The 2023 CPFCA Hall of Fame Inductees



WILLIE BREON, INDIAN VALLEY, HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

BREON PLAYED HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL AT LEWISTOWN-GRANVILLE FROM 1965-1967 HELPING HIS TEAM WIN THE WESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1966 AS A CENTER AND MIDDLE LINEBACKER. AS A SENIOR, HE WAS A 1967 BIG 33 HONORABLE MENTION LINEBACKER DESPITE PLAYING HALF THE SEASON WITH A BROKEN HAND. HE THEN FURTHERED HIS PLAYING CAREER AT LOCK HAVEN UNIVERSITY WHERE HE EARNED HIS TEACHING DEGREE.

HE STARTED HIS COACHING CAREER AT CLEARFIELD HIGH SCHOOL IN 1973, RETURNING TO HIS HOMETOWN TO TEACH AND COACH AT CHIEF LOGAN HIGH SCHOOL FROM 1977-1987 WHERE HE WAS THE DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR FROM 1981-1987. HIS DEFENSES HELPED THE MINGOES WIN 20 GAMES IN A ROW FROM 1982 TO 1983 GIVING UP A TOTAL OF 65 POINTS IN 1982 AND 64 POINTS IN 1983 ON THE WAY TO BACK TO BACK BIG 8 AND CENTRAL COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIPS.

AFTER THE MERGER OF KISHACOQUILLAS AND CHIEF LOGAN HIGH SCHOOLS, BREON JOINED THE INDIAN VALLEY STAFF IN 1989 AND SERVED AS THE DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR IN 1990 AND 1991. BREON WAS THEN THE HEAD COACH AT INDIAN VALLEY FROM 1992-1999 GOING 5-2 IN THE BIG 8 CONFERENCE IN HIS FIRST SEASON AT THE HELM. BREON WAS AWARDED THE BIG 8 COACH OF THE YEAR AWARD IN 1994 AS HIS WARRIORS TEAM CAPTURED THE FIRST WINNING SEASON IN INDIAN VALLEY HISTORY, WINNING THE BIG 8 CHAMPIONSHIP AND SECURING THE SCHOOLS FIRST PLAYOFF APPEARANCE. HIS 1995 TEAM WENT 4-3 IN THE BIG 8, UPSETTING UNDEFEATED AND STATE RANKED TYRONE. IN 1996, BREON COACHED FOR JOHN FRANCO IN THE LEZZER LUMBER CLASSIC AFTER HIS WARRIOR TEAM WON THE SCHOOLS FIRST DISTRICT PLAYOFF GAME WHICH WAS FOLLOWED UP BY ANOTHER PLAYOFF WIN IN 1997 OVER THE #1 SEEDED CENTRAL DRAGONS.

BREON WON CHAMPIONSHIPS AS A PLAYER, COORDINATOR AND HEAD COACH DURING HIS COACHING STINTS IN THE MIFFLIN COUNTY SCHOOLS AND AS HEAD COACH AT INDIAN VALLEY, LAID THE GROUNDWORK FOR FUTURE SUCCESSSES OF THE PROGRAM.



MIKE SMITH, JUNIATA VALLEY, HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

COACH MIKE SMITH GRADUATED IN 1987 FROM JUNIATA VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL WHERE HE WAS PART OF BACK TO BACK DISTRICT 6 CHAMPIONSHIPS. COACH SMITH CONTINUED HIS EDUCATION AT PENN STATE, OBTAINING HIS BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN LANDSCAPE CONTRACTING AND A SECONDARY EDUCATION DEGREE IN SCIENCE AND AGRICULTURE. COACH SMITH PLAYED FOOTBALL FOR PENN STATE FOR 3 SEASONS. HE PLAYED 2 YEARS AT THE "HERO" POSITION BEFORE SWITCHING TO FREE SAFETY HIS FINAL YEAR. HE ENJOYED COACHING FOOTBALL, TRACK AND BASKETBALL WHILE AT JUNIATA VALLEY.

COACH SMITH WAS ASSISTANT COACH AT JUNIATA VALLEY FROM 1997-2002. HE THEN BECAME HEAD COACH AT HIS ALMA MATER FROM 2002-2012. HE LED THE GREEN HORNETS TO 4 ICC DIVISIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS AND COACHED THE GREEN HORNETS IN 2 SINGLE A DISTRICT 6 CHAMPIONSHIP. THE 2004 GREEN ARE STILL THE ONLY REGULAR SEASON UNDEFEATED TEAM IN SCHOOL HISTORY. IN TOTAL COACH SMITH BUILT A CAREER RECORD OF 70-33. HE ENJOYED COACHING FOOTBALL, TRACK AND BASKETBALL WHILE AT JUNIATA VALLEY.

