# Skillful Display

WINGATE -- Multiple North players stormed toward South quarterback Trent Lee.

Feeling the pressure, Lee lofted a pass resembling football's version of a knuckleball.

Like a good baseball player, which he is, Lucas Runk never lost sight of the ball, catching it at the 18-yard-line and sprinting into the end zone for a third-quarter touchdown.

Now imagine a team filled with players possessing similar focus and athletic ability.

That's what the North faced Friday.

An athletic South team ended the North's two-year Lezzer Lumber Football Classic reign with a 35-14 victory at Alumni Stadium. The victory gives the South a 14-13 lead in the all-time series.

"They made the plays," South coach John Franco said. "I have said for years, 'You win big games when great players make great plays and that was the case tonight.'"

Franco coaches Tyrone. The South showed the opportunistic qualities that make the Golden Eagles a difficult out.

The South forced six turnovers. On some of those plays, the North did little wrong.

Trailing 21-6 in the third quarter, North quarterback Tyler Lucas hit Derek Danver in the hands with a pass. As Danver pulled the ball into his chest, he was hit in the waist by Austin Harnish. The ball fluttered in the air. Altoona's DeRon Lee grabbed it and sprinted 58 yards, allowing the South to start a possession on the North 20.

Runk, a Central standout and the South's offensive MVP, scored the first of his two touchdowns six plays later to give the South a 28-6 lead with two seconds left in the third quarter. Lee also had a first-quarter interception that led to a touchdown.

"It was a great week," said Lee, the South's defensive MVP. "All week in practice we really came together and it showed tonight."

The North didn't fare better to begin the fourth. Hollidaysburg's Nick Schrifft jumped to break up Tyler Jenny's pass to Matt Watson. Schrifft juggled the ball, but maintained his concentration for the South's third interception. Runk made a leaping interception later in the quarter, giving the South four for the game.

"We had a lot of opportunities but the defense executed on our mistakes," Lucas said. "That had a big impact on the game."

The turnovers aided an already dangerous South team. The group showed its potential on the game's opening drive, using nine plays to march 58 yards. The drive ended with Hollidaysburg's Chad Barton, who completed 8 of 10 passes for 85 yards, throwing a 23-yard touchdown pass to 6-foot-2, 220-pound Lewistown tight end Dan Wheeler.

"They had a lot of speed," State College linebacker Shane Dorner said. "They just came right at you with the tight ends. Their blocking and everything was perfect."

The South executed the drive four days after their first practice together. Players hailed from large and small schools. Some were fierce competitors during the fall.

Both sides jelled. The North showed its cohesion late in the first half, taking the ball at its own 15 with 1:23 remaining. Less than a minute later, Lucas completed a swing pass to Watson, his former Bellefonte teammate, to give the North a second-and-two from the South 3 with 22 seconds left in the half.

But the drive yielded no points. Huntingdon's Sean Houck recovered a wayward pitch, allowing the South to enter halftime with a 14-6 lead.

"We had our opportunities," Dorner said, "but the ball didn't go our way."

The North scored on Jenny's one-yard run in the second quarter and Derek Morgan's three-yard pass from Lucas in the fourth.

Lucas completed 7 of 19 passes for 102 yards and rushed for 41 yards on seven carries to earn North offensive MVP honors. Penns Valley's Elliot Dillon, who played on the offensive and defensive lines, earned North defensive MVP honors.

"The game wasn't as bad as the score makes it look," Dillon said. "We had a super team and we just made some mistakes they took advantage of."

Runk led the South with 67 yards on 11 carries. He also caught four passes for 33 yards and completed a halfback pass for 21 yards. Having Runk on his side, eased Franco's pregame concerns.

"I'm tired of coaching against him," Franco said. "It was nice having him with me."

Players participated in the game for a variety of reasons. Many, including the St. Francis-bound Runk, are seven weeks away from beginning college careers, so Friday helped them return to football speed. Others, such as Lucas, are still auditioning for college spots.

The game also featured athletes wearing jerseys and pads for the final time. All three groups left Wingate with some new friends and lasting memories.

"I got to meet a lot of new people and some really cool people," Lucas said. "This team had a lot of great players. I don't know what happened. We should have won the game. But it was my last high school game and it was pretty sweet to be in it."

## ***CLASSIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT***

How are the funds raised? Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past twenty-four years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

Basically, the game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty-one schools comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Lezzer Lumber Classic.

## LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

<b>Offense</b>	Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30 % of their offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If a team is under the 30 % pass attempt, each non-pass play will be penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct until the percentages are met and maintained. Forced scrambles and sacks will be counted as pass attempts
<b>Defense</b>	Must align in a Basic 5-2, with a man on the Center, a man on each Tackle, and a man on each End (or outside of the defensive tackle to the split-end side) Linebackers must be over the Guards and deeper than the heels of the defensive tackles. Defensive Ends (one or both may drop into pass coverage) but must start in alignment outside the defensive tackles, on or off the ball. Slanting and looping by the front five is permissible. There shall be no blitzing or shooting of linebackers or secondary. Pass Coverage on first, second, and fourth down may be man or zone, but must be man-to-man on third down.
<b>Short Yardage / Goaline</b>	Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or touchdown, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end).
<b>Point Differential</b>	<b><u>If Team A scores and is behind by 9 + points, Team A will be given the Option to Kick or Receive. If Team A receives and scores on that possession and still trails by 9 + points, No option - Team A will Kickoff to Team B. Rule does not change designated second half Kickoff.</u></b>
<b>Kickoff</b>	<u>Kickoff will be from the 35 yardline.</u>
<b>Kicking Game</b>	In Kicking Game situations, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end), however, no more than seven may rush on any kicking play.
<b>Quarters / Time</b>	Each <u>Quarter will be 12 minutes</u>
<b>Playing Time</b>	Each player must participate for a least 15 plays.
<b>Tie Breaker</b>	If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie

## PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

### Player Selection:

1. Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
  - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)

### Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division -- North and South.
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five/six Associate Coaches.

## A Classic History

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewis-town Lion Club were "great football games," but were short lived.

In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools. Uni-Mart replaced Mid-State Bank as the game sponsor in 1993. Since 1996, Jack Bailey and Rob Irwin have served as Co-Game Directors for the Classic. J. Gawen Stoker is our Game Director for 2010.

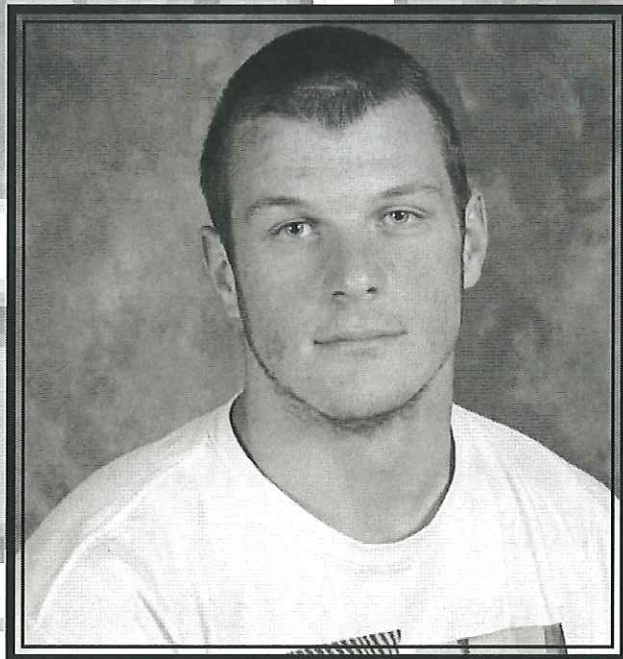
In 1998, the Lezzer Lumber Company became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. We are proud to continue our association with the Lezzer Lumber as the corporate sponsor. Currently, there are thirty-one schools from District VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$101,000 in the form of 189 scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. # Tribute to J. Gawen Stoker



He was persistent. He was loyal. But most of all he was a friend of Pennsylvania High School football. "Stokes" was involved in football across the State. He was an active member of the Pennsylvania Scholastic Football Coaches' Association. He was a major partner in the Lezzer Lumber All-Star Game and he was extremely active in the District 6 Football Coaches' Association. As a member of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame (PA Chapter), Gawen was one of the hardest workers on the Board. It had been his job to contact then follow up on the more than 40 high schools in the Central Region.

On banquet day, he was there early sorting and organizing the plaques for the top individual academic seniors from the Central PA area. He was proud of the area athletes who distinguished themselves on the field and in the classroom. Stokes made a name for himself as an innovator in high school football, perhaps being the first to bring the 'polecat' to our area. He coached at Bald Eagle Area, Trinity (Washington, PA) and more recently at Indian Valley High School (now part of the Mifflin County jointure).

Frank Rocco, executive director of the Central PA Chapter says, "J. Gawen Stoker was a leader of men and boys and a great friend to many, many people. As Executive Director of the Pa. Scholastic Football Coaches Assoc. and a valued member of the Central Pa. Chapter of the National Football Foundation board of directors, his leadership and organizational skills were invaluable. Neither organization will ever be the same without him and he is missed by many."



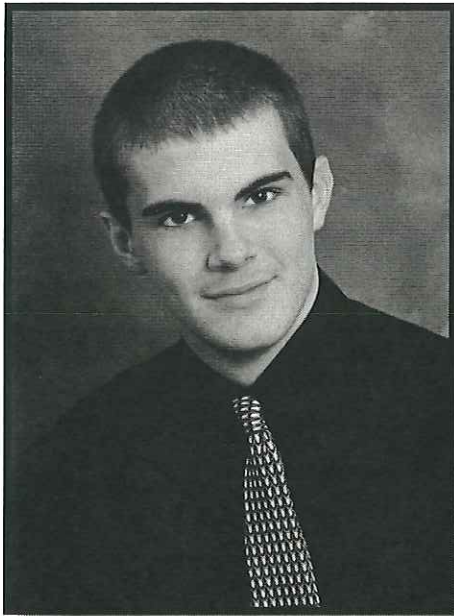
