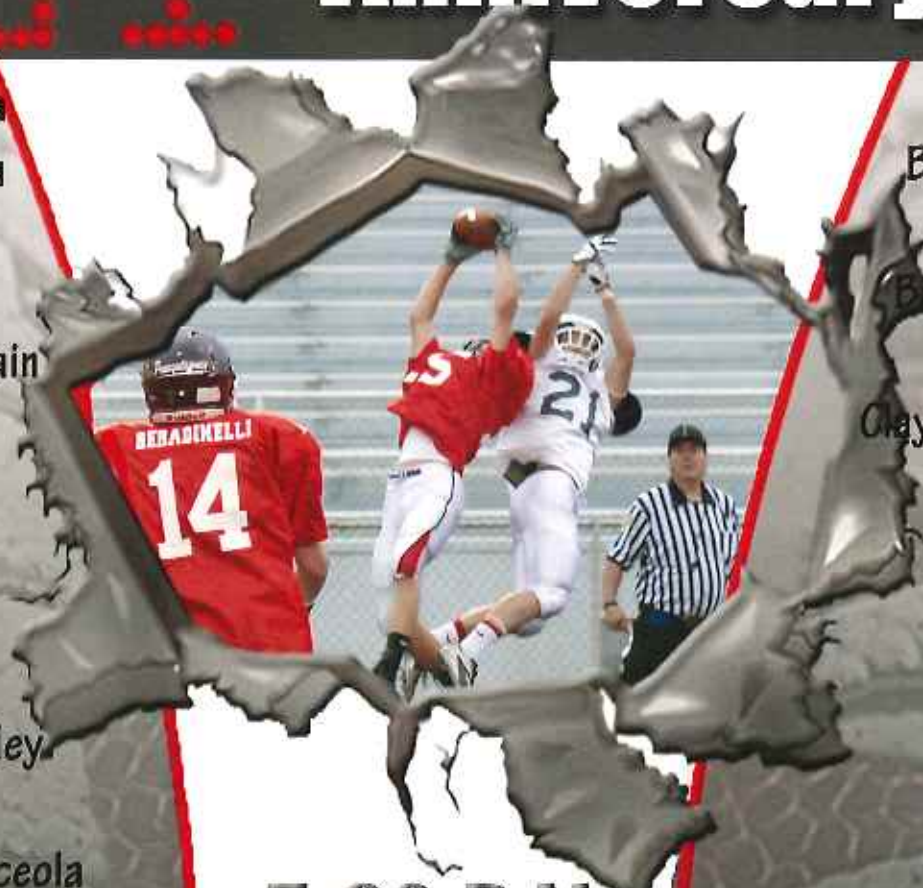

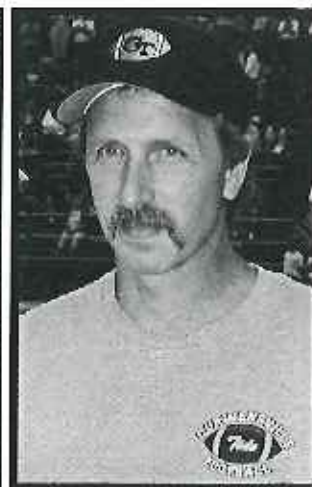
### DISTINGUISHED COACHES FROM CPFCA SCHOOLS BEING INDUCTED TONIGHT

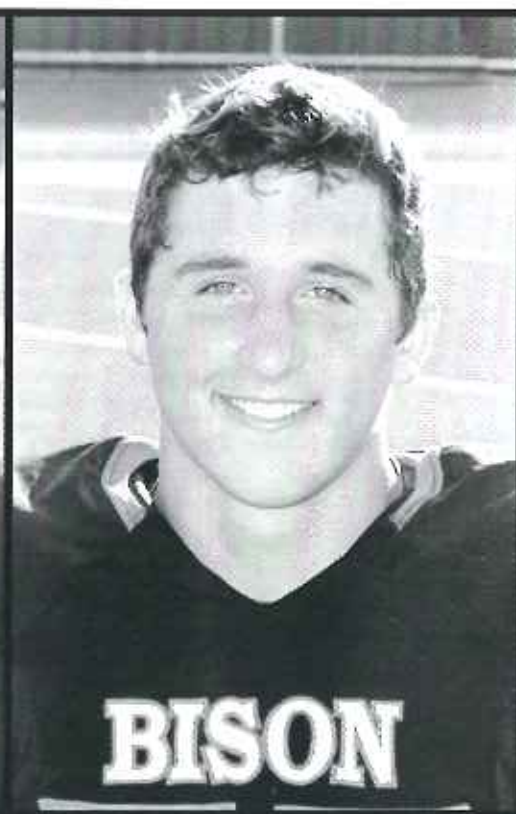

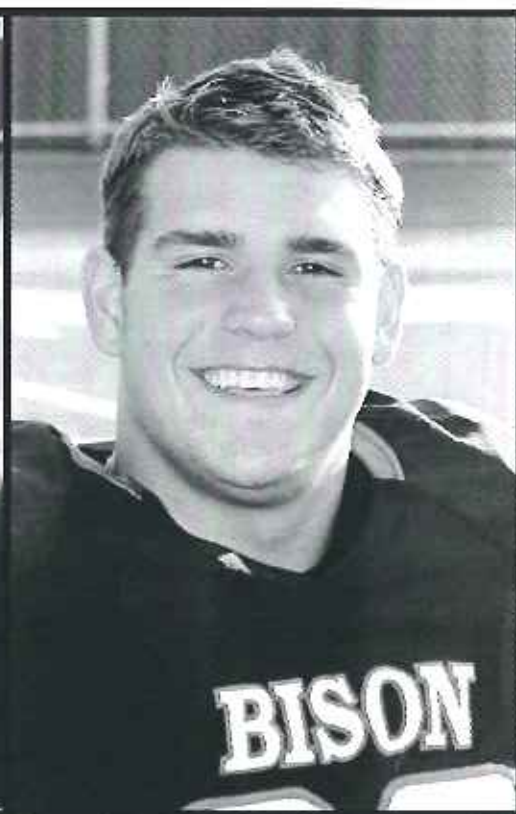

# *North team uses defense to win Lezzer Lumber Classic; Penns Valley's Tobias named MVP*

ALTOONA You wouldn't expect with a mere six days of practice out of season, that a football all-star game would be dominated by defense.

But in the 30th installment of the Lezzer Lumber Classic in its return to Mansion Park, the North team's defense put on quite a show Friday night.

The North caused seven turnovers, intercepting five passes and recovering two fumbles, in a decisive 24-7 victory.

"It wasn't bad," understated Bald Eagle Area's Bryan Greene, who was one of the defensive leaders with an interception and a fumble recovery. "We had a goal a couple days ago. (Clearfield coach Tim) Janocko got the defense together and was like, 'Let's put up a goose egg on them, a goose egg on the scoreboard.' We almost did."

The other big defensive leader was Clearfield's Tyler Stratton, who picked off three passes and garnered Defensive Most Valuable Player honors.

Picking up the Offensive MVP award was one of the young men who turned those mistakes into points -- Penns Valley quarterback Cameron Tobias, who was 6 for 9 for 110 yards with two touchdowns and an interception.

"It's definitely exciting," Tobias said of finishing his high school career with a win and an MVP award. "It is the last game, and everybody worked hard this week. There were many, plenty of guys that were deserving of the award, and it's awesome that we all came out on top with a win."

While Tobias will be playing football at Lock Haven, and it marked the final time for many others to play football before heading off to college, for others it was the last time possibly ever to strap on a helmet and pads.

A number of other Centre County athletes also made major contributions.