COACH SMITH PASSED AWAY FEBRUARY 28TH OF THIS YEAR LEAVING A STRONG SENSE OF COMMUNITY AND FAMILY AS HIS LEGACY. IN ADDITION TO HIS WIFE ANITA MOYER SMITH, HE IS SURVIVED BY FIVE CHILDREN, HIS PRIDE AND JOY: MICHAELA KNEPP AND HER HUSBAND, JOHN-MICHAEL; JARED SMITH; HALEE SMITH; OLIVIA SMITH; AND CHARLEE SMITH.

College Career (Penn State): 2013 True Freshman Season at Penn State: Appeared in 11 games...An all-purpose player, seeing time on offense, defense and special teams...Was one of 12 true freshmen to see game action... Returned six kickoffs for 99 yards, including a long of 23...Returned four punts for 19 yards. **2014 Sophomore Season:** Was selected Academic All-Big Ten for the first time in his career. **Season:** Appeared in 12 games...Made his first career start against Northwestern at linebacker. Was a major contributor on special teams. **2015 Junior Season:** Appeared in 12 games with two starts...Made his second career start and first start of the season vs. Buffalo...Tied for fifth on the team with seven special teams tackles, including a team-best six on punt coverage. **2016 Senior Season Awards:** Won the Bob Mitinger Memorial Award (senior who exhibits courage, character and social responsibility) and was honored with the Captain's Award at the annual Nittany Lion Football Banquet. **Season:** Appeared in 11 games...Missed the final three games of the season after suffering an injury. Selected team captain for the second time in his career...One of only eight Penn State players named two-time team captain. **Post Graduation:** "After graduating from Penn State University I spent some time in the Washington, DC area, New York City, and currently live in Boonton Township, NJ. Right out of college I found myself working for a high level IT staffing firm based out of Alexandria, VA and was tasked with finding the right people for government issued contracts. I'm currently working with Stryker (Stryker is one of the world's leading medical technology companies). I specifically work with all the video and software that takes place in the Operating Room working with Surgeons across all specialties." **Thoughts on Lezzer Lumber Classic:** "My experience with this event was nothing but awesome. I specifically remember the relationships that were built during practice sessions in such a short period of time. Kids playing the sport at a high level all getting together to showcase their talents is a special thing."

The J. Gawen Stoker Memorial Scholarship



He was persistent. He was loyal. But most of all he was a friend of Pennsylvania High School football. “Stokes” was involved in football across the state. He was an active member of the Pennsylvania Scholastic Football Coaches’ Association. He was a major partner in the Lezzer Lumber All-Star Game and he was extremely active in the District 6 Football Coaches’ Association. As a member of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame (PA Chapter), Gawen was one of the hardest workers on the Board. He was proud of the area athletes who distinguished themselves on the field and in the classroom. Stokes made a name for himself as an innovator in high school football, perhaps being the first to bring the ‘polecat’ to our area. He coached at Bald Eagle Area, Trinity (Washington, PA) and more recently at Indian Valley High School (now part of the Mifflin County jointure).

Frank Rocco, executive director of the Central PA Chapter says, “J. Gawen Stoker was a leader of men and boys and a great friend to many, many people. As Executive Director of the Pa. Scholastic Football Coaches Assoc. and a valued member of the Central Pa. Chapter of the National Football Foundation board of directors, his leadership and organizational skills were invaluable. Neither organization will ever be the same without him and he is missed by many.”

