**DISTRICT IV
 2019 BOYS' AND GIRLS' SOCCER**

1. District IV will have 10 soccer teams advancing to the state tournament. Advancing will be 2 (A) Girls, 2 (AA) Girls, 1 (AAA) Girls, 2 (A) Boys, 2 (AA) Boys, 1 (AAA) Boys, (AAAA) Boys and (AAAA) Girls will qualify through District 2.
2. Only official PIAA varsity games will be considered for your record. An official game is one with a PIAA contract (or league scheduled), and officials.
3. The district playoff games shall be conducted in accordance with the PIAA rules and regulations governing interscholastic sports competition. The National

Federation Soccer Rules are the official PIAA rules. Teams that enter the playoffs agree to all the regulations established by the district soccer committee.

4. The district committee will assign officials and a game manager for each game.
5. Seeding:
 - a. Teams will be seeded according to the power rating system as instituted by the District IV Committee.. **Tournament games tied at the conclusion of regulation play that have the tie broken with an overtime procedure will be counted as a win or a loss.**
 - b. **In Class A Boys and Girls a minimum of eight teams will be eligible for the District IV Tournament. These eight teams would be the highest ranked teams as determined by the power ranking system. In addition, any team with a .500 record or better would also be eligible for the District IV Tournament. District IV Teams must play 10 or more games to be eligible for the playoffs.**
 - c. **In Class AA Boys and Girls a minimum of eight teams will be eligible for the District IV Tournament. These eight teams would be the highest ranked teams as determined by the power ranking system. In addition, any team with a .500 record or better would also be eligible for the District IV Tournament. District IV Teams must play 10 or more games to be eligible for the playoffs.**
 - d. **In Class AAA Boys and Girls a minimum of four teams will be eligible for the District IV Tournament. These four teams would be the highest ranked teams as determined by the power ranking system. In addition, any team with a .500 record or better would also be eligible for the District IV Tournament. District IV Teams must play 10 or more games to be eligible for the playoffs.**
 - e. **The District IV Committee reserves the right to seed teams with special circumstances at it's discretion.**
 - f. **The District IV Committee reserves the right to seed teams at it's discretion who do not report accurately or by the established deadline.**
 - g. **The final day for games to count is SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2019. ALL SCHOOLS MUST HAVE ALL GAMES ENTERED INTO THE POWER RATING SYSTEM BY 12:00 PM ON OCTOBER 19, 2019.**
6. To be eligible a school must play a minimum of 10 official varsity games by Saturday, October 19, 2019. (Consideration may be given to teams that played less than 10 games if a scheduled game had to be postponed during the week of October 14, but all teams must make every effort to play every scheduled game. Not playing a game to stay “.500” is not acceptable.) **Games scheduled after the first game of the season will not be considered to qualify a team for district competition (or overall record) unless pre-approved by the District IV Committee.**

7. All games will be played at available sites at 4:00(Triple header only), 6:00 and 8:00 during weekdays. Triple-headers may be used to keep girls and boys teams from the same school at the same site. Saturday games will be 12:00, 2:00, 4:00, 6:00. **The teams on the top of the bracket will be the home team and wear dark colored uniforms.** The visiting team will be responsible for wearing white uniforms.
8. If play in games are necessary consideration may be given to the higher seeded team to host these games if possible. Rental fees **will not** be issued if the higher seeded team hosts a game.
9. **Each school shall provide the following for every game:**
 - a. one (1) adult scorer
 - b. two (2) ball chasers
11. Awards:
 - a. Team plaque to each district championship team
 - b. 25 individual medals for each team advancing to state competition and teams in the finals who do not qualify for states (Boys A,AA,AAA Girls A,AA,AAA)

13. **Hosting schools:** The following facilities may be hosting playoff games (Athens, Balls Mills (Williamsport), Bloomsburg University, Mansfield University, Central Columbia, Lewisburg, Danville, Hughesville, Mid-West, Millville, Towanda, Sayre, Shamokin, Mifflinburg, Loyalsock) All expenses will be paid from the gate. District IV will pay the officials. Game managers must complete all forms and deposit money within 48 hours following each game.
14. Facilities: Teams should come to the tournament dressed for the game. Locker rooms and showers may be available after each game, please call ahead to the Athletic Director of hosting school. Notify the host school Athletic Director if dressing facilities are desired before the preliminary, quarterfinals, semifinal, and/or championship games.
15. Criteria used to determine sites are:

1. Maximum playing dimensions	5. Provision to charge admission
2. Lights	6. Geographical location
3. Spectator seating	7. Site availability
4. Condition of playing surface	8. Seeding of teams will not be a criterion for selection of game sites
16. A&AA Boys' and A Girls' Sites, Dates, and Times.
 - a. Tuesday, October 22, Wednesday, October 23 and Thursday, October 24, 2019
Preliminary Games: Games will be scheduled by the committee at available sites. The games will be played at 4:00, 6:00 and 8:00 P.M.

- b. Saturday October 26, 2019 Quarterfinal games will be played at available sites. The games will be 12:00, 2:00, 4:00, 6:00.
- c. Tuesday, October 29, 2019 Semifinal games will be played at available sites at 4:00, 6:00 and 8:00.
- d. Thursday, October 31, 2019 Championship games will be played at 5:00 and 7:00 at available sites.

17. AA Girls' Sites, Dates, and Times

- a. Tuesday, October 22, 2019 Preliminary games will be scheduled at available sites at 5:00 and 7:00 if necessary.
- b. Wednesday, October 23 or Thursday, October 24, 2019 Quarterfinal games will be played at 5:00 and 7:00 at available sites.
- c. Monday, October 28, 2019 Semifinal games will be played at 5:00 and 7:00 at an available site.
- d. Thursday, October 31, 2019 Championship game will be at an available site at 5:00 or 7:00.

18. AAA Boys and Girls Sites, Dates, and Times

- a. Tuesday, October 22, Wednesday, October 23, Thursday, October 24, 2019 Preliminary games will be scheduled by the committee at available sites. Games will be played at 4:00, 6:00, or 8:00 pm.
- b. Semifinal AAA Boys and Girls Saturday, October 26, 2019 at 12:00, 2:00, 4:00 and 6:00 pm at an available site.
- c. Wednesday, October 30, 2019 championship games for boys and girls will be played at 5:00 and 7:00 pm at an available site.

19. AAAA Boys and AAAA Girls will qualify through District 2.
