### DISTRICT IV 2018 BOYS' AND GIRLS' LACROSSE

- 1. The top four lacrosse teams in both boys and girls are eligible for the District IV Tournament provided they play a minimum of nine games. District IV will have one girls team and one boys team advance to the state tournament.
- 2. Only official PIAA varsity games will be considered for your record. An official game is one with a PIAA contract (or league scheduled) and your opponent must be a member of the PIAA in lacrosse, all games that count must be conducted by PIAA Officials.

- 3. The district playoff games shall be conducted in accordance with the PIAA rules and regulations governing interscholastic sports competition. The National Federation Lacrosse Rules are the official PIAA rules. Teams that enter the playoffs agree to all the regulations established by the district lacrosse committee.
- 4. The district committee will assign officials and a game manager for each game.
- 5. Seeding:
- a. Teams will be seeded by the district lacrosse committee based upon winning percentage of your overall record. If the winning percentage is equal, the team with the most games played will be seeded higher. Head to head competition and having more wins, or coin flip will be considered to break a seeding tie.
- b. Winning percentage will be determined by the following procedure: 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss; (total wins) divided by (total games played x 2) = winning percentage.
- c. The top four District IV Teams that played 9 games or more are eligible for District IV Playoffs.
- 6. Notification must be Faxed by 12:00(Noon) Monday, May 14, 2018 Fax # 966-8260 of a school's intention to compete or not in the district competition. (Please note forms are due Monday) The following information must be sent to the District IV Lacrosse Chairman if you are competing: eligibility, list of players and the enclosed record sheet for each team. Games played after May 11 will not count towards seeding.
- 7. To be eligible a school must play a minimum of 9 official varsity games by May 11, 2018. Games scheduled after the first game of the season will not be considered to qualify a team for district competition (or overall record) unless pre-approved by the District IV Committee.
- 8. All games will be played at Danville High School at 6:00, and 7:30 during weekdays. The teams on the top of the bracket will be the home team and wear light colored uniforms. The visiting team will be responsible for having uniforms of a contrasting color.
- 9. Each school shall provide the following for every game:

a. one (1) adult scorer

b. two (2) ball chasers

## 10. Awards:

- a. Team plaque to each district championship team
- b. 25 individual medals for each first place team in District IV.
- 10. Admission prices: All Games

Adults \$6.00 Students \$4.00

- 12. **Hosting school**: Danville High School will host all district playoff games.
- 13. Facilities: Teams should come to the tournament dressed for the game. Locker rooms and showers may be available after each game, please call ahead to Athletic Director of hosting school. Notify the host school Athletic Director if dressing facilities are desired before the semifinal, and/or championship games.
- 14. Criteria used to determine sites are:
- a. Maximum playing dimensions
- d. Provision to charge admission

b. Lights

e. Geographical location

- c. Spectator seating
- 15. AA Boys' and AA Girls' Sites, Dates, and Times.
  - a. Wednesday, May 16, semi-final girls games at 6:00 and 7:30.
  - b. Thursday, May 17, semi-final boys games at 6:00 and 7:30.
  - c. Tuesday, May 22, finals for girls at 6:00, finals for boys at 7:30.