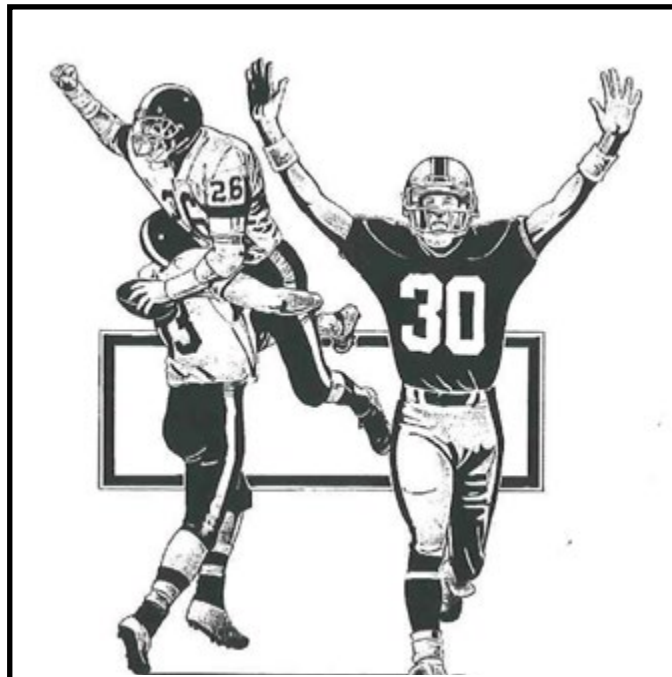

Previous Central Pennsylvania All-Star Football games such as the 1960 Central Counties and the 1977-78 Lewistown Lion Club were “great football games,” but were short lived.

In 1985, the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association, with J. Gawen Stoker as the Game Director, initiated the Mid-State Classic under the corporate sponsorship of the Mid-State Bank. The game was established to promote scholastic football, to recognize excellence of our players and coaches, to provide a system of ongoing football education for our coaching staffs, and to fund a scholarship program. The first game involved players from twenty-five schools. Uni-Mart replaced Mid-State Bank as the game sponsor in 1993. Jack Bailey and Rob Irwin have served as Co-Game Directors for the Classic from 1996 to 2009. J. Gawen Stoker was the Game Director 2010-2011. Jim Zauzig has been our Game Director from 2012 to present. Larry Wisner & Tom Shearer will be Co-Game Directors starting in 2023.

In 1998, the Lezzer Lumber Company became the major sponsor for the Classic with the CPFCA maintaining the football and organizational aspects of the game. We are proud to continue our association with the Lezzer Lumber as the corporate sponsor. Currently, there are thirty-two schools from District VI and IX involved in the game. To date, \$179,000 in the form of 343 scholarships have been awarded to help young people continue their education. The CPFCA holds monthly mini-clinics for high school and youth coaches during the winter months. To the players and coaches, being selected to participate in the “Classic” is held in high regard. It would seem that the goals for the Classic are being realized. The degree to which the game and the CPFCA can work toward these goals will depend upon the support we continue to receive.

The Lezzer Lumber Classic is considered as one of the premiere all-star football games in Pennsylvania. It is a tribute to our sponsors and co-sponsors, to the individual players sponsors, the business card and patron sponsors, and to families and friends of scholastic football in the Central Pennsylvania region. Please patronize our supporters, and let them know that you appreciate their contributions to the Classic when you visit their businesses.

CLASSIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

How are the funds raised? Where does the money go?

The Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association (CPFCA) is recognized as a non-profit organization. The CPFCA has been the administrative organization promoting and conducting the Classic over the past thirty years. Annually the receipts and expenditures for the operation of the game are in the \$25,000 to \$30,000 range.

There are three avenues of revenue for the Classic -- 1) individual player sponsors provide for one-third of the funds, 2) Game Sponsor and Co-Sponsors contributions equate to one-fourth of the revenue, and 3) the promotional component, including advertisers, business card and patron sponsors, sale of promotional items such as hats, T-shirts, and game program, video, and ticket sales constitutes the remainder of the revenues.

On the expenditure side, player expenses including game jerseys, practice meals, player commemorative awards, insurance coverage, and scholarship awards account for forty percent of the costs. An additional forty percent of the expenses are related to field rental, game site personnel, purchase of promotional items, and game program printing costs. The rest of the expenses are associated with coaching expenses, promotional fees, and administrative costs.

Basically, the game is a result of efforts of individuals from the thirty-two schools comprising the Central Pennsylvania region working for continued success of the Lezzer Lumber Classic.

LEZZER LUMBER FOOTBALL CLASSIC GAME RULES

- I. OFFENSE:** Must play with a balanced line. There must be three men on either side of center on the line of scrimmage. The offense may align in or motion to trips formation as long as one running back remains aligned in the backfield between the tackles. Each team must attempt passes on 30 % of their offensive plays. Percentages will be checked midway through the third quarter. If a team is under the 30 % pass attempt, each non-pass play will be penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct until the percentages are met and maintained. Force scrambles and sacks will be counted as pass attempts.

