#### **A Classic History**

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the

1977-78 Lewistown Lion Člub were "great football games," but were short lived.

In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools. Uni-Mart replaced Mid-State Bank as the game sponsor in 1993. Jack Bailey and Rob Irwin have served as Co-Game Directors for the Classic from 1996 to 2009. J. Gawen Stoker was the Game Director 2010-2011. Jim Zauzig has been our Game Director from 2012 to present.

In 1998, the Lezzer Lumber Company became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. We are proud to continue our association with the Lezzer Lumber as the corporate sponsor. Currently, there are thirty-two schools from District VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$148,000 in the form of 282 scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the "Classic" is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

The Lezzer Lumber Classic is considered as one of the premiere all-star football games in Pennsylvania. It is a tribute to our sponsors and co-sponsors, to the individual players sponsors, the business card and patron sponsors, and to families and friends of scholastic football in the Central Pennsylvania region. Please patronize our supporters, and let them know that you appreciate their contributions to

the Classic when you visit their businesses.

#### YOU MAKE IT ALL WORK!

#### CLASSIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

How are the funds raised? Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past thirty years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

Basically, the game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty-two schools comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Lezzer Lumber Classic.

#### LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

Offense Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of

scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30 % of their offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If a team is under the 30 % pass attempt, each non-pass play will be penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct until the percentages are met and maintained. Forced scrambles and sacks will be counted as pass attempts

**Defense** 

Must align in a 4-3, with a man on each Guard (Inside/On/Outside). Ends to the TE can be (Inside/On/Outside) shoulder of TE. Ends away from TE must be outside shoulder of tackle. All 4 down guys must be in a 3 or 4 point stance and must rush the passer. Slanting and looping by the front 4 is permissible. There shall be no blitzing or shooting of linebackers or secondary. Linebackers must be deeper than the heels of the defensive lineman. Mike Linebacker must always be aligned inside the guards. Sam/Will linebackers must be aligned inside the tackles unless they are bumped out in a zone coverage vs multiple WR. Pass Coverage on 1st, 2nd, and 4th down may be man or zone (In zone, you must have 2 high safeties at least 9 yards deep), but must be man-to-man on 3rd down.

Man-to-man must be played by the secondary only.

Short Yardage / Goaline

Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or touchdown, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the

defensive end).

Point Differential If Team A scores and is behind by 9 + points, Team A will be given the Option to Kick or Receive.

If Team A receives and scores on that possession and still trails by 9 + points, No option - Team

A will Kickoff to Team B. Rule does not change designated second half Kickoff.

Kickoff Kickoff will be from the 35 yardline.

IF BALL IS KICKED INTO THE END ZONE, THEN THE DEFENSE IS REWARDED WITH PLACING THE BALL ON

THE 20 YARD LINE. IF THE RECEIVING TEAM CALLS FOR A FAIR CATCH INSIDE THE 25, THE BALL

WILL BE PLACED AT THE 25.

PAT: BALL WILL PLACED AT 13 YD. LINE FOR A 30-YD ATTEMPT. WORTH 2 PTS. IF GOOD. PAT & FG

**Kicking Game** In Kicking Game situations, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the sec-

ondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end), however, no more than seven may

rush on any kicking play. Each Quarter will be 12 minutes **Quarters / Time** 

**Playing Time** Each player must participate for a least 15 plays.

Tie Breaker If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie

#### PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.


#### **Player Selection:**

- Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December. a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
- Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
- Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)
- This year coaches from both staffs selected alternates in case players were unable to participate for various reasons.

#### **Coach Selection:**

- 1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division
- The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five/six Associate Coaches.
