RE: 2021-2022 District IV Competitive Spirit Championships

Please take time to review the rules for the 2021-2022 PIAA District IV Championships in Competitive Spirit. I am enclosing a copy of the rules as approved by the District IV Committee for your convenience.

The defined season for Competitive Spirit begins the first day of fall sports and ends with the last day of the PIAA Basketball Championships. Tryouts can be held outside the defined season, but all other season and out-of season rules and regulations apply. The District IV Championships will be held on January 15, 2022 at Shamokin Area High School beginning at 12:00 noon. The PIAA State Championships will be held Friday and Saturday, January 28 and 29, 2022 in Hershey.

Last season, PIAA reclassified the Competitive Spirit divisions. Classification is AA or AAA. This is determined by your school's enrollment:

Within each classification there will be a Small (1-15 members) and Large (16+ members) Division. There will also be one overall Co-ed Division for any school that has at least one male. District 4 will have a total of (5) qualifiers for the PIAA State Championships. AA will have (4) qualifiers and AAA will have (1) qualifier. The top (4) scores in AA and top score in AAA will advance to the State Championships regardless of Division (Large, Small, or Co-ed). The District and State Level Championships will be judged by Varsity judges. There will be NO entry fee for the District Level Championships. DISTRICT IV COMPETITIVE SPIRIT 2021-2022

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES:

- 1. To enter the District IV Championships, each school must submit their completed entry form no later than 12:00 (noon) on Friday, December 3, 2021.
- 2. PIAA has classified the Competitive Spirit divisions as follows: Classification is AA or AAA. This is determined by your school's enrollment. Within each classification there will be a Small (1-15 members) and Large (16+ members) Division. There will also be one overall Co-ed Division for any team that has at least one male.
- 3. District 4 will have a total of (5) qualifiers for the PIAA State Championships. AA will have (4) qualifiers and AAA will have (1) qualifier. The top (4) scores in AA and top score in AAA will advance to the State Championships regardless of Division (Large, Small, or Co-ed). If a tie exists between two or more squads for a state qualifier, the tiebreaker will be based on the same criteria used at the State Level Championships.
- 4. A non-spring floor will be used for both the District and State Level Championships. Spring floors are prohibited.
- 5. Teams may not change divisions once their entry forms have been submitted.
- 6. All schools competing should bring their own spotters if needed.
- 7. A championship plaque and medals will be awarded to the top team in each division. However, the top (4) scores in AA and top score in AAA will advance to the State Championships regardless of Division (Large, Small, or Co-ed).
- 8. Please bring two copies of your music (of different formats) either on CD, flash drive, iPhone, or Android. The DJ has auxiliary cords and you can test your music during warm-ups.
- 9. Doors will open one hour prior to the start of the competition. All ticket sales will be done online through Hometown Ticketing. More information regarding online ticket sales is forthcoming. District IV will charge \$6 for all tickets (plus additional fees set by Hometown Ticketing).