II. DEFENSIVE GUIDELINES

A. Four-Four-Man-Free

1. **Front:**
 - a. Tackles –inside / on / outside shoulder of guards.
 - b. Ends to the TE – inside / on / outside shoulder of the TE. Away from TE - outside shoulder of tackle (no ghost position).
 - c. All in 3 or 4-point stance.
 - d. Tackles and ends may slant, but no twists!
 - e. Tackles and ends must rush the passer.
2. **Inside Linebackers:**
 - a. Stacked on guards.
 - b. Depth of 5 yards from the LOS.
 - c. Depth may change in short yardage (2 yards or less) or goal line (10-yard line and in) situations, where the LB's may play as tight as possible and may assume a 3 or 4-point stance.
 - d. LB's react, but are never allowed to stunt – no stunts!
 - e. In passing situations, ILB's must be in coverage.
3. **Outside Linebackers:**
 - a. Align at 3 by 3 yds. to TE or tackle.
 - b. Same short yardage and goal line rules as ILB's.
 - c. OLB's react but are never allowed to stunt.
 - d. In passing situations, OLB's must be in coverage. If man motions, OLB may follow, switch, or invert with FS.
 - e. In a Trips Away formation, OLB must move over to the Trips.
4. **Corners:**
 - a. Must play man-to-man at a maximum depth of 7 yards at the snap of the ball.
 - b. If man motions, C may follow, switch, or invert with FS.
5. **Free Safety:**
 - a. Must align inside the tackle box at a maximum depth of 10 yards.
 - b. With motion, FS may invert with OLB or C.

III. DEFENSE vs. FIELD GOAL, EXTRA POINT, and PUNT

- A. Same alignment as goal line and you can rush up to as many as eight (8) players on field goal and extra point, but all eight (8) players must be on the line of scrimmage. All players must rush through the shoulder of the player they line up on. Cannot rush over the center.
- B. You may rush only two (2) players on a punt return and they are the ends. The outside linebackers can move out to play the two (2) slot men, man-to-man and no deeper than five (5) yards. The alignment of the ends, tackles, and middle linebacker are the same.
- C. On Punts, only the two (2) outside players (ends or flankers) and the center can release and go downfield before the ball is kicked (violation - 5 yards). May use trick play from a punt formation. Short Yardage /Anytime the offense has less than three yards to go for a first down or touchdown, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end).

Point Differential If Team A scores and is behind by 9 + points, Team A will be given the Option to Kick or Receive. If Team A receives and scores on that possession and still trails by 9 + points, No option - Team A will Kickoff to Team B. Rule does not change designated second half Kickoff.

Kickoff Kickoff will be from the 35 yard line.
IF BALL IS KICKED INTO THE END ZONE, THEN THE DEFENSE IS REWARDED WITH PLACING THE BALL ON THE 15 YARD LINE.

PAT & FG PAT: BALL WILL PLACED AT 13 YD. LINE FOR A 30-YD ATTEMPT. WORTH 2 PTS. IF GOOD.
IF KICKED AT THE REGULAR SPOT, STILL WORTH 1 PT.
FG: FG OF 40+ YARDS = 4 PTS.

Kicking Game In Kicking Game situations, the linebackers may move up unto the line of scrimmage, and the secondary may move up (but must stay outside the defensive end), however, no more than seven may rush on any kicking play.

Quarters / Time Each Quarter will be 12 minutes
Playing Time Each player must participate for a least 15 plays.
Tie Breaker If the score is tied at the end of regulation play it will stand as a tie.

PLAYER AND COACHES SELECTION

Players and coaches are selected for the game by members of the Central Pennsylvania Football Coaches Association. They require that a representative attend a minimum of three CPFCA meetings before a player is eligible. Players from schools failing to meet the minimum participation requirements are not eligible for the following year.

Player Selection:

1. Graduating Senior players are nominated in writing by their head coach in December.
 - a. Each school may have no more than five players participate.
2. Players nominated are polled to ascertain that they will participate if selected.
3. Coaches from schools in each division review the nominated players and the forty players are selected by a consensus of the selection committees. (A player from each eligible school will be selected to participate in the game.)
4. This year coaches from both staffs selected alternates in case players were unable to participate for various reasons.

Coach Selection:

1. Members of the association select the coaching staff from member schools in each division -- North and South.
2. The coaching staffs for each division consist of a Head Coach and five/six Associate Coaches.
