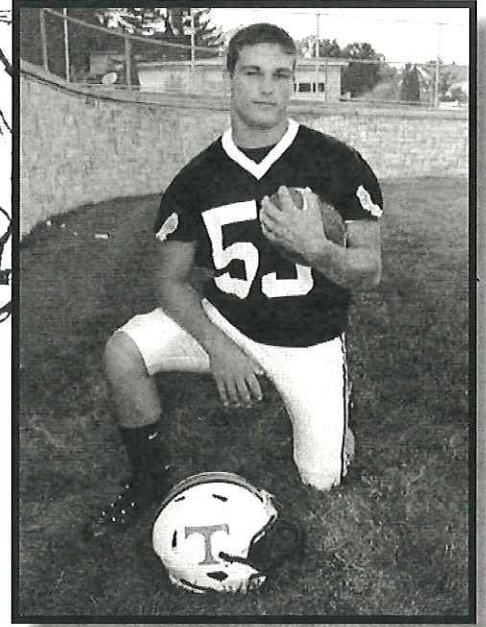