A trio from BEA all left their marks. Bryan Greene also had three punt returns for 27 yards, his twin brother Bryce caught a 37-yard pass from Tobias and Dakota Bartley had one catch for 12 yards and was the game's leading rusher with seven carries for 94 yards.

"It's definitely not something you expect in an all-star game," Bartley said of the lopsided final score. "You expect a high shootout and a close game and it didn't turn out like that."

The turnover numbers also were evident in the yardage totals. The North finished with 356 yards, including 164 on the ground, while the South had just 142 total yards, marred by 11 yards rushing on 30 carries.

"It's hard to come back from (seven)," Mifflin County and South coach George Miskinis said. "It's hard to come back from one sometimes in a game, but when you make (seven), I think the defense played extremely well. They played their hearts out, and we had a hard time to really just keep our composure, pick up one first down at a time and just try to establish the line of scrimmage. We did, but it was late."

The North was certainly happy with its defensive showing.

"Any time you get that short week, and they've been off since December, November, we're really pleased," Clarion and North coach Larry Wisor said. "I've always been a proponent of ... zeroes I really like. It's my favorite number."

All of the North's points came from Clarion players in one form or another.

Damien Slike caught a 14-yard strike from Tobias for the first score in the opening quarter.

Bryan Greene thought he added to the total with a 64-yard punt return for a score, but it was wiped out by a penalty. On the ensuing play, Bartley raced 59 yards to get North on the doorstep, and Slike finished the drive.

A Tobias-to-Cody Hearst 13-yard strike in the final minute before halftime made it 21-0 at the break. Clarion kicker Antonio Trease, who made all three of his PAT tries, booted a 32-yard field goal early in the third to close the North scoring.

