#### DISTRICT IV 2020 BOYS' AND GIRLS' SOCCER

- 1. District IV will have 6 soccer teams advancing to the state tournament. Advancing will be 1 (A) Girls, 1 (AA) Girls, 1 (AAA) Girls, 1 (A) Boys, 1 (AAA) Boys, (AAAA) Boys and (AAAA) Girls will qualify through District 2.
- 2. Only official PIAA varsity games will be considered for your record. An official game is one with a PIAA contract (or league scheduled), and officials.
- 3. The district playoff games shall be conducted in accordance with the PIAA rules and regulations governing interscholastic sports competition. The National Federation Soccer Rules are the official PIAA rules. Teams that enter the playoffs agree to all the regulations established by the district soccer committee.

- 4. The district committee will assign officials and a game manager for each game.
- 5. Seeding:
  - a. Teams will be seeded according to the power rating system as instituted by the District IV Committee.. Tournament games tied at the conclusion of regulation play that have the tie broken with an overtime procedure will be counted as a win or a loss.
  - b. In Class A Boys and Girls eight teams will be eligible for the District IV Tournament. These eight teams would be the highest ranked teams as determined by the power ranking system.
  - c. In Class AA Boys and Girls eight teams will be eligible for the District IV Tournament. These eight teams would be the highest ranked teams as determined by the power ranking system.
  - d. In Class AAA Boys and Girls four teams will be eligible for the District IV Tournament. These four teams would be the highest ranked teams as determined by the power ranking system.
  - e. The District IV Committee reserves the right to seed teams with special circumstances at it's discretion.
  - f. The District IV Committee reserves the right to seed teams at it's discretion who do not report accurately or by the established deadline.
  - g. The final day for games to count is Friday, OCTOBER 23, 2020. ALL SCHOOLS MUST HAVE ALL GAMES ENTERED INTO THE POWER RATING SYSTEM BY 12:00 AM ON OCTOBER 23, 2020.
- 6. To be eligible a school must play a minimum of 6 official varsity games by Saturday, October 23, 2020. (Consideration may be given to teams that played less than 6 games if a scheduled game had to be postponed during the week of October 19, but all teams must make every effort to play every scheduled game. Games scheduled after the first game of the season will not be considered to qualify a team for district competition (or overall record) unless pre-approved by the District IV Committee.
- 7. All games will be played at the site of the higher seeded team. The teams on the top of the bracket will be the home team and wear dark colored uniforms. The visiting team will be responsible for wearing white uniforms.
- 8. The hosting school will school will pay all game expenses including officials fees.
- 9. The hosting school will provide all game personnel.
- 10. Game times will be 4:00 pm on weekdays and 2:00 pm on weekends.

11. A team plaque and 25 medals will be awarded to each District IV Champion. Medals will NOT be presented on the field following the championship games. Immediately following the completion of each championship game, a team plaque will be presented on the field to the champion.

12. Admission prices All Games

Adults \$6.00 Students \$4.00

#### 13.COVID-19

- a. Games not played due to COVID exposure will be considered NO CONTEST. If a team's opponent for a scheduled game cannot play due to COVID it may schedule a replacement game. The results of the replacement game will count for power ratings, provided it is against a PIAA member school and is played prior to the power ranking deadline.
- b. Teams that are unable to participate on the first date of their class' tournament due to COVID exposure will not be permitted to enter the tournament.
- c. A team that qualifies for the tournament but must suspend its season due to COVID after the power ranking deadline will be eliminated.
- **d.** Schools that do not qualify for the tournament and schools that are eliminated from the district tournament may continue their regular season until **Saturday**, **November 7**, **2020**.
- e. Attendance at games will be determined by the state guidelines as they apply on the date of the event. Further information will be provided as changes occur.
- 14. Please distribute the necessary copies of this memo for boys and girls soccer teams.
- 15. The District IV Committee reserves the right to make changes to this year's tournament if necessary.