A four-yard pass from Williamsburg quarterback Austin McMonagle to Central's Bradi Moore midway through the fourth spoiled the shutout. Moore also had seven carries for 30 yards for the Offensive MVP for the South, and Mifflin County's John Michael Maclay was the South Defensive MVP.

Even with a short week of practice, it all came together well and easily for the North.

"We came into camp like we were teammates for three years," Bryan Greene said. "We got to know each other and it was a pleasure."

Notes: South lost one of its top athletes, Central running back Austin Cunningham, to a knee injury on its second offensive series of the game. ... A number of athletes picked up \$500 scholarships, including Tobias and Taylor Collison of Penns Valley and State College quarterback Patrick Irwin. ... Hearst led in receiving with three catches for 105 yards.

He was an active member of the Pennsylvania Scholastic Football Coaches' Association. He was a major partner in the Lezzer Lumber All-Star Game and he was extremely active in the District 6 Football Coaches' Association. As a member of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame (PA Chapter), Gawen was one of the hardest workers on the Board. He was proud of the area athletes who distinguished themselves on the field and in the classroom. Stokes made a name for himself as an in-

novator in high school football, perhaps being the first to bring the 'polecat' to our area. He coached at Bald Eagle Area, Trinity (Washington, PA) and more recently at Indian Valley High School (now part of the Mifflin County jointure).

Frank Rocco, executive director of the Central PA Chapter says, "J. Gawen Stoker was a leader of men and boys and a great friend to many, many people. As Executive Director of the Pa. Scholastic Football Coaches Assoc. and a valued member of the Central Pa. Chapter of the National Football Foundation board of directors, his leadership and organizational skills were invaluable. Neither organization will ever be the same without him and he is missed by many."

# A Classic History

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewistown Lion Club were "great football games," but were short lived.

In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools. Uni-Mart replaced Mid-State Bank as the game sponsor in 1993. Jack Bailey and Rob Irwin have served as Co-Game Directors for the Classic from 1996 to 2009. J. Gawen Stoker was the Game Director 2010-2011. Jim Zauzig has been our Game Director since 2012.

In 1998, the Lezzer Lumber Company became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. We are proud to continue our association with the Lezzer Lumber as the corporate sponsor. Currently, there are thirty-one schools from District VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$124,000 in the form of 240 scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the "Classic" is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

The Lezzer Lumber Classic is considered as one of the premiere all-star football games in Pennsylvania. It is a tribute to our sponsors and co-sponsors, to the individual players sponsors, the business card and patron sponsors, and to families and friends of scholastic football in the Central Pennsylvania region. Please patronize our supporters, and let them know that you appreciate their contributions to the Classic when you visit their businesses.

### *CLASSIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT*

How are the funds raised? Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past thirty years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

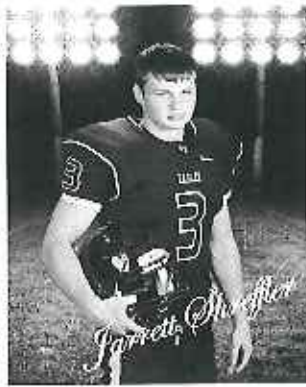
There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

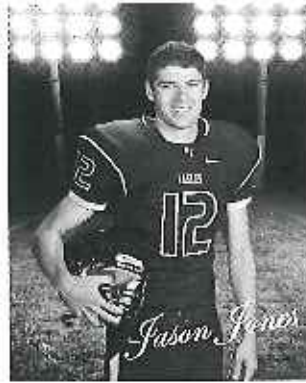

# LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

<b>Offense</b>	Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30 % of their offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If a team is under the 30 % pass attempt, each non-pass play will be penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct until the percentages are met and maintained. Forced scrambles and sacks will be counted as pass attempts.
<b>Defense</b>	Must align in a 4-3, with a man on each Guard (Inside/On/Outside). Ends to the TE can be (Inside/On/Outside) shoulder of TE. Ends away from TE must be outside shoulder of tackle. All 4 down guys must be in a 3 or 4 point stance and must rush the passer. Slanting and looping by the front 4 is permissible. There shall be no blitzing or shooting of linebackers or secondary. Linebackers must be deeper than the heels of the defensive lineman. Mike Linebacker must always be aligned inside the guards. Sam/Will linebackers must be aligned inside the tackles unless they are bumped out in a zone coverage vs multiple WR. Pass Coverage on 1st, 2nd, and 4th down may be man or zone (In zone, you must have 2 high safeties at least 9 yards deep), but must be man-to-man on 3rd down. Man-to-man must be played by the secondary only.
<b>Short Yardage / Goaline</b>	Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or touchdown, the linebackers may move up onto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end).
<b>Point Differential</b>	<b><u>If Team A scores and is behind by 9 + points, Team A will be given the Option to Kick or Receive. If Team A receives and scores on that possession and still trails by 9 + points, No option - Team A will Kickoff to Team B. Rule does not change designated second half Kickoff.</u></b>
<b>Kickoff</b>	<u>Kickoff will be from the 35 yardline.</u>
<b>Kicking Game</b>	In Kicking Game situations, the linebackers may move up onto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end), however, no more than seven may rush on any kicking play.
<b>Quarters / Time</b>	Each Quarter will be 12 minutes
<b>Playing Time</b>	Each player must participate for a least 15 plays.
<b>Tie Breaker</b>	If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie

## PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

### Player Selection:

1. Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
  - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)
4. This year coaches from both staffs selected alternates in case players were unable to participate for various reasons.

### Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division -- North and South.
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five/six Associate Coaches.

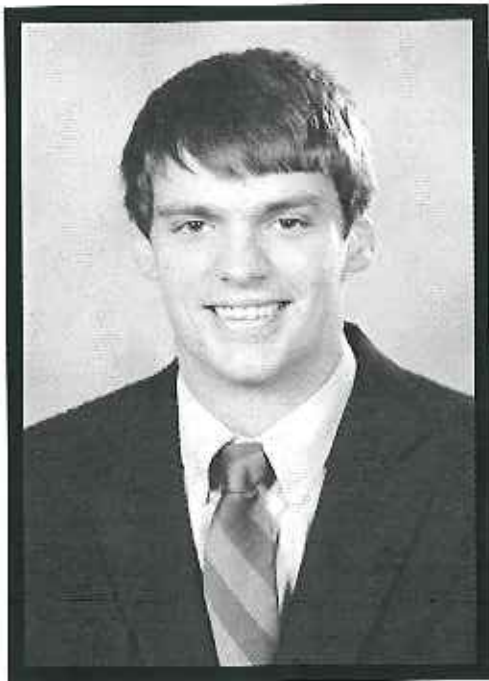

He began his teaching and coaching career at Johnsonburg High School and then moved in 1966 to Huntingdon County, where he taught physical education and health education at Juniata Valley Junior/Senior High School in Alexandria until his retirement in December 1994.

While at Juniata Valley, he coached football, wrestling, track and field, weight training and helped with the Alexandria Eagles Pee Wee football team. He led the Hornets to two PIAA District 6-A Championships in 1986 and 1987 and was named the Mid-State Football Classic assistant coach in 1986 and head coach in 1987. He was inducted into the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Hall of Fame in 1998 and the Huntingdon County Sports Hall of Fame in 2001.

After retiring from Juniata Valley, he returned to his high school alma mater as head football coach for the Moniteau Warriors for two years.

He enjoyed golf trips with his friends and family and traveling in his RV to visit his children and grandchildren in New York, Texas, Arizona, California and Pennsylvania. He also enjoyed supporting his favorite Pennsylvania teams, the Steelers, Pirates and Nittany Lions, especially while traveling in sometimes not so friendly rival territories.

Bill is survived by his wife, Mona; five children: William (Bill) of Sunnyvale, Calif., Jana Grose of Massena, N.Y., Richard of Sunnyvale, Calif., Lisa Carper of Alexandria, Pa., and Patti and her husband Matt Sargood of Millsap, Texas; and 12 grandchildren. 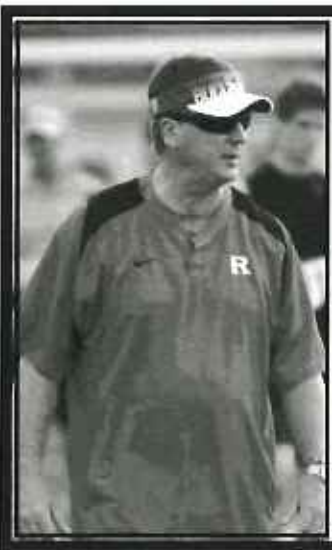

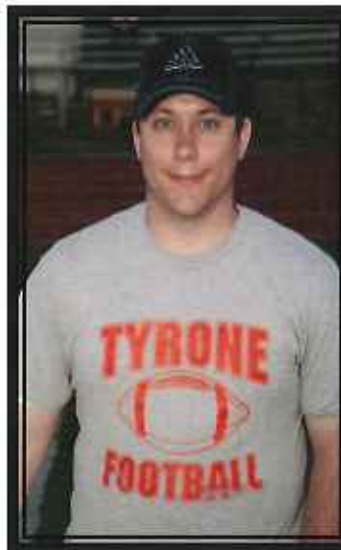
